


*VanZyverden's*

They perennialize nicely, providing a splash of color.

*Growing Instructions:* To ensure optimal results, allow adequate space, sunlight, plant at the appropriate depth, feed with a well balanced fertilizer, allowing the leaves to yellow/brown before removing.

*Care Tip:* Crocus can be successfully grown in a lawn for a spring meadow effect. Hold off on mowing the lawn in spring until the Crocus foliage begins to die back.

*Exposure:* Full sun to partial shade

*Height:* Grows 4-6" tall

*Spacing:* Plant 2-3" apart, 2-4" deep

*USDA Zones:* Hardy in USDA zones 3-9
