
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



- ◆ Inspect the wire insulation for any cuts, abrasions, or exposed copper that may have resulted during shipping. If there is a defect in the wire, do not attempt installation.
- Before starting installation of this fixture or removal of a previous fixture, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box.

Canopy Screw Collar Ring





EXPLODED PARTS




INSTALLATION STEP 1

- 1. Choose the length of the **chain** you need (Open the chain using a phillips screwdriver (not included) and pliers (not included).)
- 2. Attach the end of the **chain** to the loop on the **fixture**.




STEP 2

Use the **mounting screws** to attach the **mounting unit** to the junction box (not included).




STEP 3


- 1. Pass the **chain** and the branch wires through the **screw collar ring** and **canopy**.
- 2. Attach the end of the **chain** to the **mounting unit**.
- 3. Feed the branch wires through the pipe nipple on the **mounting unit**.



STEP 4

Make the electrical connection from the junction box (not included) to the $\mbox{\it fixture}.$ Connect the ground wire to the $\mbox{\it mounting unit}$ using the preinstalled green ground screw. Next, connect the live wire, neutral wire and ground wires with the supplied wire nuts. Secure with electrical tape.





STEP 5

Secure the canopy to the mounting unit with the screw collar ring.

NOTICE: Before use, add silicone glass sealant between the ceiling and the canopy to completely cover the gap.
