
- 4. Remove the set screw located at the point where the cable attaches to the towel warmer and cut the cable at 10" from the towel warmer rack.
- 5. Feed cable through the cover tube (H) and attach tube to the frame using the screw that had been previously removed, slip the junction box cover plate (L) over the cover tube (H).
- 6. Place towel rack at the desired location, with a pencil, mark the location of the 4 mounting tubes (G) as well as the location of the electrical junction insert the appropriate anchors for your type of wall and secure the support cores (K) to the wall using enclosed screws (D).
- 7. Install electrical junction box at the marked location.
- 8. Place towel warmer on the wall, by inserting the mounting tubes over the support cores and attach using the set screws (F) tighten with an Allen wrench.
- 9. Make your electrical connection and install towel warmer on the wall, by inserting the mounting tubes over the support cores and attach using the set screws (F) tighten with an Allen wrench.
- 10. Fasten the cover plate (L) to the junction box using enclosed screws (C).



#### Operation and maintenance instruction

- Once the unit is plugged in, turn the unit on, a red indicator light will let you know it is warming.
- This unit is designed to run continuously.
- Turn off when you are done, the indicator light will turn off, letting you know it is no longer in warming mode.
- You may clean it with a soft dry towel.



# **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS** Freestanding, Hardwire & Wall Mount Electric Towel Warmer

#### Before Installation:

- Review Installation instructions carefully.
- This towel warmer requires 120VAC-60HZ, grounded power supply and should be protected by a dedicated 15 amp circuit breaker or equivalent.
- According to NEC and NFPA regulations all electrical work must be performed by a "Qualified" person.
- Please follow applicable construction codes and electrical wiring regulations, especially those pertaining to installation of electrical products in potentially damp areas.
- When selecting the location for the installation of this product, it is best to install in a location where it will be out of reach to unsupervised small children or subject to accidental contact by elderly or disabled persons.
- This product is designed for residential use exclusively and not intended to be installed inside a shower stall. steam room or submerged in water.
- Do not install this towel warmer on a wall over a tub.
- Do not let power supply cord come in contact with the towel warmer's surface.
- Carefully open package to avoid damage or loss of any parts, inspect contents and confirm that all components are included, do not attempt to assemble unless you have all the parts shown on image.

  If you suspect any possible malfunction please unplug or shut off any power supply to this unit immediately
- and contact the manufacturer.


# Assembly and installation Instructions

## For Freestanding models:


- 1. After putting a blanket on the floor place towel warmer rack upside down on top of the blanket.
- 2. Place the coupling nut (I) on top of the leg with the concave side up, place curved leg (J) on top of coupling adapter (I) and secure using the enclosed Allen screw (A).



The surfaces on this towel warmer will be hot; do not allow unsupervised children or elderly persons near this device as it can cause severe burns.






#### For Plug-in models:

- 1. After putting a blanket on the floor place towel warmer rack face down on top of the blanket.
- 2. Remove the decorative cover and screws from the back of the towel warmer.
- 3. Attach the 4 mounting tubes (G) to the back of the rack by inserting the Allen screws (B) and securing using an Allen wrench.
- 4. Place towel rack at the desired location, with a pencil, mark the location of the 4 mounting tubes (G) on the wall and insert the appropriate anchors (E) for your type of wall and secure the support cores (K) to the wall using enclosed screws (D).



- 5. Place towel warmer on the wall, by inserting the mounting tubes over the support cores and attach using the set screws (F) tighten with an Allen wrench.
- 6. For plug in models, just plug into a dedicated outlet.



#### For Hardwire models:

- After putting a blanket on the floor place towel warmer rack face down on top of the blanket.
- 2. Remove the decorative cover and screws from the back of the towel warmer.
- 3. Attach the 4 mounting tubes (G) to the back of the rack by inserting the Allen screws (B) and securing using an Allen wrench.
