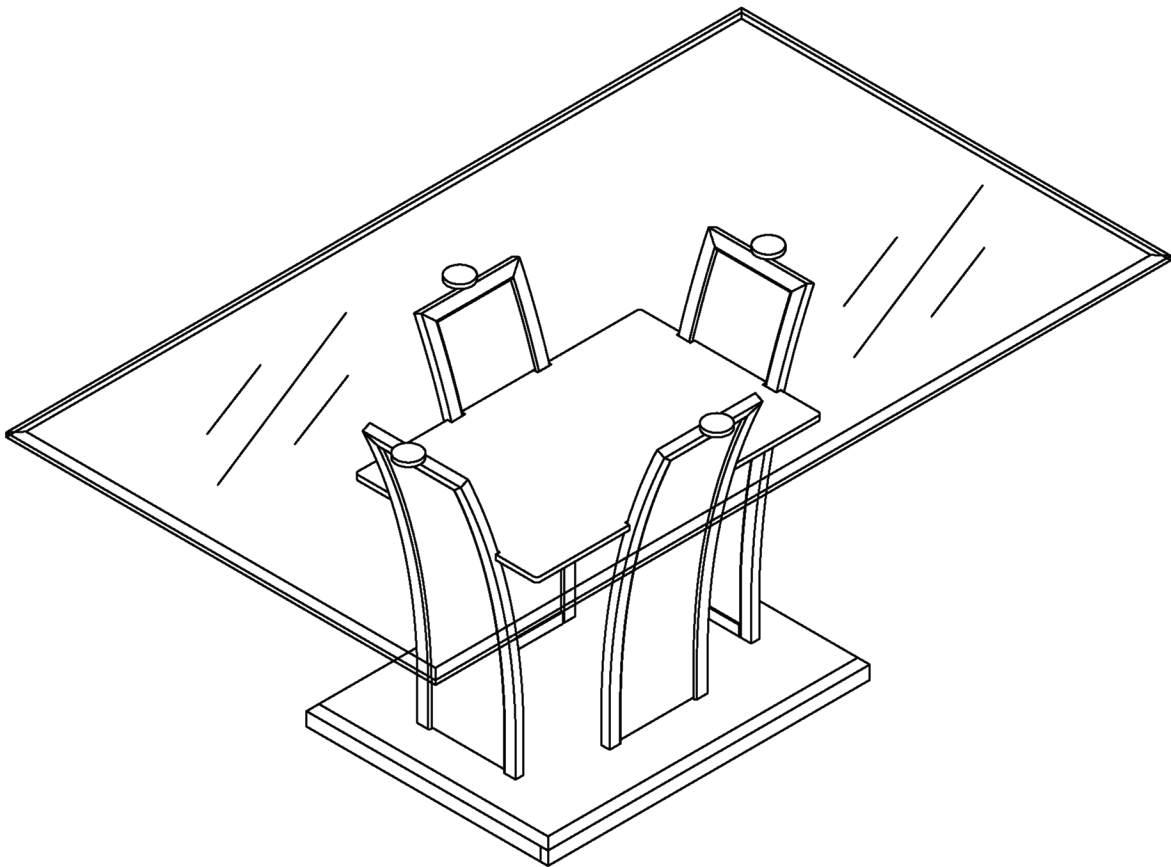


Assembly Instructions



ASSEMBLY RATING

The Assembly Rating is a 5-point system that shows the degree of effort needed in assembling a specific product (with 1 being easy and 5 being difficult). For some products, two persons are recommended.

