When installing wall panels, make sure the two connecting panels are at a 90 degree angle vertical to the ground, and 90 degree perpendicular to each other. Tilting in any way might cause damage to the groove.

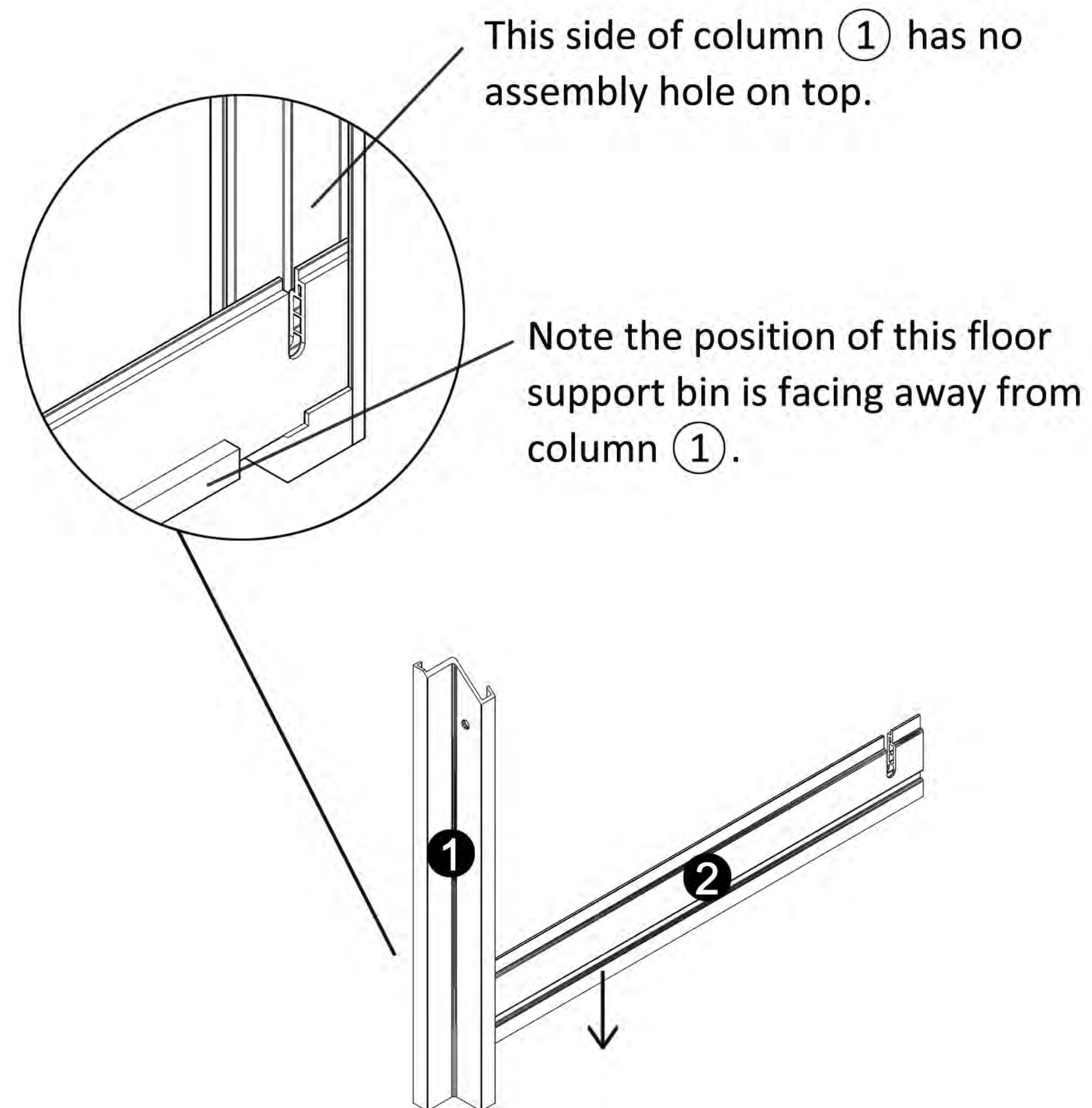

IMPORTANT ASSEMBLY TIPS

Before launch the new ecoChoice™ line, we have conducted hundreds of testing and surveys with pet lovers. Thanks to all the participants and their feedbacks, now we have these valuable tips to pass on to you ...

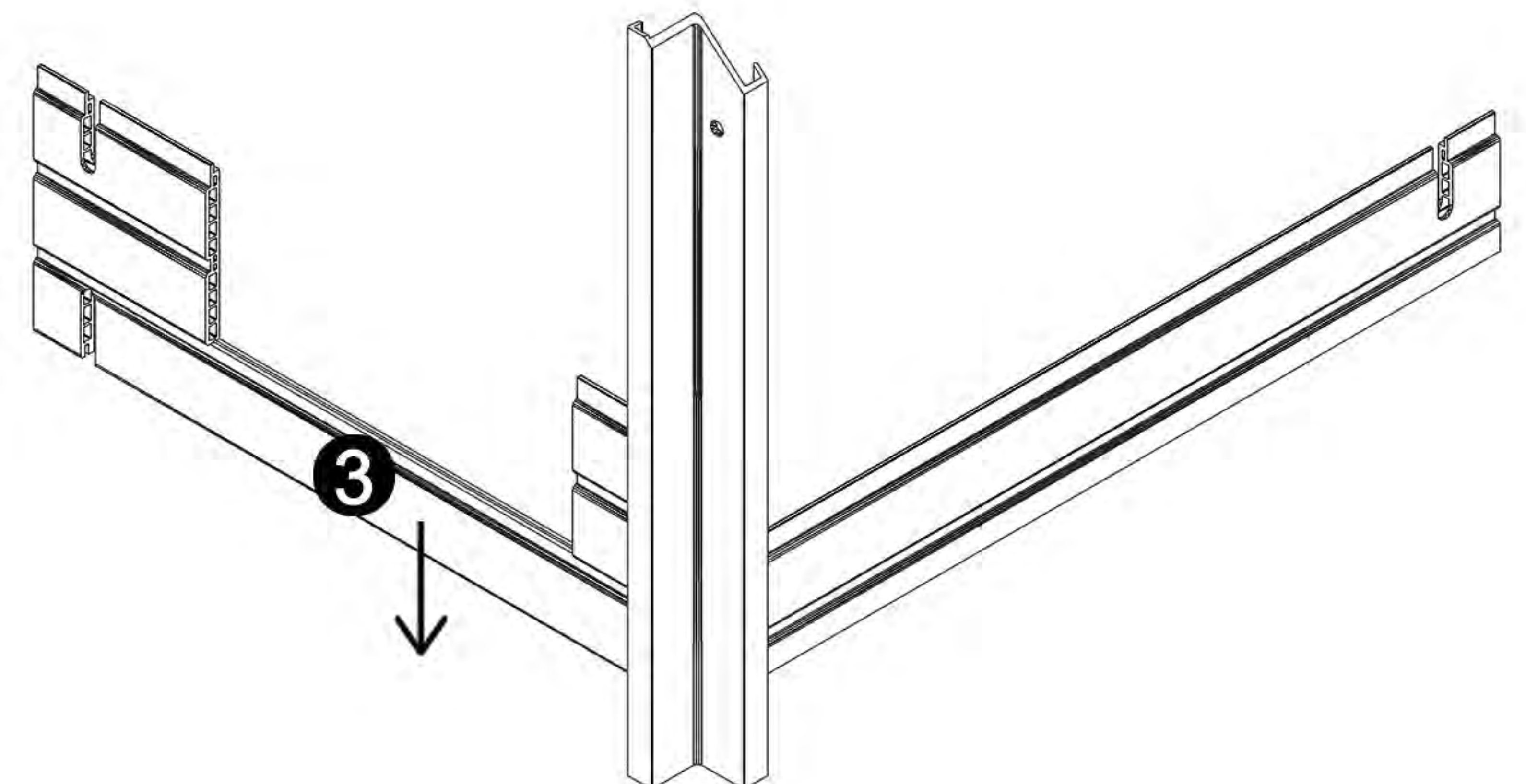
- ⇒ **Assemble on a hard, flat surface.** Once assembled, you can easily move the dog house to the location desired.
- ⇒ **Sort the parts in sequence.** We know you are eager to dive in, but spending a moment lay out the parts by ascending numbers will save you time and frustration later on.
- ⇒ **Note the difference of the panel edges.** For all wall, roof and floor panels, one edge has lip, the other edge has groove. During assembly, the grooved edge is always facing downward (except for the floor panels).
- ⇒ **Note the difference of the two sides of panels.** As a general rule, the flat side is facing inside the house, and the washed side is facing outside.

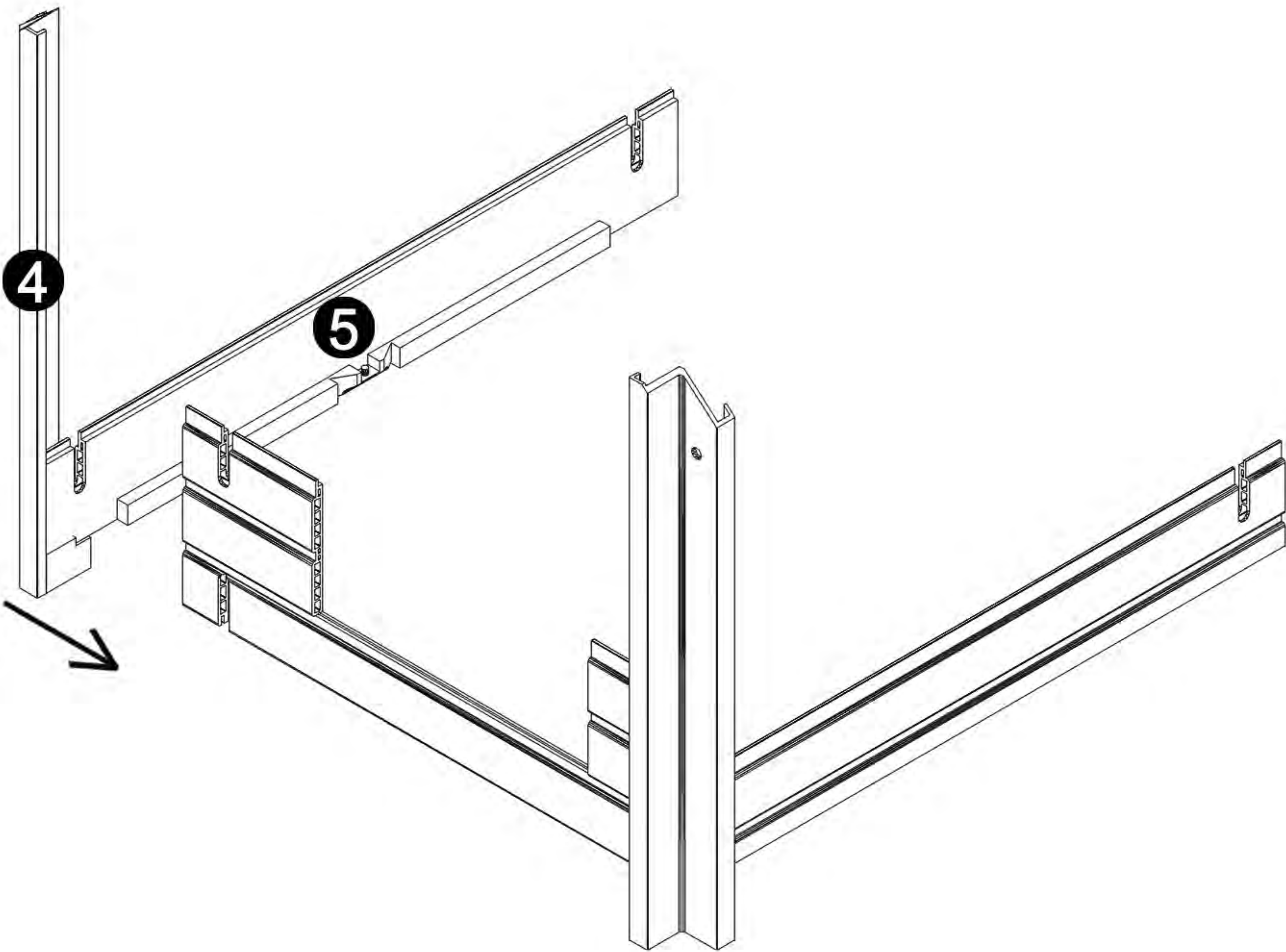

Note: After install Panel ③, make sure the FLAT side of panel ① and ③ are facing inside, and the washed sides are facing out.

