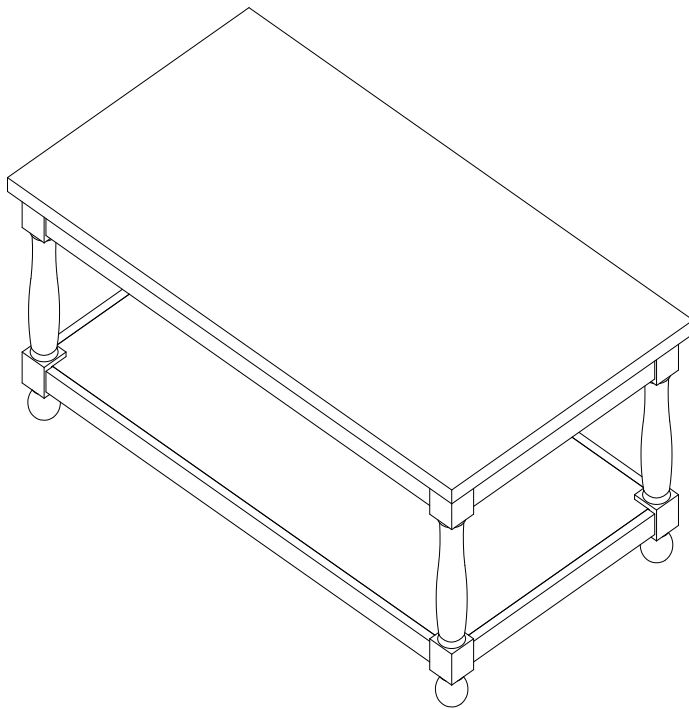
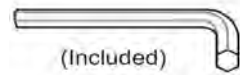

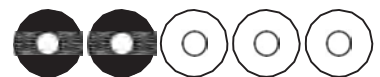

damage during assembly.



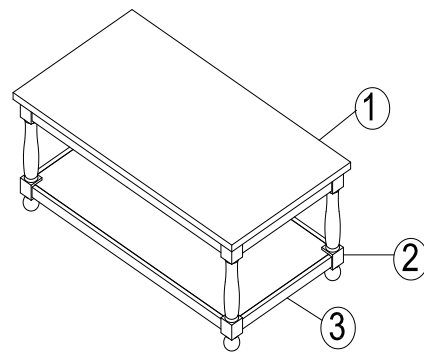
After two weeks, check and
