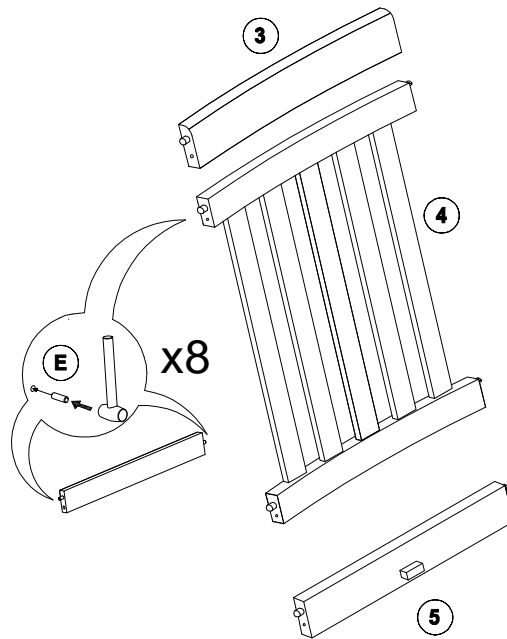
IMPORTANT NOTE :

- Keep all hardware parts out of reach of children.
- **DO NOT TIGHTEN BOLTS/SCREWS UNTIL ALL COMPLETELY ASSEMBLED.**

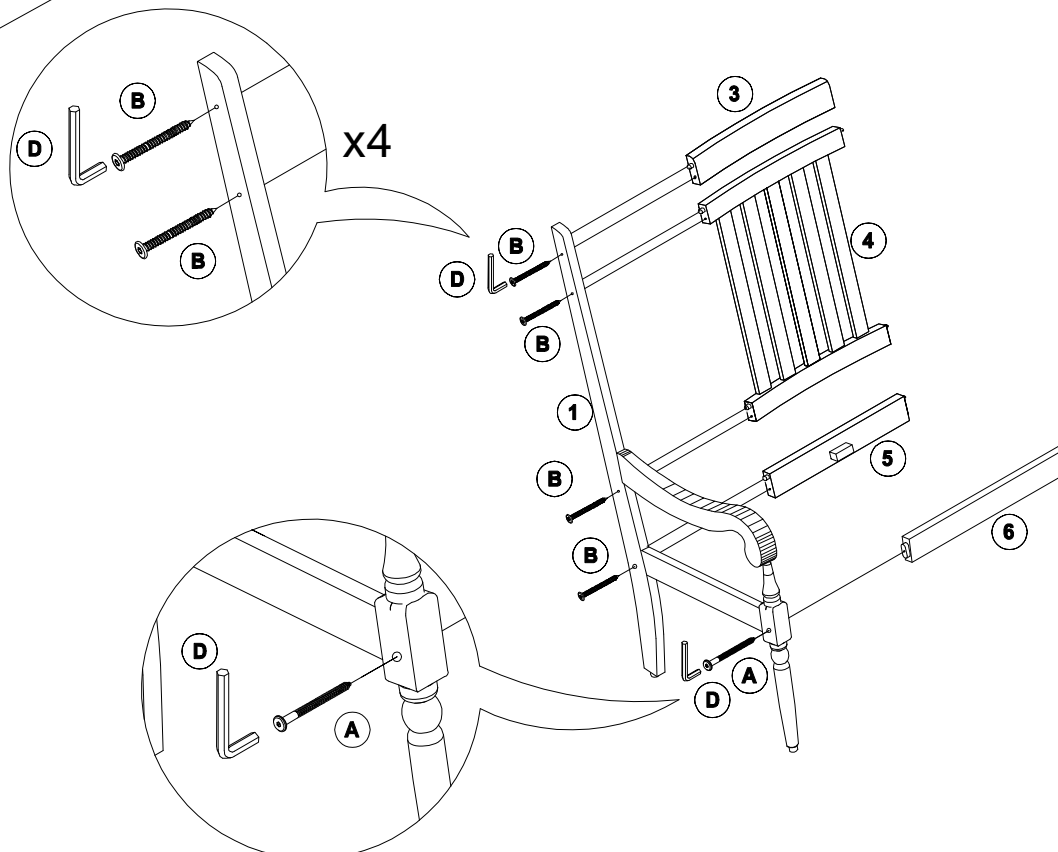

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- The touch of a soft cloth is all the maintenance your wood pieces will ever need. Never use harsh chemical or abrasive cleaners, as they could mark or destroy finish.
- Bolts, screws, and nuts may loosen during everyday use. They should be periodically inspected and re-tightened. Always visually check that all hardware on the list is attached and kept tightened.