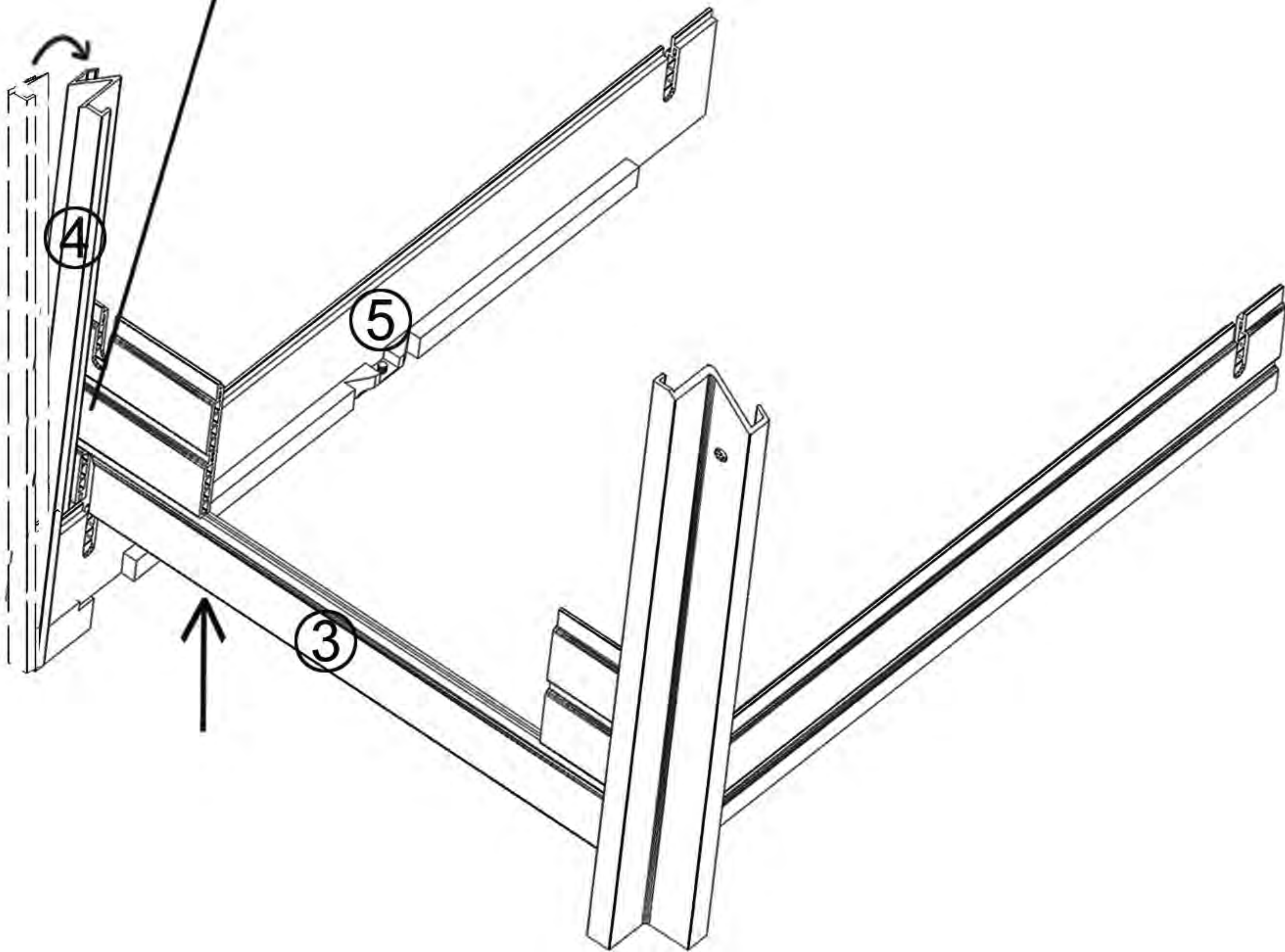

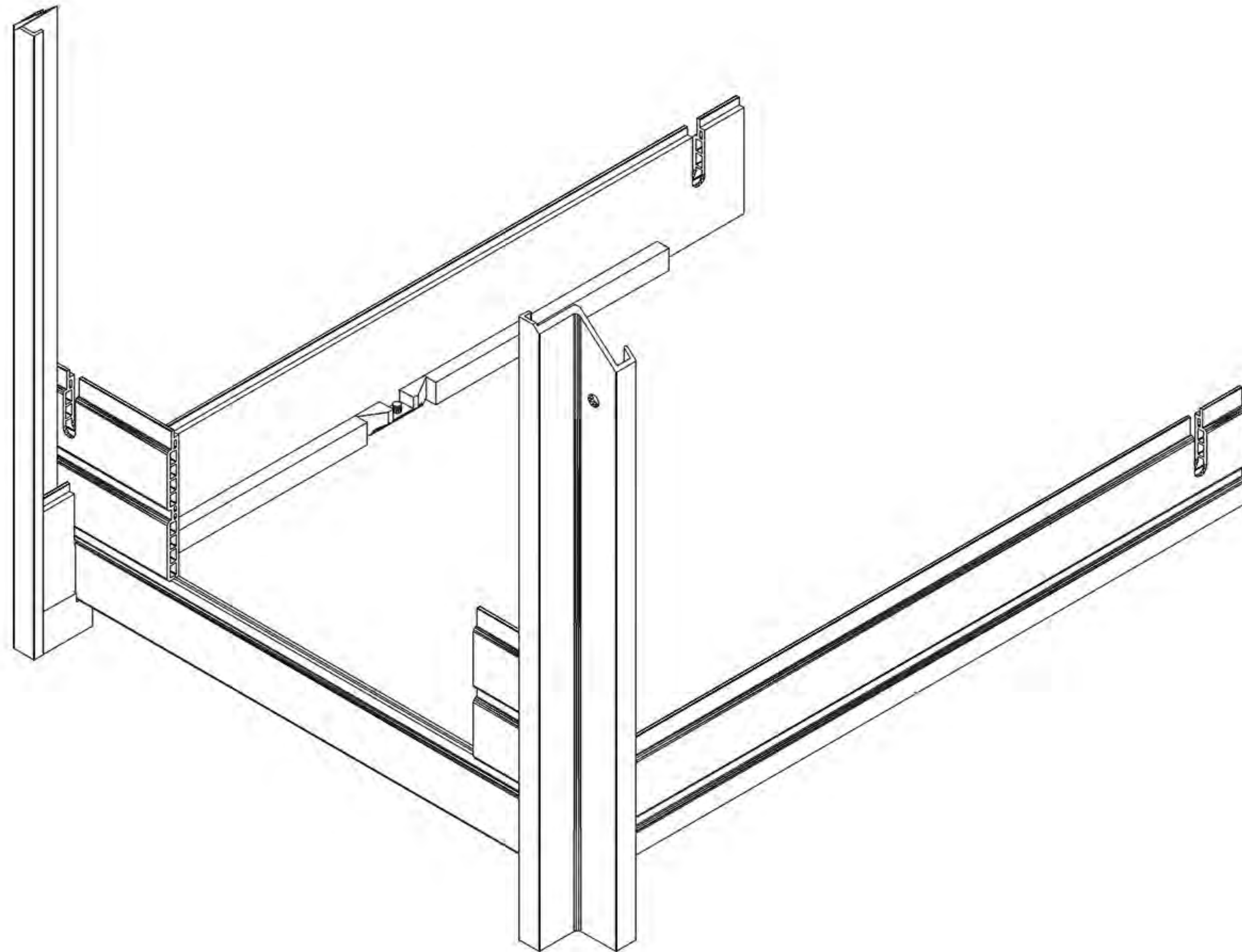

Move assembled parts ④ & ⑤ and ③ near to each other. Lift ③ upward as shown, then tilt ④ & ⑤ so ③ is perpendicular to ⑤. Insert ③ into ⑤.

