Caution: This Adirondack is NOT a TOY.


Keep your child / children at bay during the assembly process. Whenever moving or lifting the Adirondack and to prevent any possible damage to it, two adults are needed to execute this action.

# **Assembly Preparation**

Before Beginning Assembly:

Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




• Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-




Save all packaging until finished-


## **Assembly Steps**



This Adirondack has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Adirondack parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.




Place the Seat Panel(A) onto a clean, non-marring surface.

Position the KD Slat( $\hat{F}$ ) onto the Seat Panel(A) using Screws(4) and a Screwdriver (7) as shown above

#### Do not fully tighten the Screws

#### Step 3




Turn the assemble in step 2 upside down as shown above.

Attach the Pre-fixed Front Leg( C) to the Seat Panel(A) using Bolts (1) Plastic

Washers (⑤), Sleeve Nuts (②) and the Allen Wrench (⑥) as shown above **Do not fully tighten Bolts.** 

Note:Plastic Washers should be placed between the Seat Panel and Front Leg.




Turn the Frame in Step 3 back right side up and place it in the position as shown in the picture above.

Attach the Folding Support Bar(G) to the Seat Panel(A) using Bolts (①), Plastic Washers (⑤), Sleeve Nuts (②) and the Allen Wrench (⑥).

Do not fully tighten Bolts.


Note: A Plastic Washer should be placed between the Seat Panel and the Folding Support Bar.



Position the Backrest (B) with mortise into the housing of the Folding Support Bar (G) as shown in the picture above.

Secure the Folding Support Bar(G) to the Backrest (B) using Screws (\$) and the Allen Wrench (\$) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten Screws




Open the Backrest(B) as shown in the picture above:

- **6.1)** Secure the Left Armrest (E) to the Backrest (B) using Screws (3) and the Allen Wrench (6)
- **6.2)** Secure the Left Armrest (E) to the Pre-fixed Front Leg (C) using Bolts
- (1), Plastic Washers (5), Sleeve Nuts (2) and the Allen Werench (1)


Do not fully tighten Bolts and Screws.

Repeat the same process with the Right Armrest (D)



With the help of your adult partner, turn the Adirondack on its right side, then attach the Tray (H) onto the Seat Panel (A) using Screws (4) and the Screwdriver (7) as shown above.


Do not fully tighten Screws.



In a sequential manner, tighten all Bolts and Screws at all joints until fully locked into position.

Your Adirondack is ready for use.

This Adirondack can only be used on a flat, level surface.



This Adirondack can be folded shut.

**To fold** this Adirondack, raise up the Backrest and fold the Seat with the Leg Frame as indicated by the arrows, until the Adirondack folds shut.

**To open** this Adirondack, open the Backrest and Seat as indicated by the arrows, until the Adirondack folds out and locks into position.

Note: This Adirondack is slightly heavy, do exercise caution to avoid injury.

### Care & Maintenance
