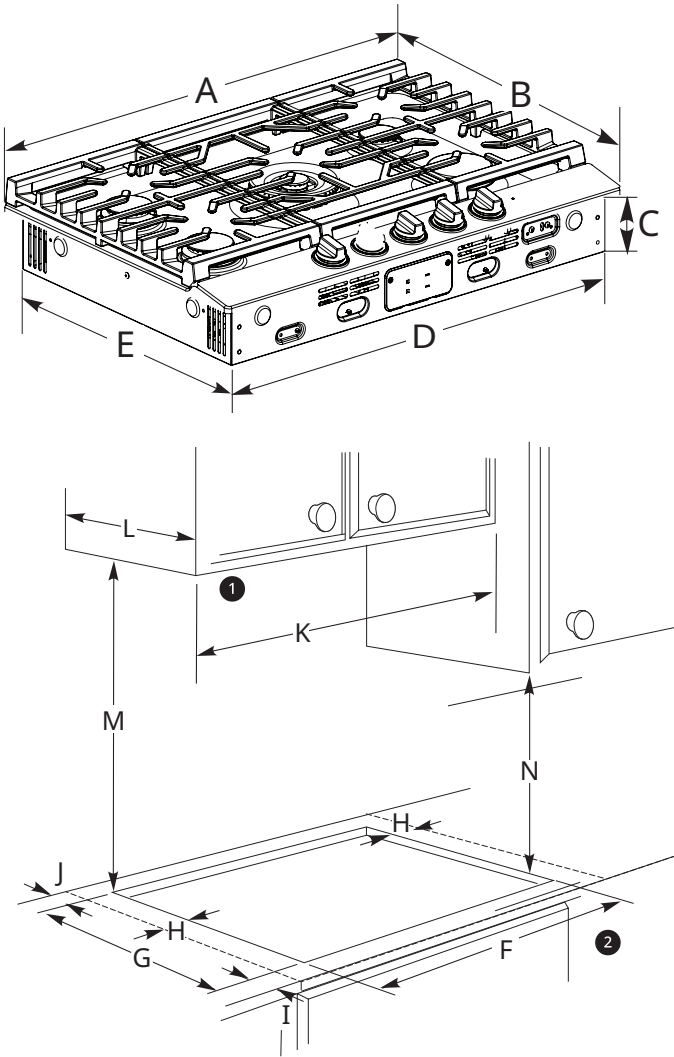

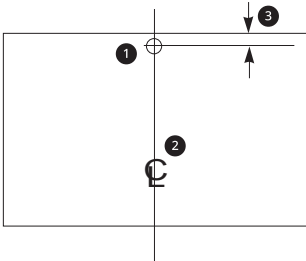

PRODUCT DIMENSIONS



- 1 Make sure wall coverings, countertop and cabinets around cooktop can withstand the heat (up to 200°F) generated by the cooktop
- 2 To ensure accuracy, it is best to make a template when cutting the opening in the counter

- 1 Recommended gas supply location
- 2 From cutout center line
- 3 1" min. from back wall



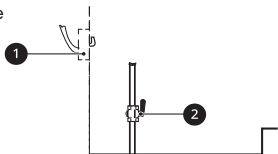
DIMENSION / CLEARANCE

Provide enough clearance between the cooktop and adjacent combustible surfaces. These dimensions must be met for safe use of your cooktop. The location of the electrical outlet and pipe opening may be adjusted to meet specific requirements. The cooktop must be placed with at least 2 3/4" of clearance to the back wall.

J	Distance between cutout and the wall behind the cooktop	≥ 2 3/4" (69 mm)
K	Width of unprotected overhead cabinets	≥ 30" (760mm)
L	Depth of unprotected overhead cabinets	≤ 13" (330 mm)
M	Clearance from countertop to unprotected overhead surface	≥ 30" (760 mm)
N	Clearance from countertop to nearest cabinet on either side of unit	≥ 18" (457 mm)

INSTALLATION

1. Locate the electrical outlet and gas shut-off valve in the cabinet beneath the cooktop.
The access cap on the gas regulator must face the front of the cabinet and be easily accessible.
Never reuse old flexible connectors.
Install a manual shut-off valve 1 in the gas line in an easily accessible location outside the cooktop.
Be sure you know how and where to shut off the gas supply to the cooktop.
Install the electrical outlet 12" 2 below the countertop.



2. Carefully lower the cooktop into the countertop cutout, making sure not to trap any wires.
3. Remove the retainer brackets from the literature package
4. Install the retainer brackets 1 to the bottom of the cooktop unit 3, then snug the screws 2 against the bottom of the countertop 4 as shown.