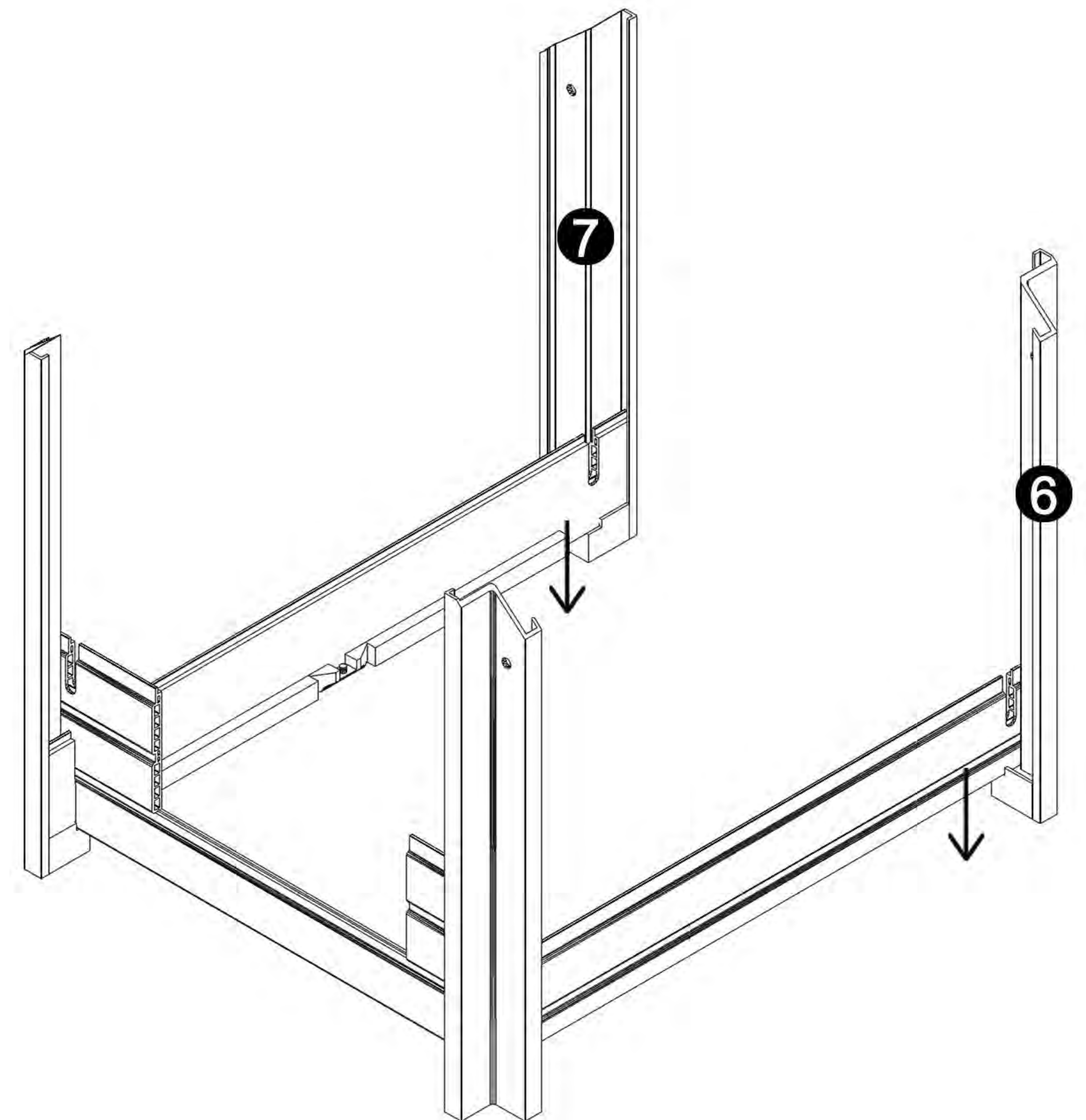

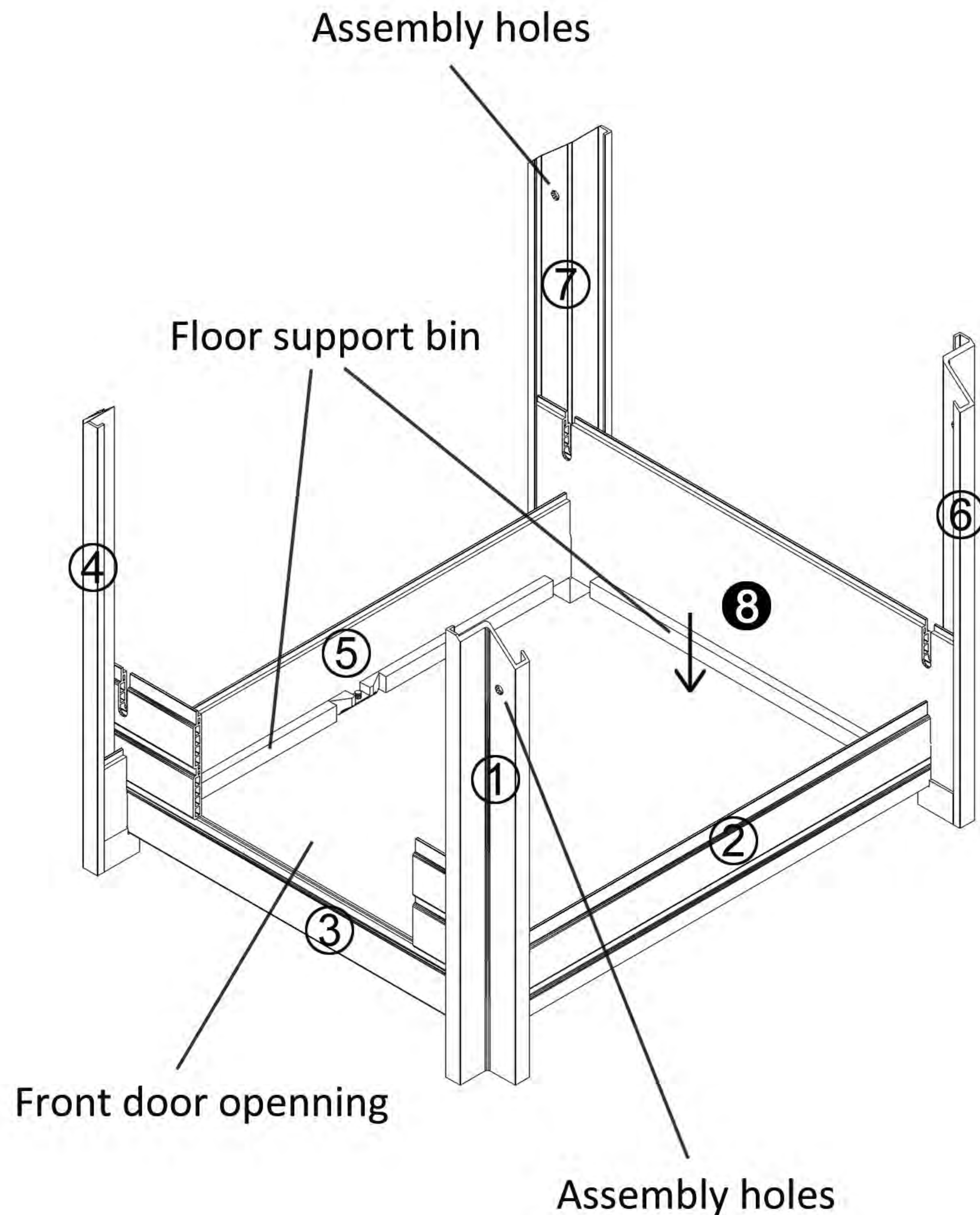
The assembly should look like this at this point. Take a step back and exam the house against the picture shown below. Note the angels on the corner posts should be pointing upward toward the middle of the house.

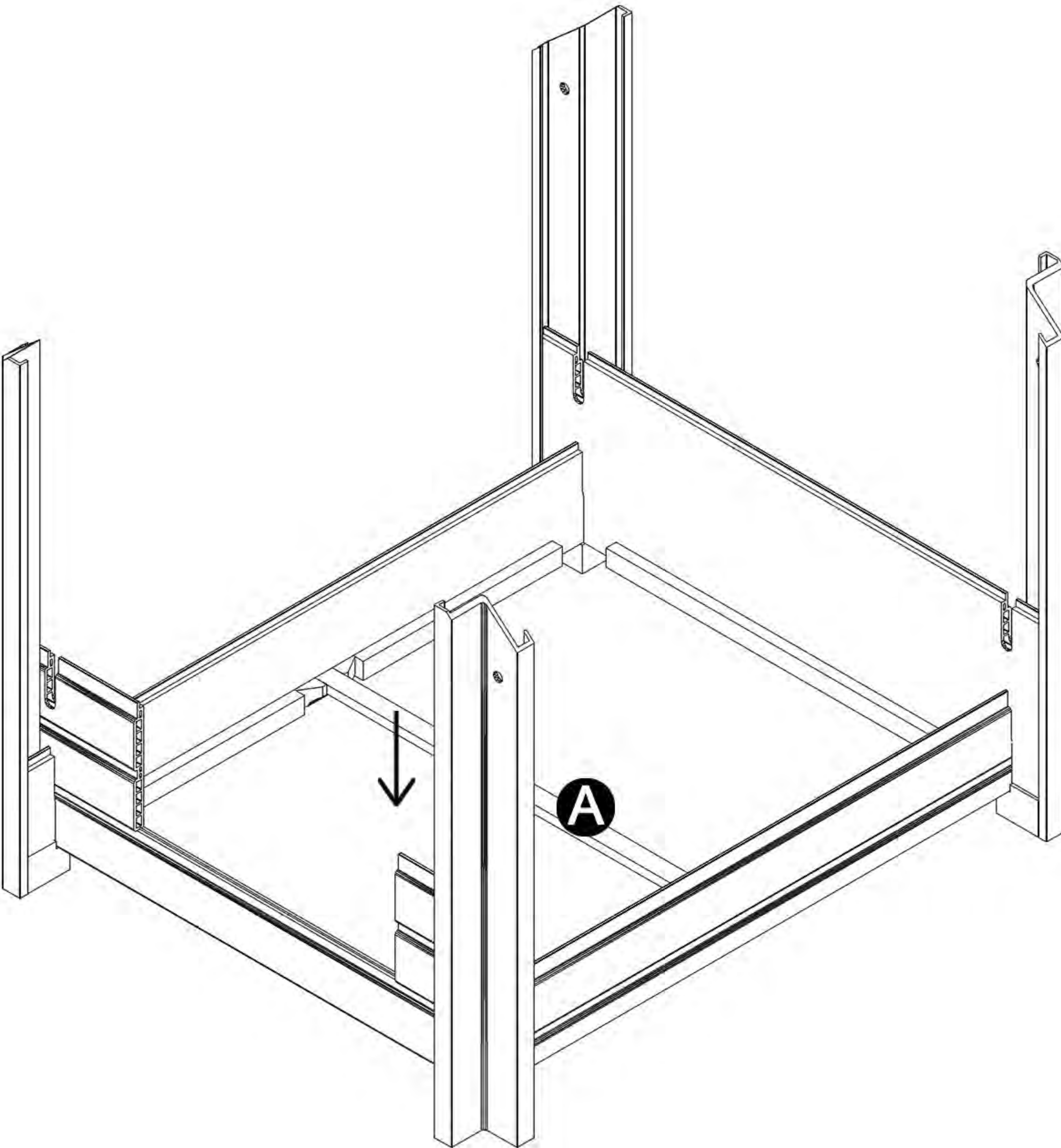


So far you have setup the wall base panels, ②, ③, ⑤ & ⑧; and the 4 column posts. Step back and stand facing the front door open. Do a quick check:

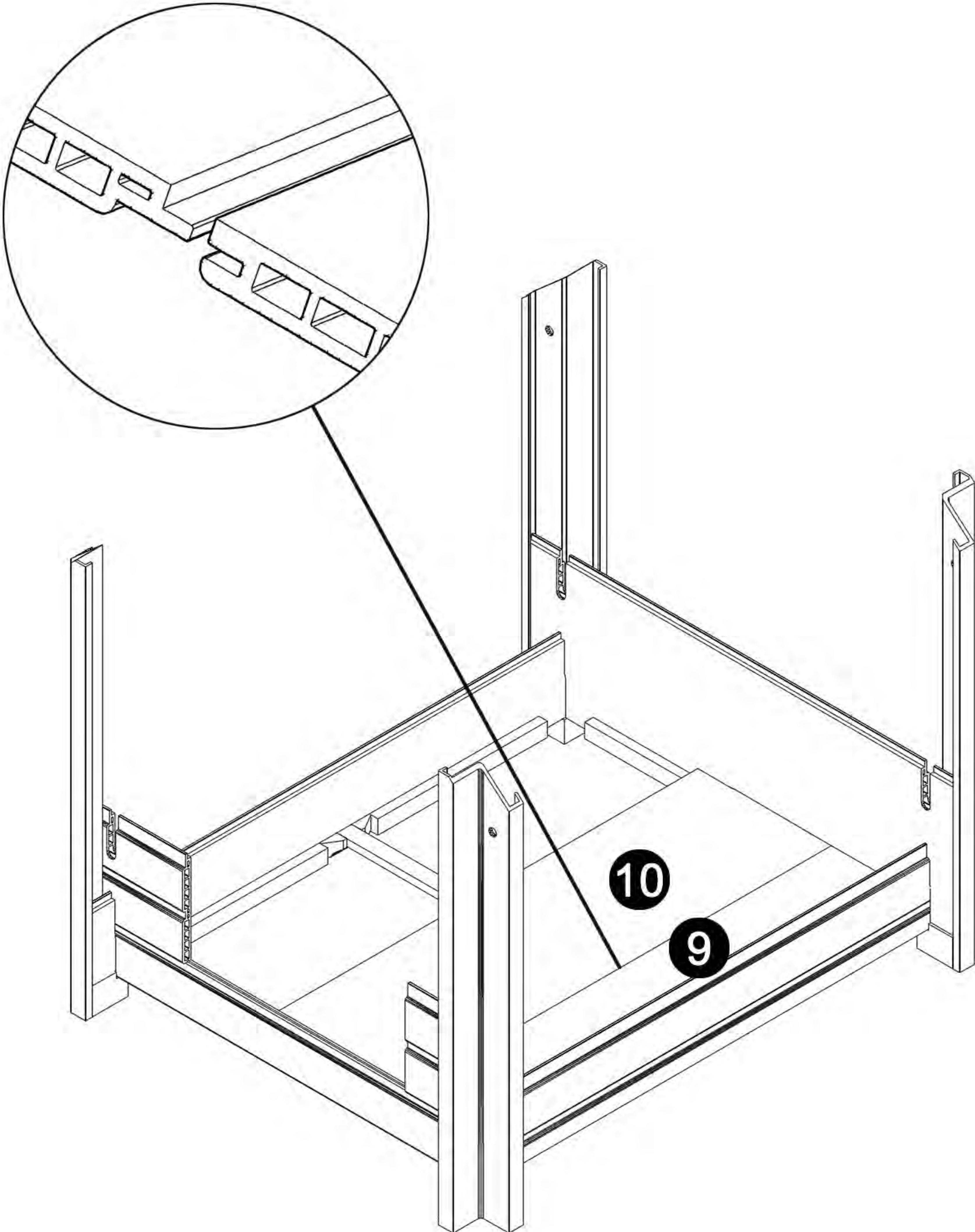
- The FLAT SIDES of the all wall panels are facing inside.
- The floor support bins are located on the lower edge of the flat side of the wall panels.
- The assembly holes on the two front columns ① & ④ are facing forwards; while the assembly holes on the two back columns ⑥ & ⑦ are facing each other.

Once you check all the above, you are ready to move on...