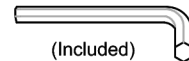

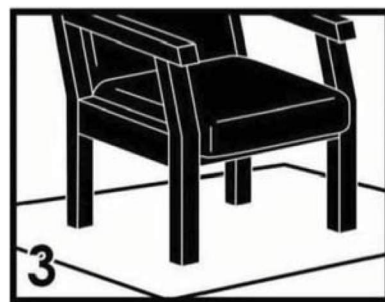
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



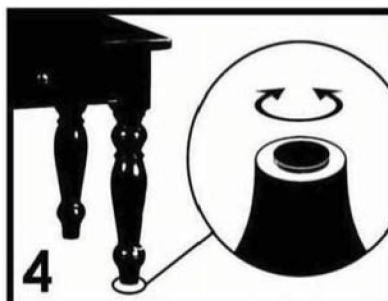
When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



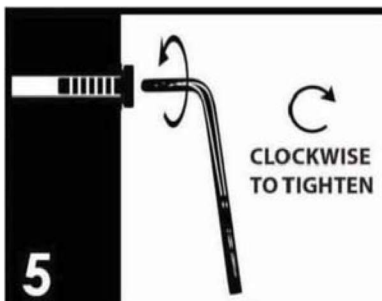
Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.



Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

2. Align the leg support frame (#3) to the holes along the center of the leg stands (#2). Insert 2 bolts (#B) into each end. Secure using the Allen wrench (#F).

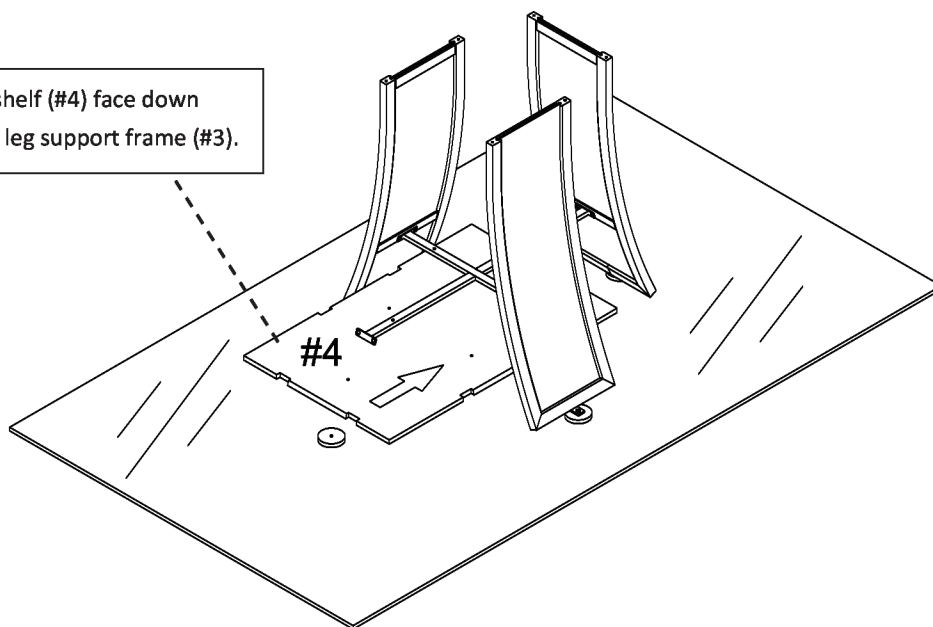

1. Place the glass top (#1) face down onto a protected surface. Align three leg stands (#2) to the holes along the glass top (#1). Insert a bolt (#B) into each hole. Secure using the Allen wrench (#F).



Slide the shelf (#4) face down under the leg support frame (#3).

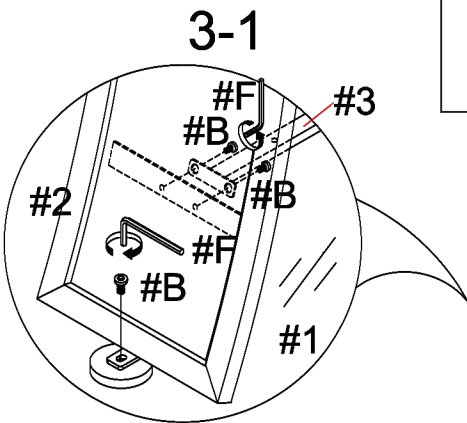

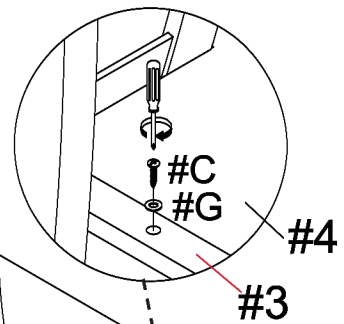
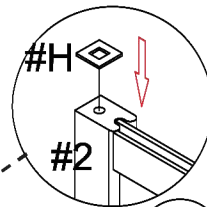

1. Align the fourth leg stand (#2) to the holes, then insert a bolt (#B) into the bottom hole and 2 bolts (#B) into the holes along the leg support frame (#3). Secure using the Allen wrench (#F).

