- Shake can well.
- Contents may be under pressure. Open carefully. Place hand over lid and open away from you. Save lid for later use.
- Do not pour or scoop gel out of the can. Light Real Flame® gel fuel only when can is placed in the designated area in unit. Wipe up spills. Use a long match or extended butane lighter to ignite fuel.
- Never move or replace cans while they're burning. Cans get hot. If they are dropped or burning fuel is spilled, it could injure people or set surroundings on fire.
- Do not refill or add any kind of fuel to gel cans.
- Do not obstruct or inhibit the flame by placing anything in or over the can.
- Do not burn more than the maximum number of cans specified in the instructions included with your Real Flame® unit.
- To extinguish flame, wipe off excess gel on lid and replace lid upside down on can with a magnetic lid opener or tongs. Allow cans to cool for 20 minutes before touching them.
- Real Flame® gel fuel is made specifically for products designed and approved by Real Flame. Do not use in any other units.
- Use Real Flame[®] gel fuel within one year of purchase. Always store in a cool, dry place.