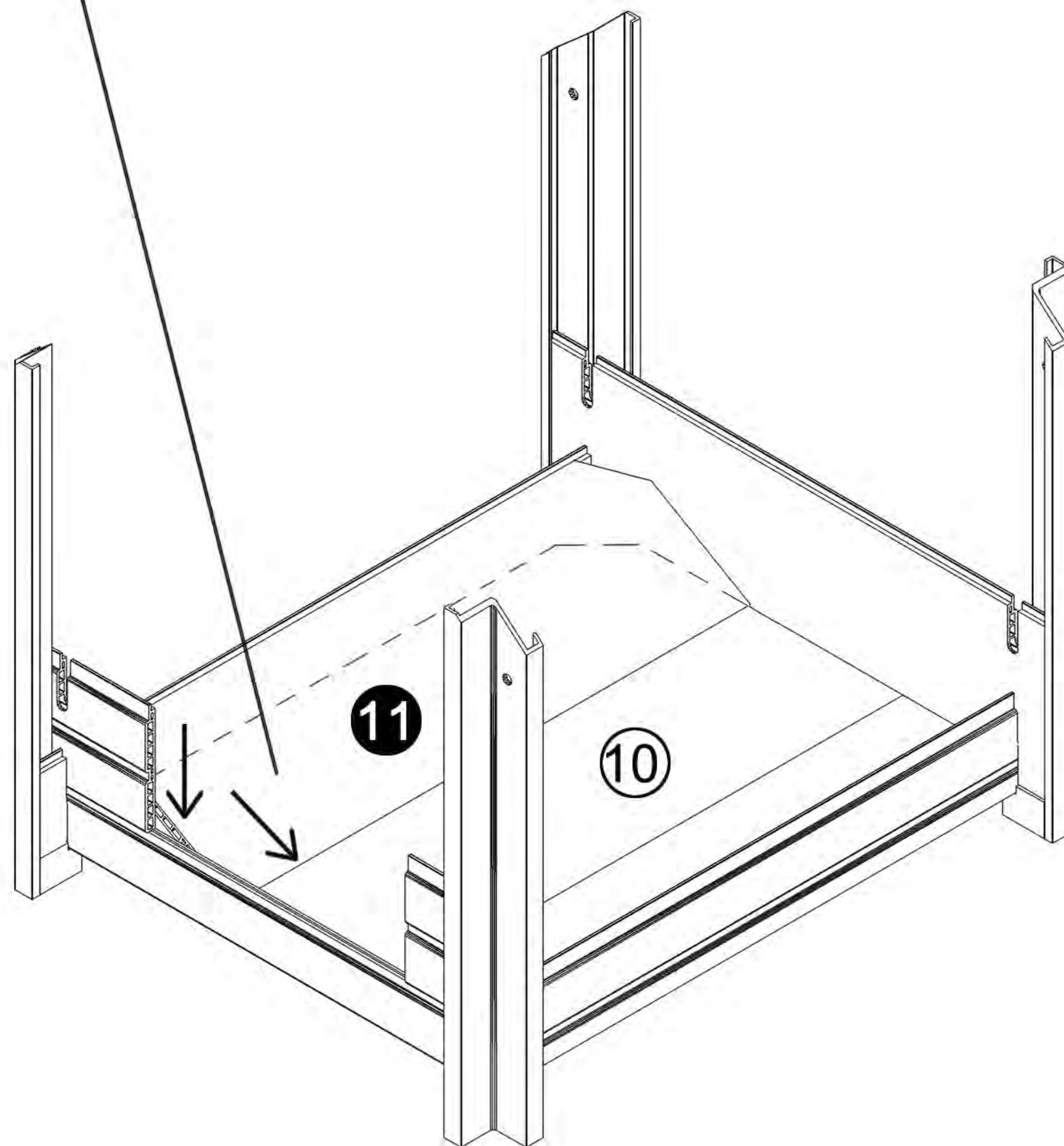

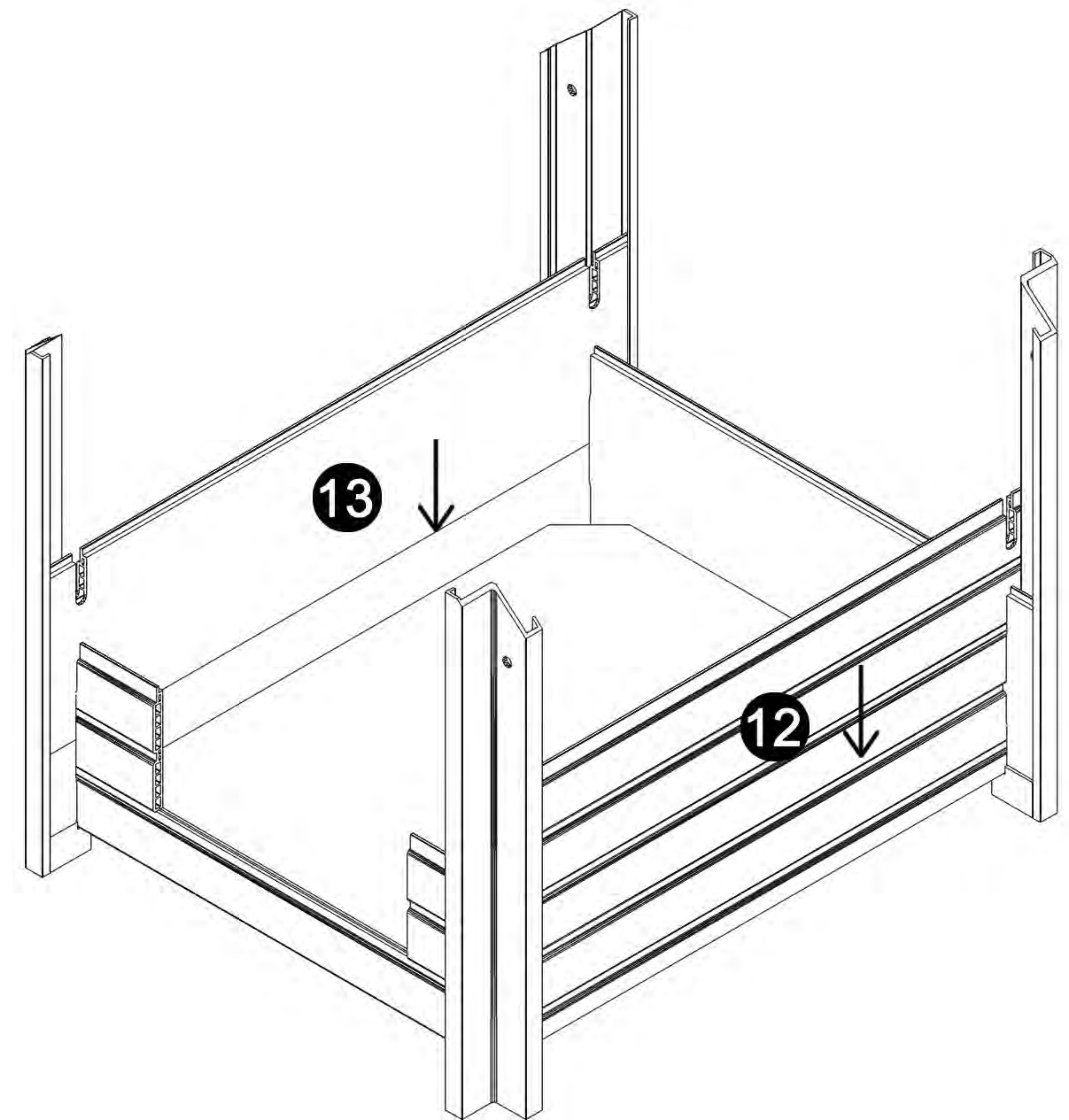

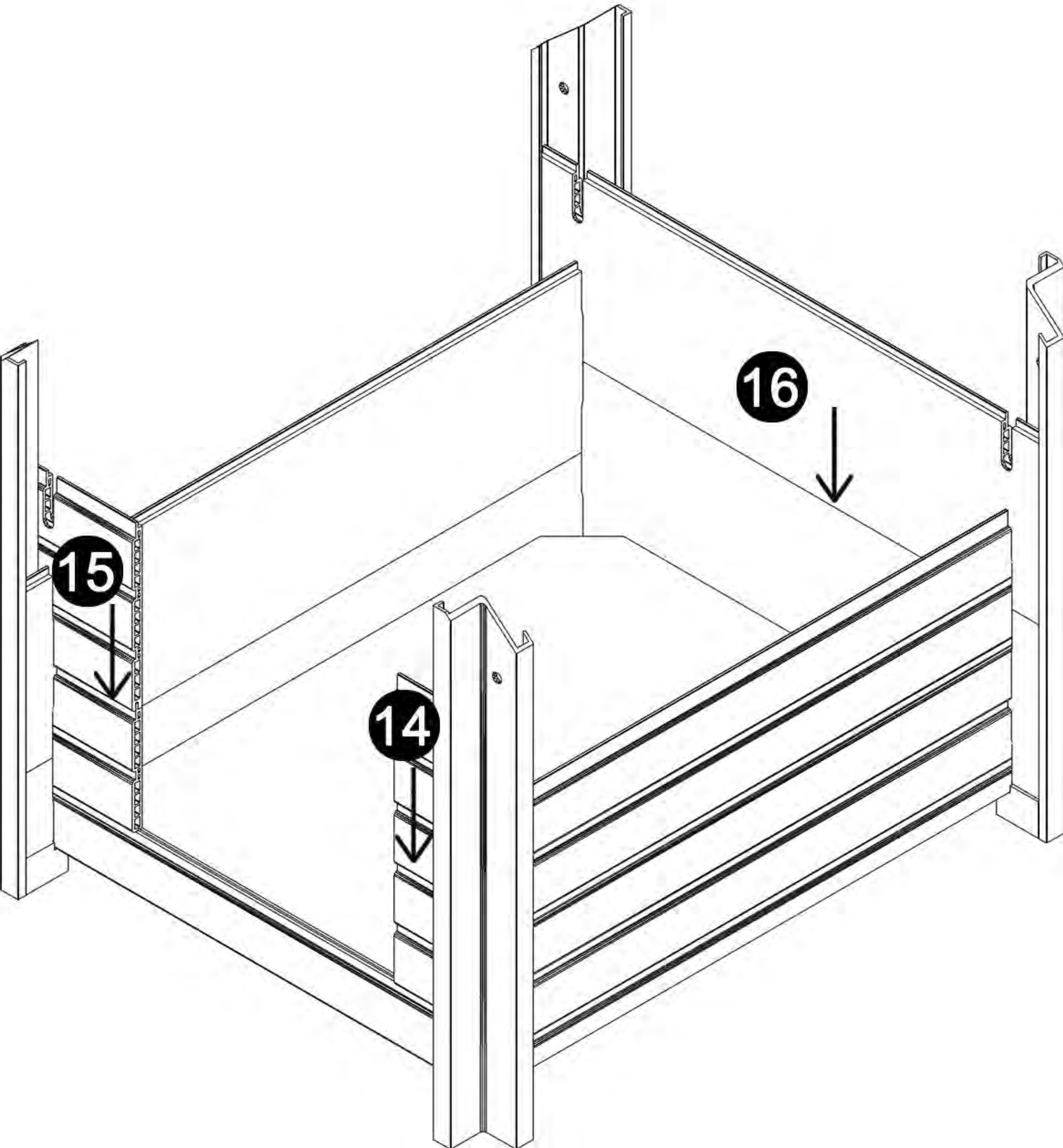
Hold panel ⑪ at the two corner cutouts. Slightly angle ⑪ into ⑩. Release panel ⑪, then gently push it down.