3. Place the plastic gaskets (#H) onto the bottom ends of the leg stands.

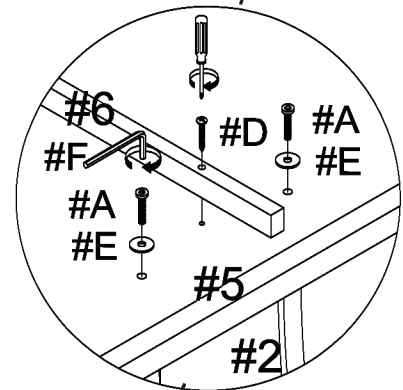
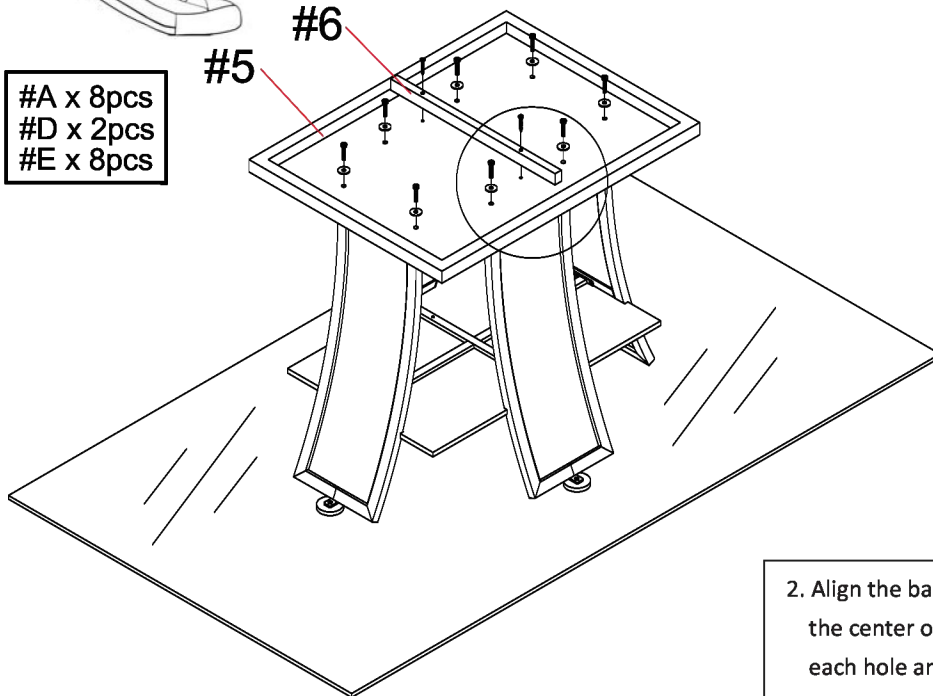


2. Prepare 4 screws by inserting a flat washer (#G) onto the screws (#C), then lift and align the shelf (#4) to the leg support frame (#3). Insert a screw assembly into each and secure using a screwdriver.



1. Place the base (#5) face down onto the leg stands (#2). Prepare 8 bolt assemblies by inserting a flat washer (#E) onto the bolt (#A). Insert into the holes and secure using the Allen wrench (#F).

