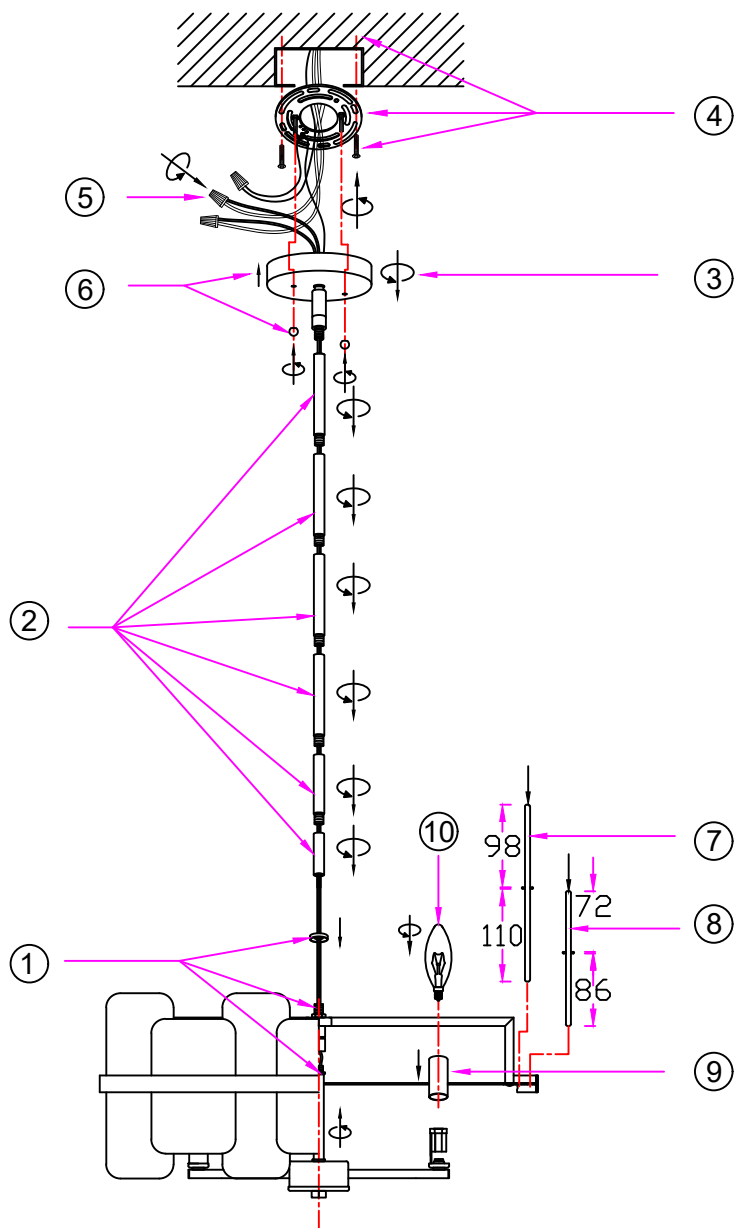


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Fasten the lamp body onto the directional head and place the tube cover over the threaded rod.
2. Screw the suspension rod onto the lamp body. Adjust the quantity of rods to achieve the desired length.
3. Screw the suspension rod into the canopy.
4. Secure the mounting plate to the junction box using the provided mounting screws.
5. Connect the fixture wires to the supply wires using wire connectors.
·Note: Connect the black (hot) wire to the black wire, the white (neutral) wire to the white wire, and the ground wire to the grounding terminal.
·Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
6. Secure the canopy to the mounting plate using metal ring.
7. Gently insert the longer glass accents, pointed end down, into the inner holes of the fixture frame. Adjust to ensure they are straight and properly seated.
8. Gently insert the shorter glass accents, pointed end down, into the outer holes of the fixture frame. Adjust to ensure they are straight and properly seated.
9. Slide the final decorative sleeve over the socket housing.
10. Insert the bulb into the socket. (Bulb Not Included)
11. Turn on the power to check if the bulb works properly.
The installation is now complete.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