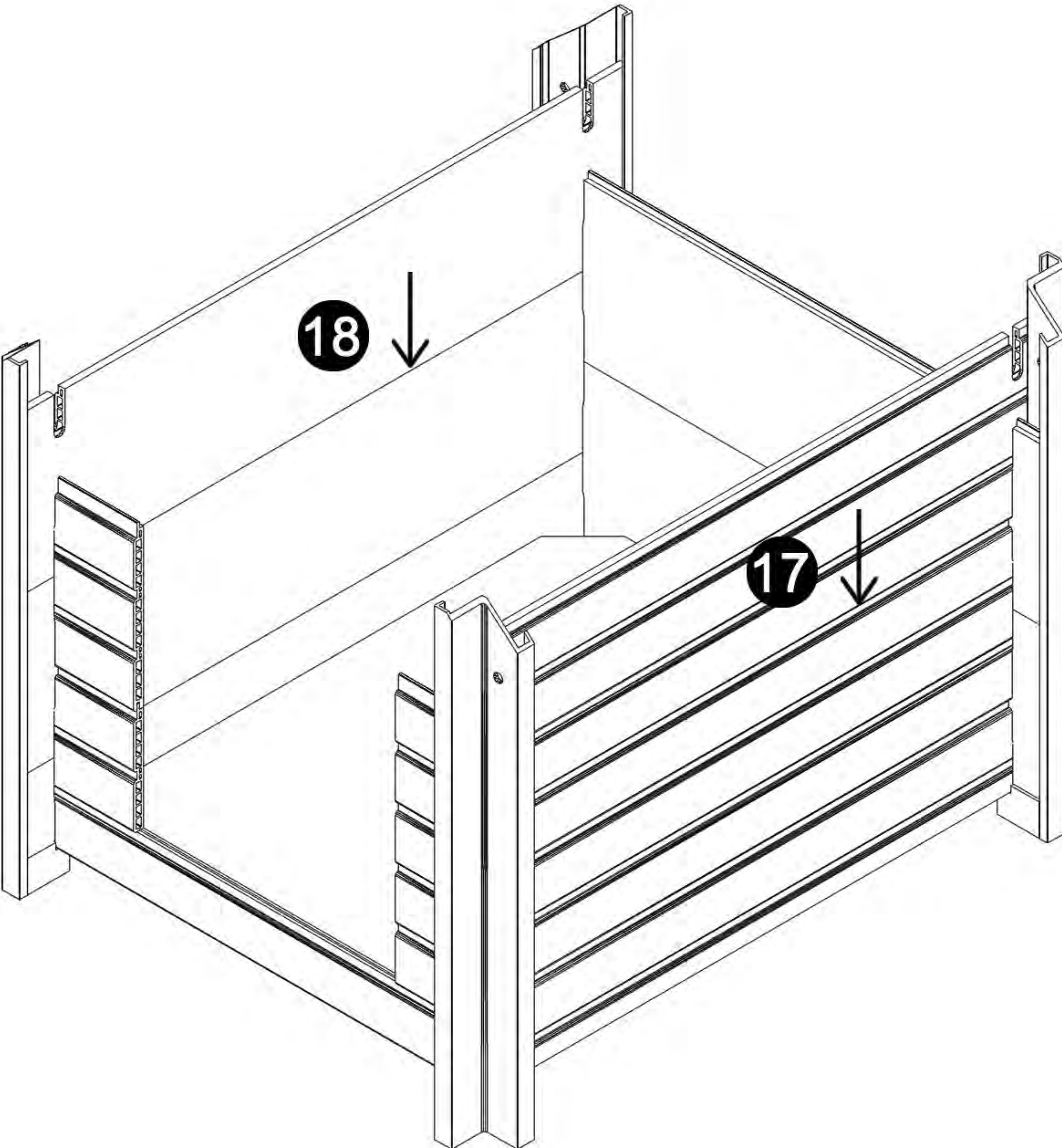

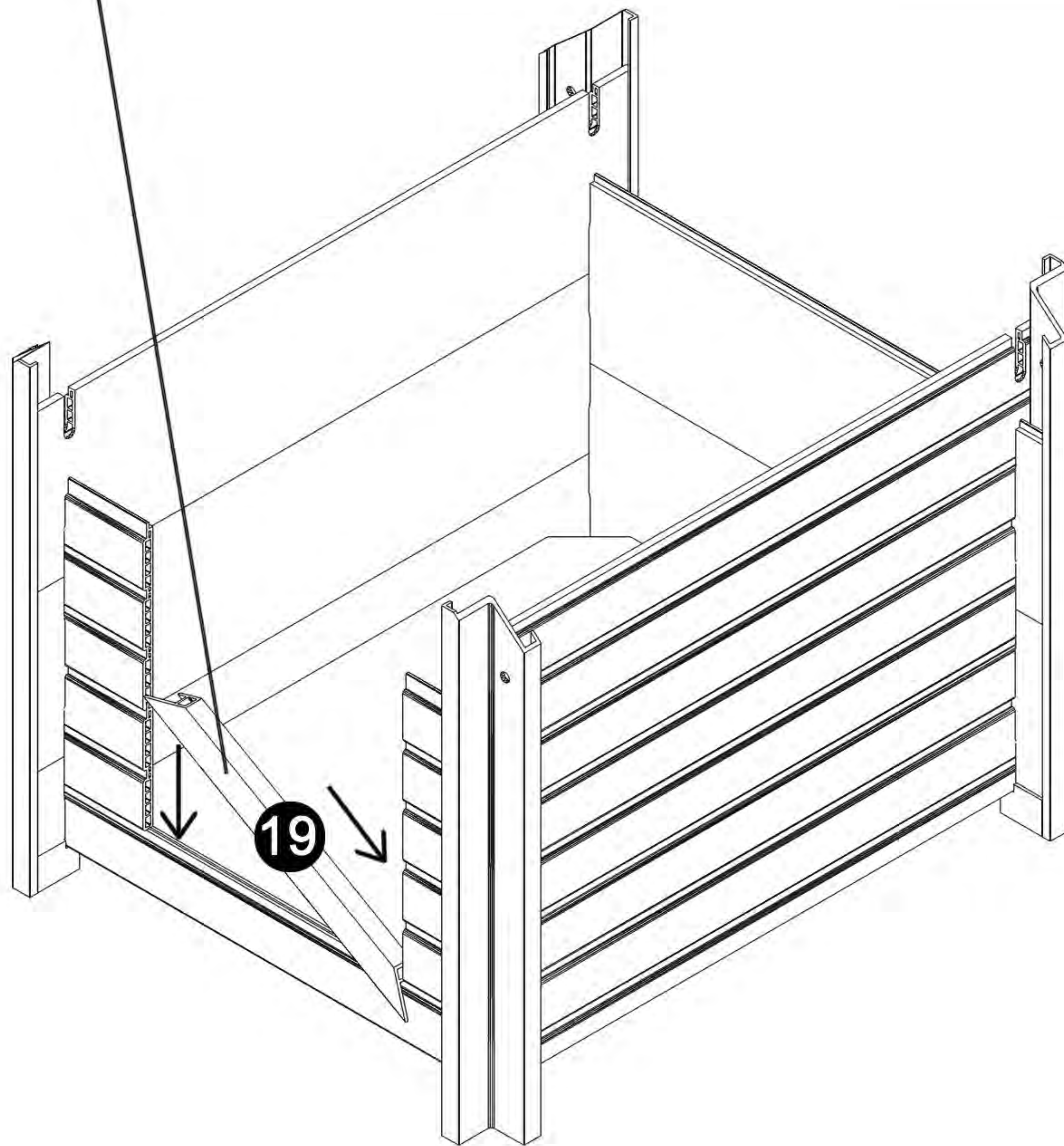

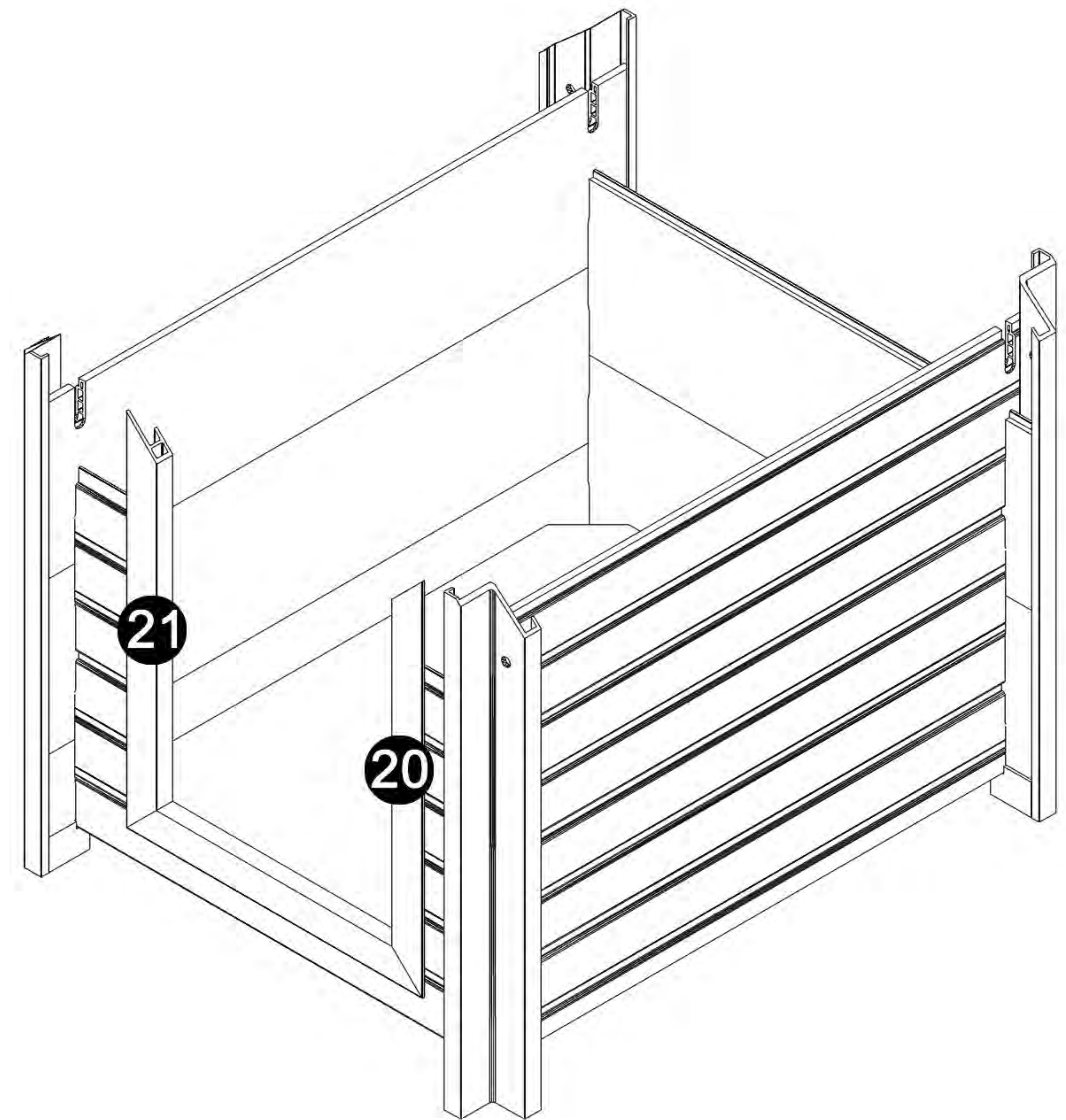

Place door frame ①9 into one of the lower corners of the door opening, then push the other end down gently. The side of the frame piece with part # bar code should be facing inside the barn. Same for all door frame pieces.