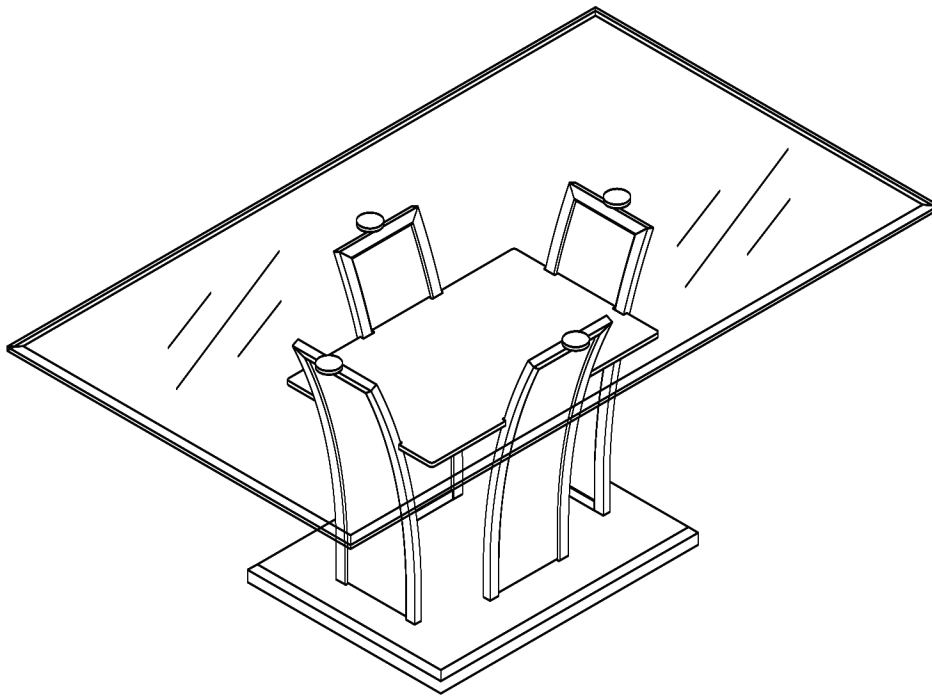

2. Align the base support rail (#6) to the holes along the center of the base (#5). Insert a screw (#D) into each hole and secure using a Phillips screwdriver.

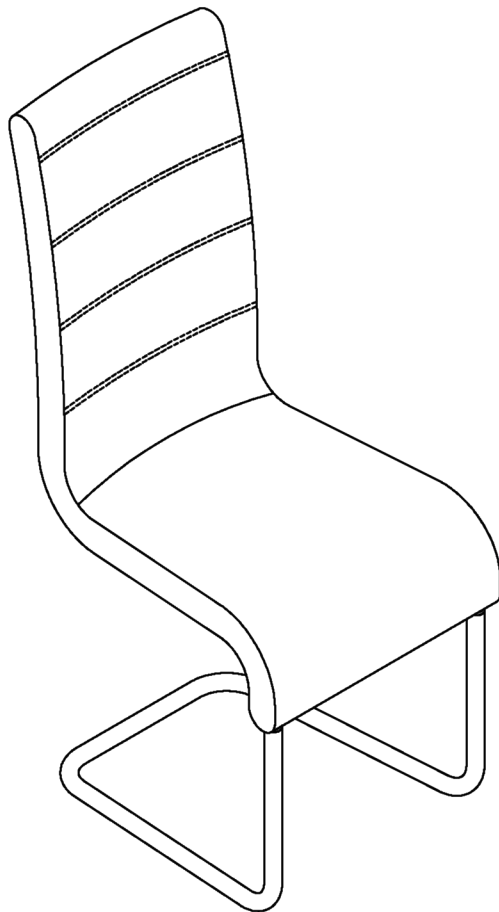


Turn the table upright and make sure all parts are firmly secured.

