Van Zyverden's DAYLILY STELLA D'ORO





The daylily (hemerocallis) is considered a "sure bet" perennial, as they thrive throughout most of the country, with the exception of the very deep south. They tolerate less than ideal conditions and will bloom faithfully for years with virtually no attention. As the name implies, daylily flowers open in the morning and close by nightfall. Each flower stem typically has at least a dozen flower buds. Blooms for many weeks. Daylilies should be planted in every garden.

About This Variety: Stella D'Oro is a multiple AHS award winner and is perhaps the most popular daylily in cultivation world wide. It flowers yellow with deeper throats and ruffled edges. The leaves are linear and blade-like. Its bloom is classified as a miniature. It is appreciated for its compact size, vigorous growth, profuse bloom and extended blooming period. Very easy to grow and a garden staple. Plant en masse in broad sweeps for massive curb appeal. Will return for years to come.

Growing Instructions: Best planted in groups for dramatic effect in full sun in moist, yet well drained soil. Excellent ground cover, as a single specimen, or in mass plantings to create a focal point in the garden.

Care Tip: They are tough, robust plants so not much can go wrong.

Exposure: Full Sun

Height: Grows 8-12" tall

Spacing: Plant 8-12" apart, 1.5-2" deep

USDA Zones: hardy in USDA zones 3-9