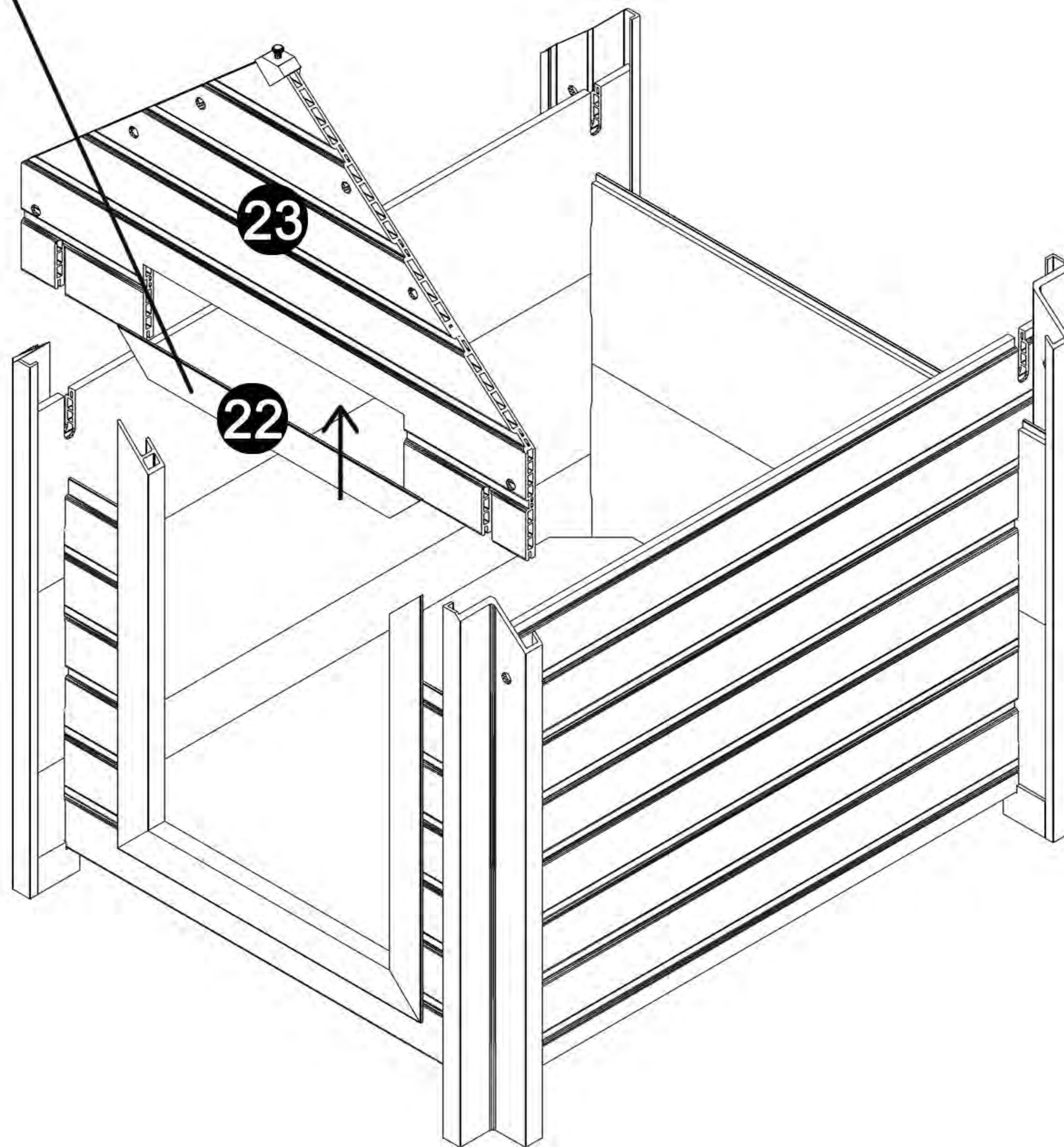

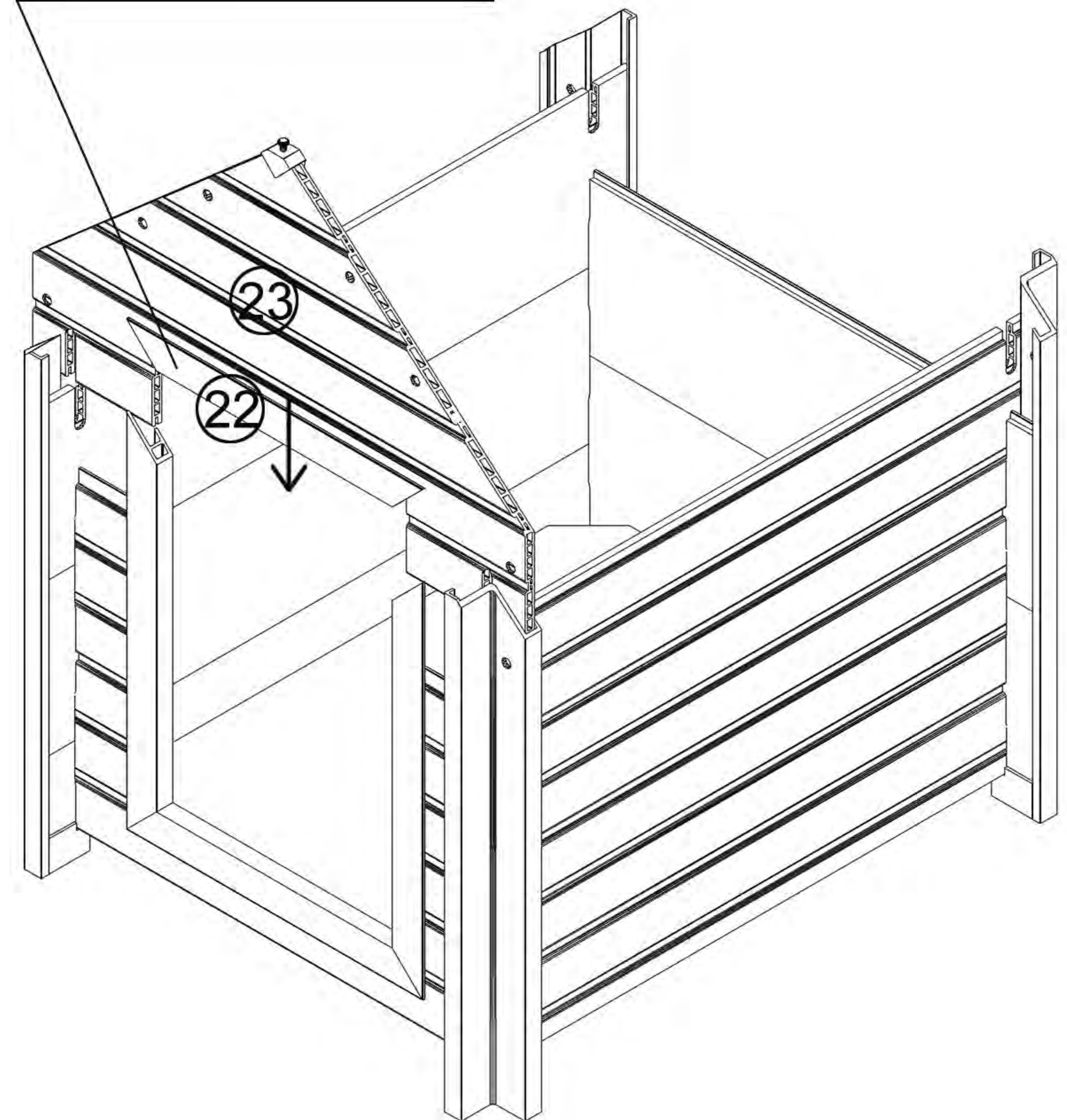

Attach door frame (22) to panel (23) in the same fashion as Step 14.

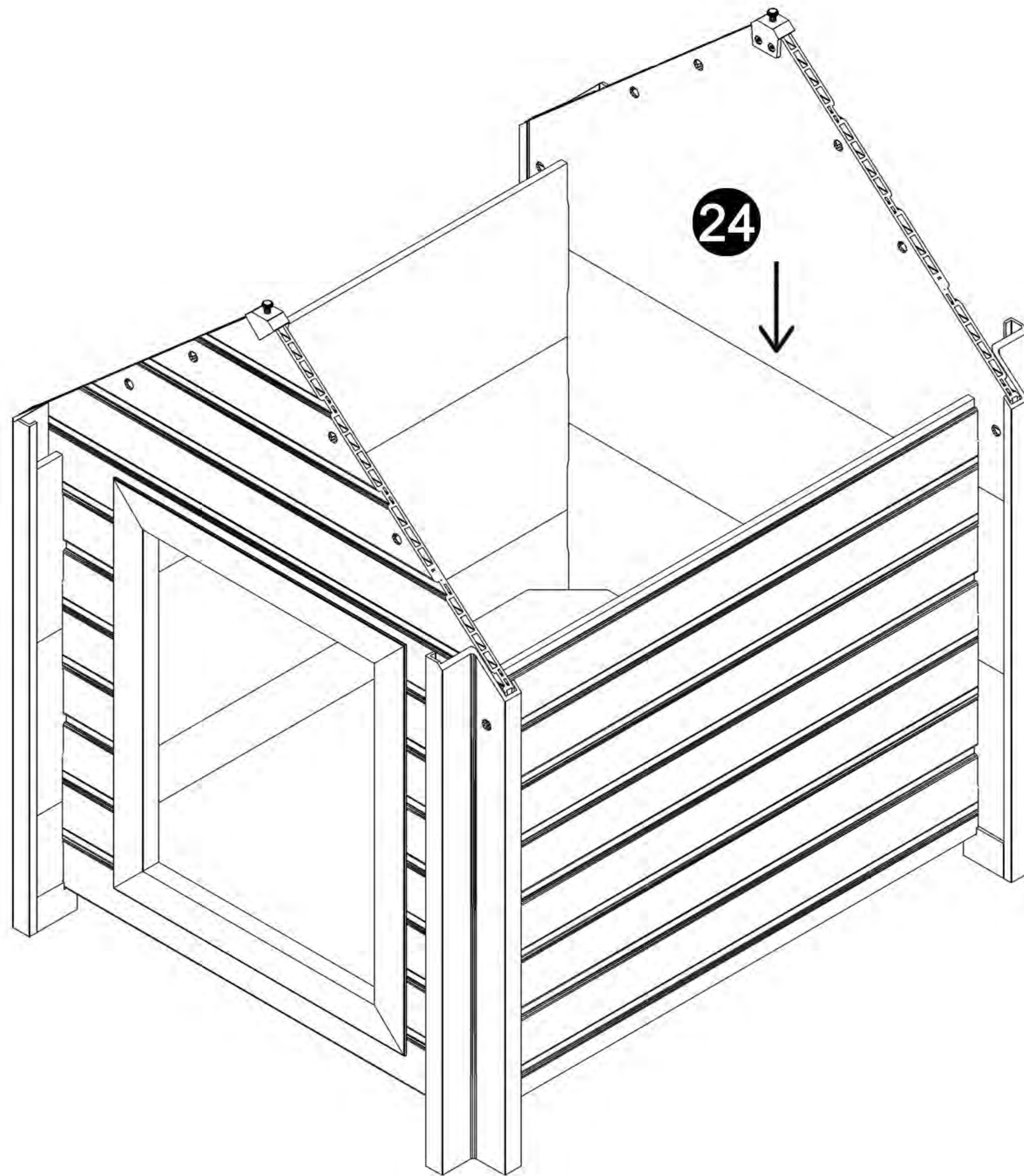

Hold door frame (22) and wall panel (23) together, insert wall panel (23) into place.