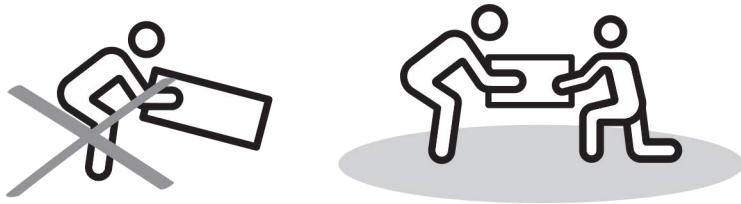

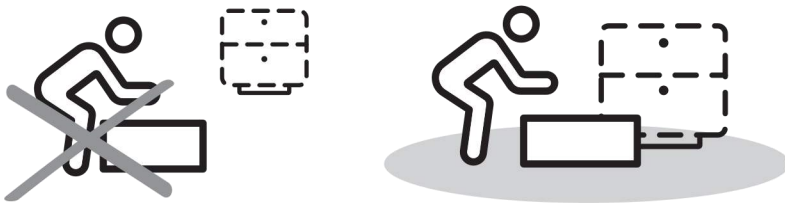
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



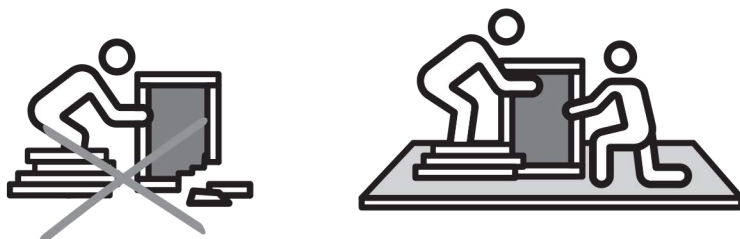
Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



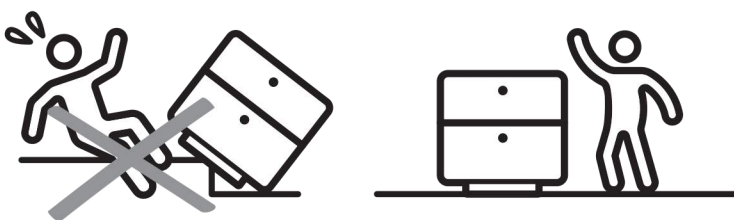
Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

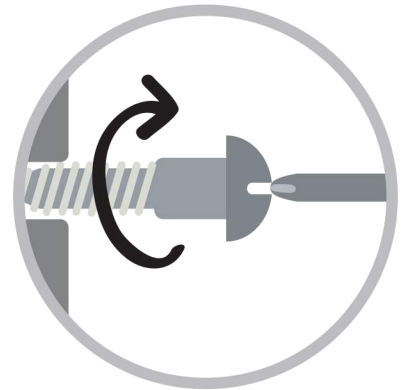

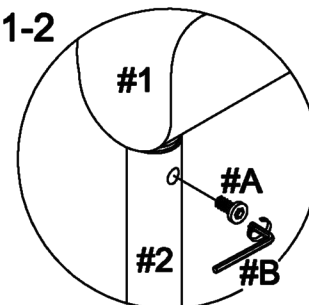


Align seat (#1) to the leg frame (#2), then secure by using bolts (#A).

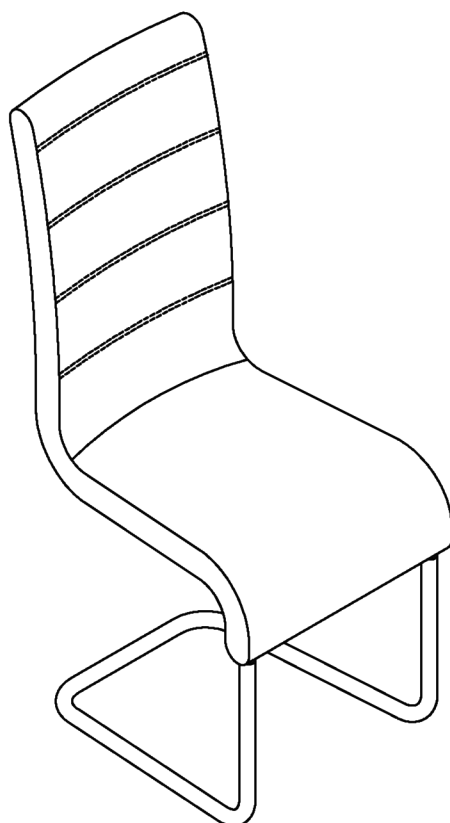

ASSEMBLY COMPLETED