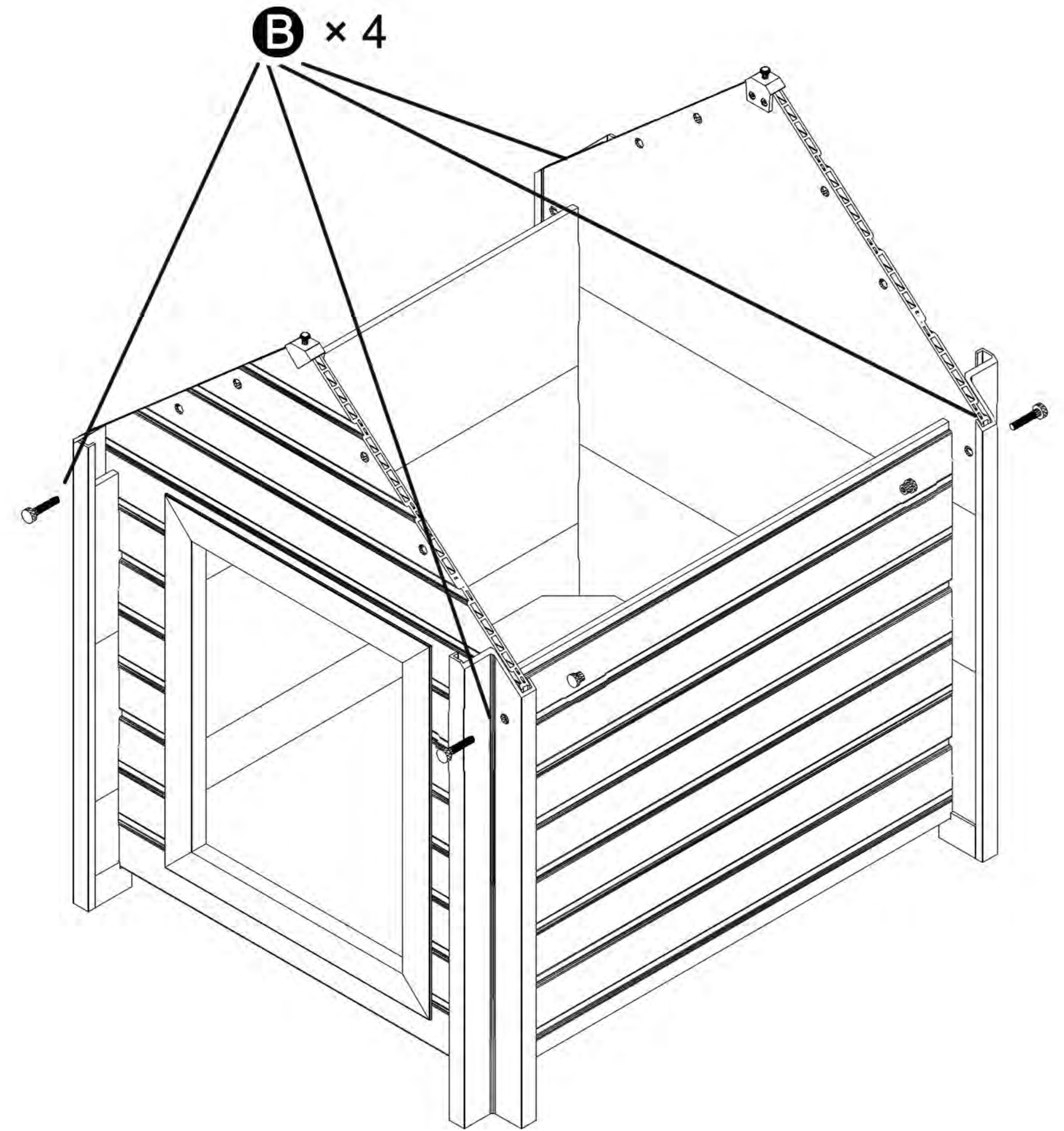

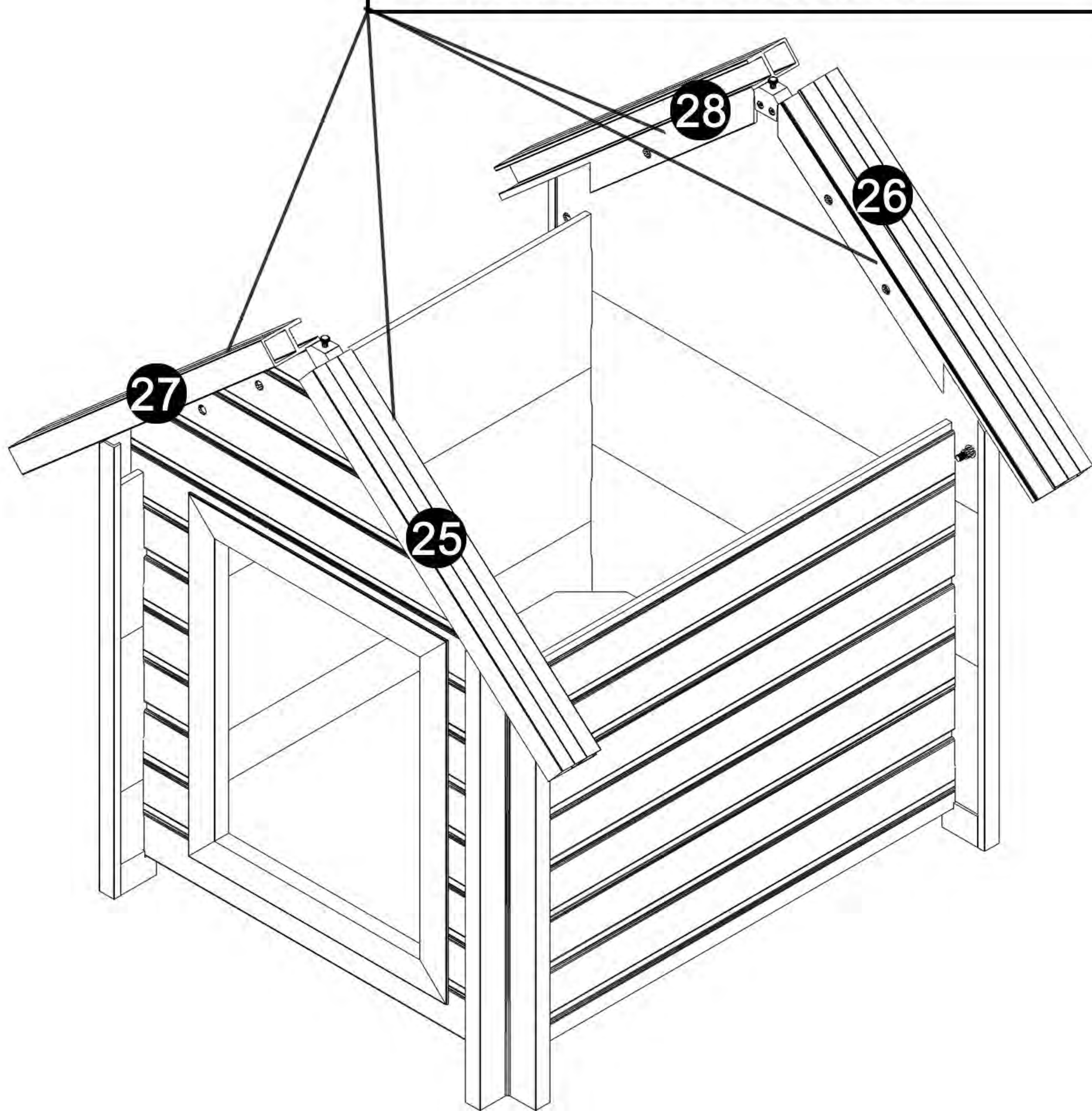

Note: If available, use screws with matching color as the corner posts.



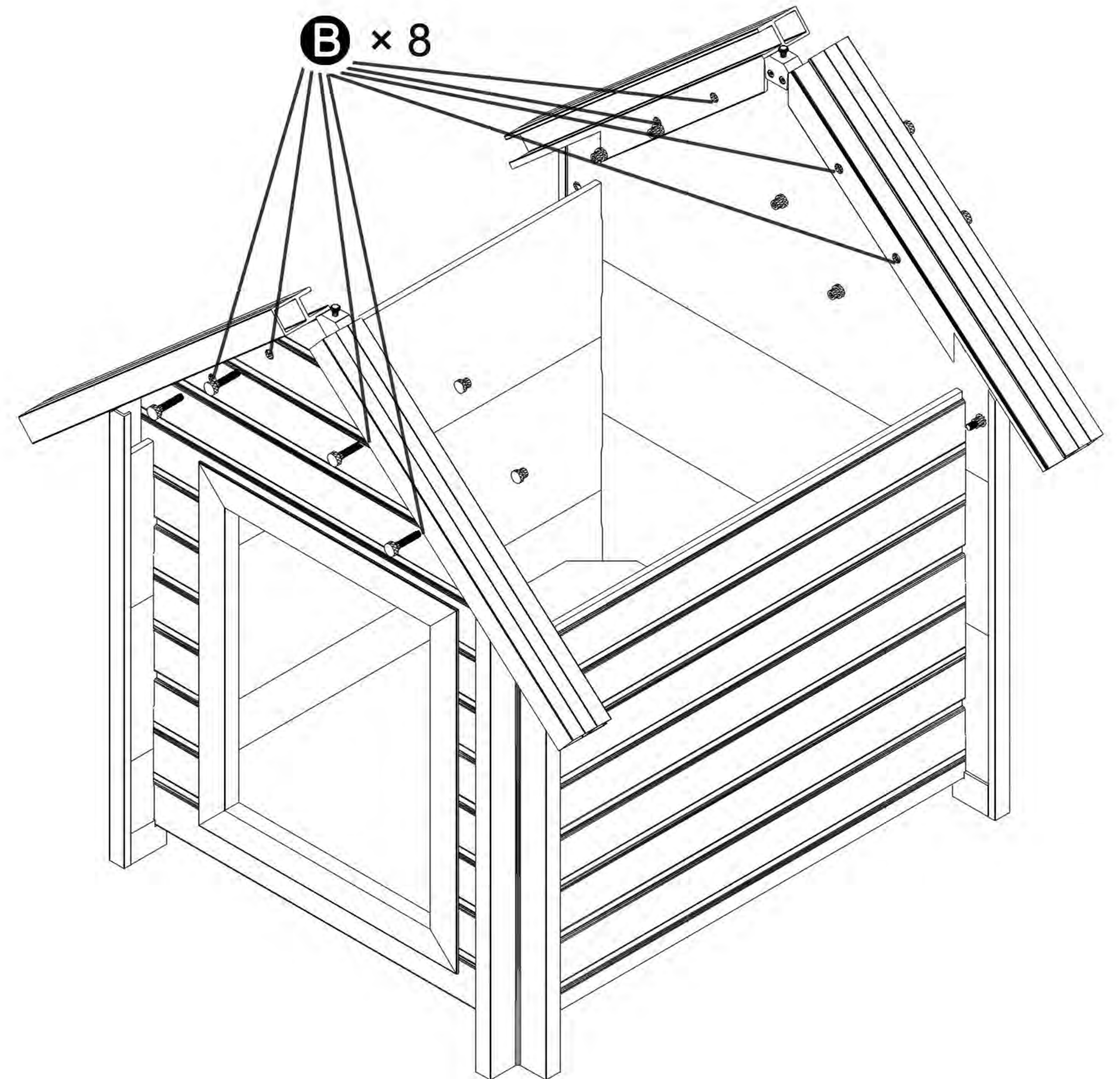
Step 20.

Parts ②⑤, ②⑥, ②⑦ and ②⑧ should be installed with the flange attaching to the inside of the wall panels.

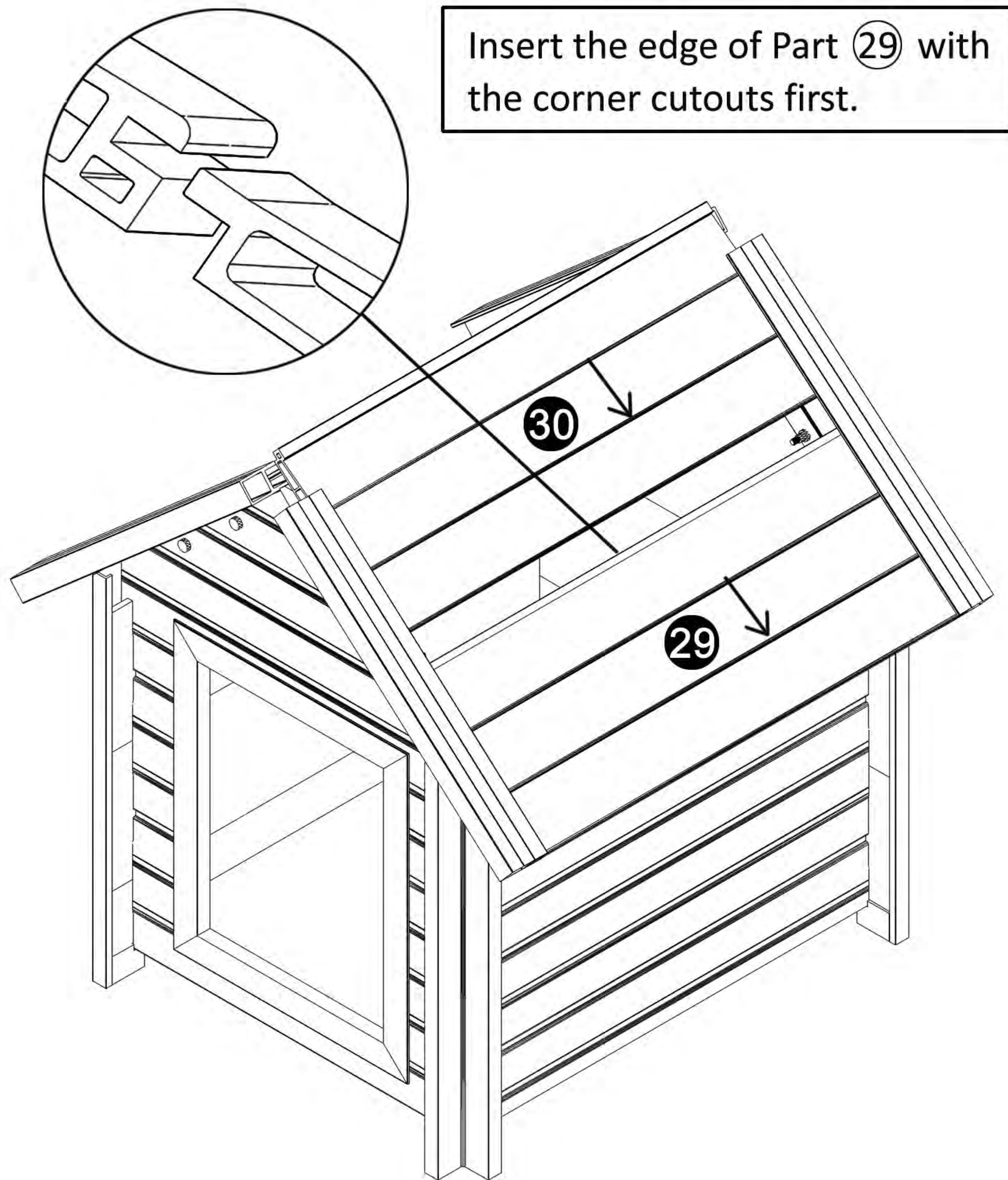

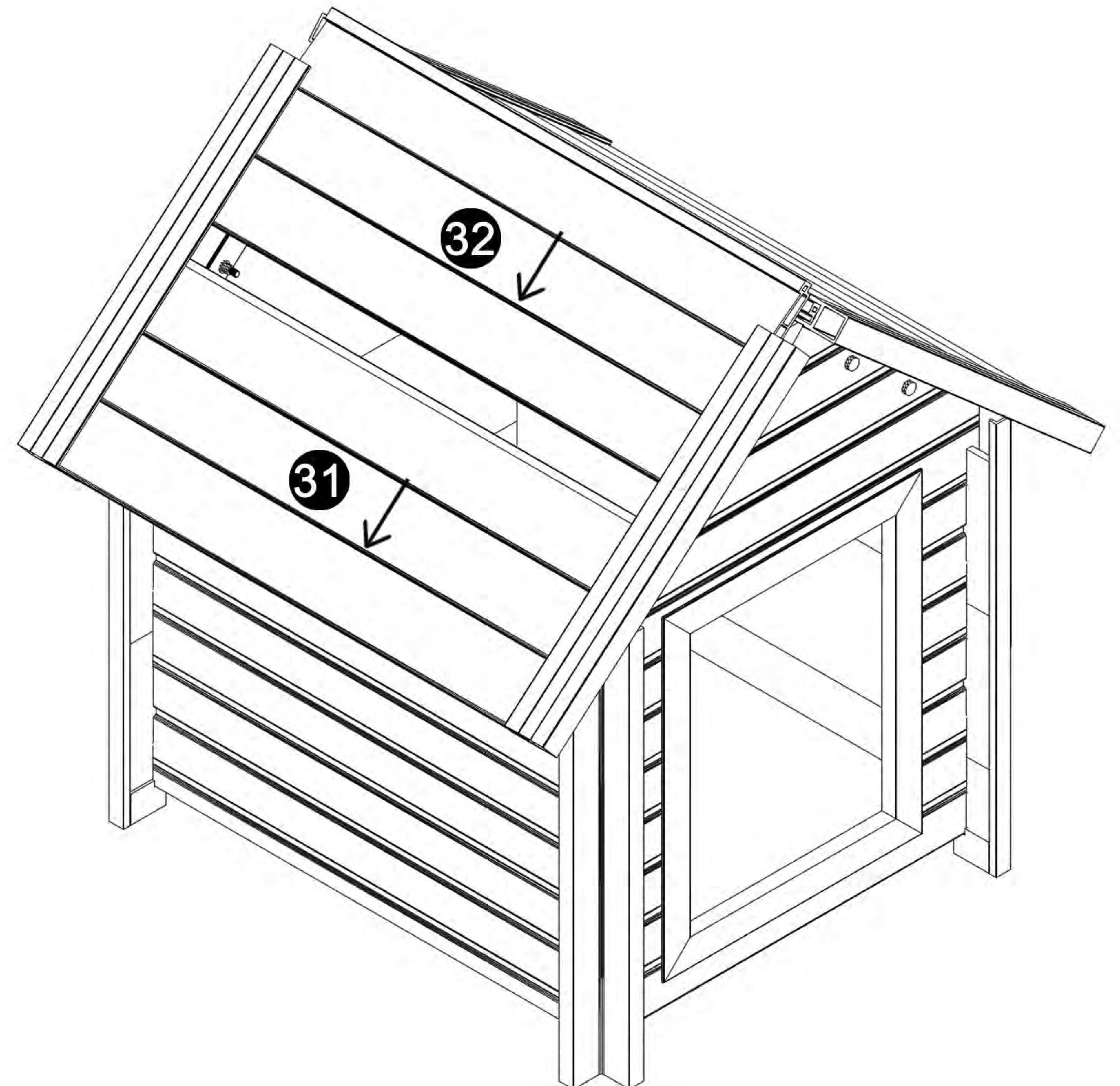
Note: If available, use natural wood color screws to match the wall panels.

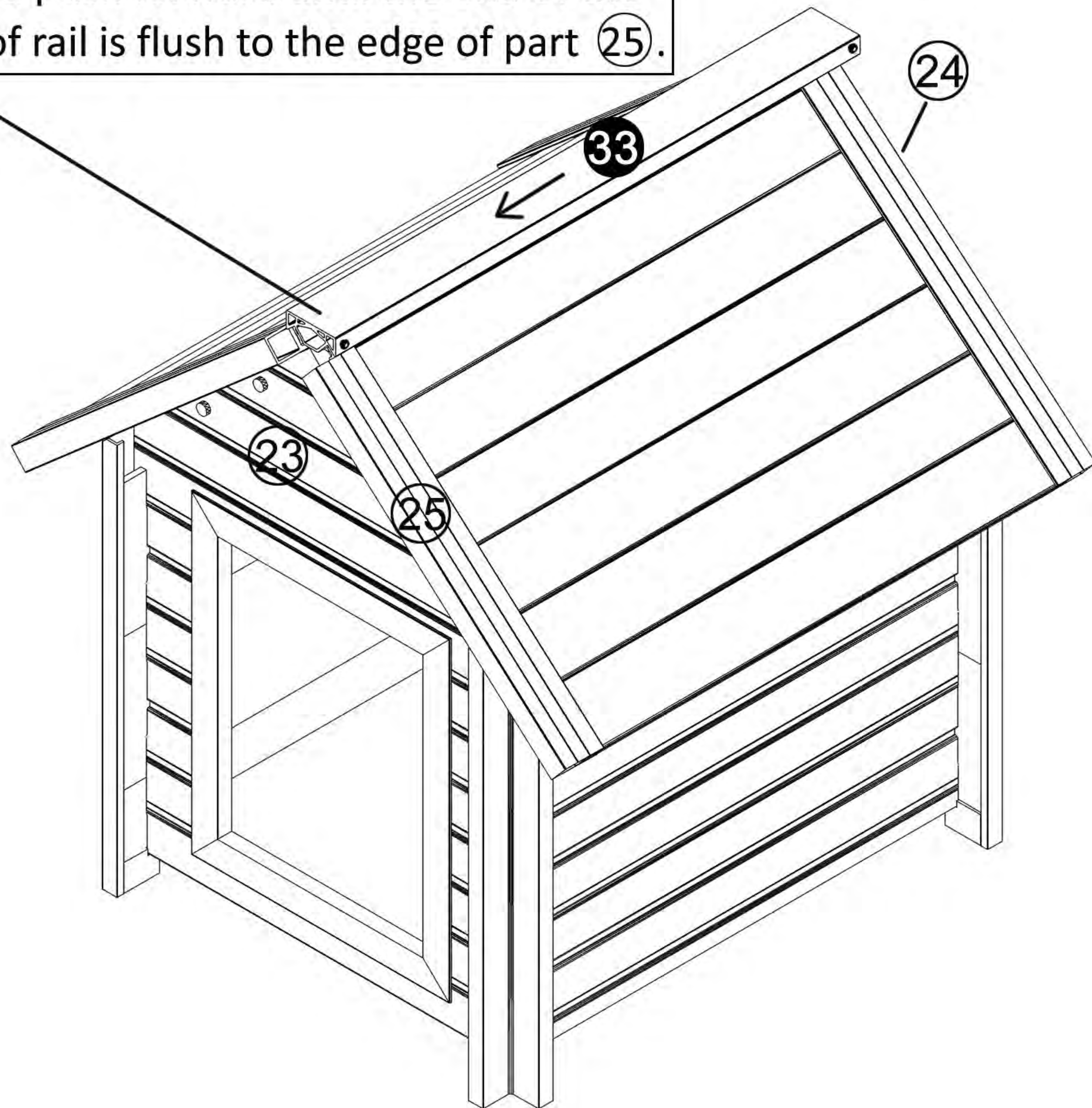

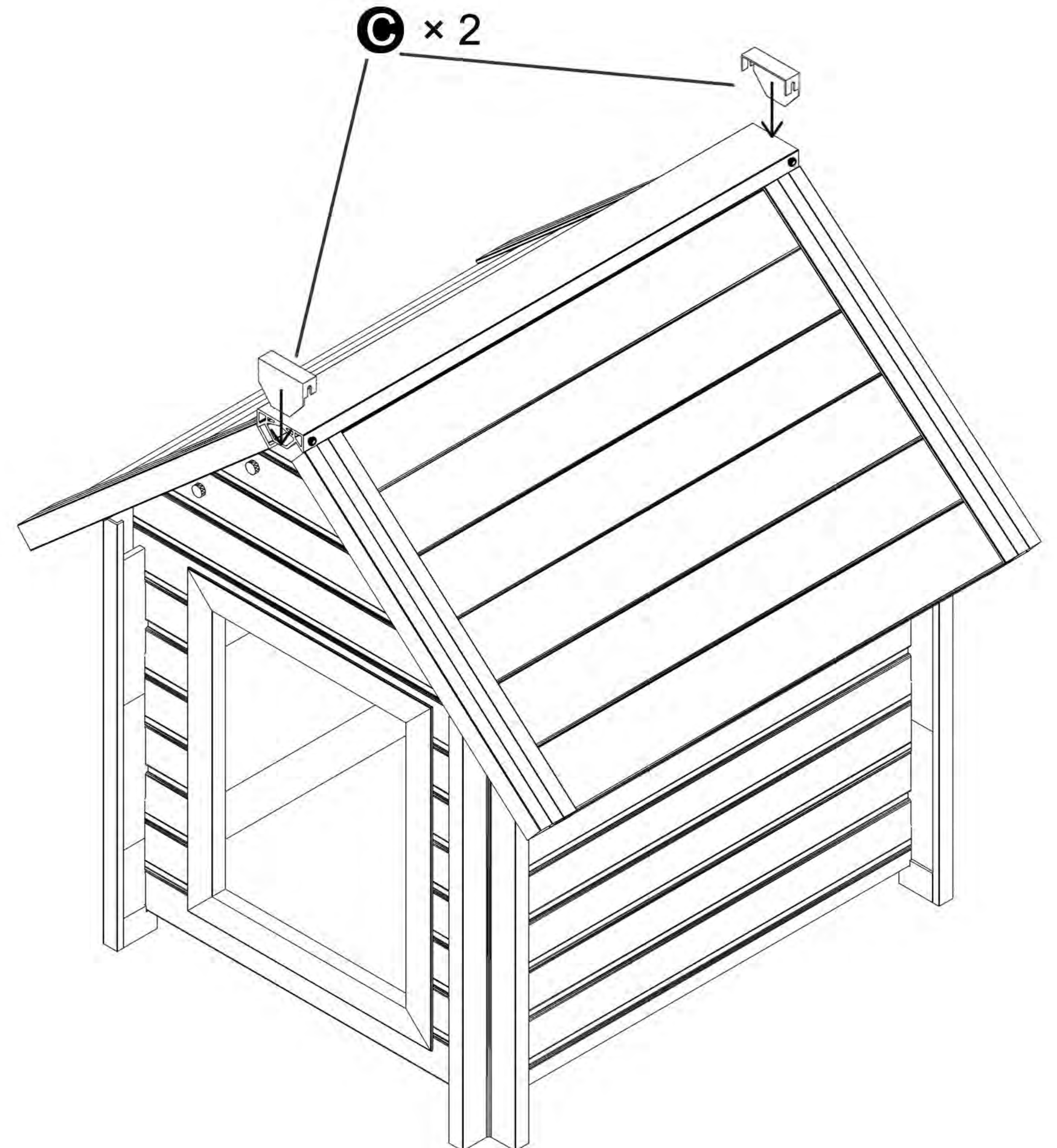

Align the keyhole openings on the roof rail (33) to the metal connectors at the peak of parts (23) and (24). Press down and push forward until the end of the roof rail is flush to the edge of part (25).

Cleaning Instruction

It is very important to keep the dog house clean for the benefit of your beloved pet. The Easy to Assemble design of all NewAgePet homes will be appreciated when it is time to clean your pet's home.

Remove one side of the roof panels by reversing the last 3 steps of the assembly instruction. You now have access to the entire inside of the house.

We recommend using a detergent with strong grease cutting capabilities and safe to use around you, your kids and your pet. After washing, rinse and then wipe down the panels. Don't forget to clean the inside of the roof panels. Allow the interior to air dry thoroughly and reassemble.

Once the house is clean and dry, re-assemble the roof panels.

Painting Instruction

- Tape off all pins/connectors and keyhole slots. Be sure to keep paint off and out of these areas to make assembly easy.
- Prime all surfaces that you want to paint with a primer that is to be used with exterior latex paint. Priming is not a requirement but it is highly recommended. It will provide better coverage when you apply the paint and your paint job will last longer and look better.
- After the primer has dried – check the instructions on the primer to determine the time between application of the primer and when it is ready for paint – apply a minimum of 2 coats of a good to better quality exterior latex based paint.
- You can paint the roof and side panels different colors. As well, the vertical stiles can be a different color than the horizontal field. If you are going to paint, get creative!
- Allow the panels to DRY COMPLETELY before you assemble the house.

Staining Instruction

- Tape off all pins/connectors and keyhole slots. Be sure to keep paint off and out of these areas to make assembly easy.
- Use a good to better quality oil based stain for the job. Let the stain set for about 5-7 minutes and wipe off the excess stain. If the color is lighter than the effect you are looking for repeat until you get the color you want.
- Allow the panels to DRY COMPLETELY before you assemble the house.
