Before You Begin:

Please identify all component parts and hardware pieces required before you begin. Carefully remove all of the components from the packaging and set aside for assembly. Assemble on a soft surface to prevent scratching during assembly.





Remove the triangle knobs from both sides and the strap then flip the front and rear wheels downwards until they align with the installation holes.





Insert the (4) triangle knobs (part 7) into the holes and tighten.

Quality and Safety Guidelines

- Please follow the static and dynamic weight capacity limits provided on this item. If you are unsure of the weight capacities for this product, email us at customerexperience@theubiquegroup.com or call 866-552-2810.
- Do not use the walker under the influence of alcohol, medication or other drugs that affect your physical or mental abilities.
- All wheels must have constant contact with the ground to ensure correct alignment of the walker.
- Do not use the walker on uneven surfaces or surfaces that may hinder the wheels such as sand or gravel.
- Do not use the walker on icy or wet surfaces or in reduced visibility conditions.
- Do not use the walker on stairs or escalators.
- Transport things solely in the bag provided, do not hang anything from the frame.
- Do not use the device as a walker while seated. Before using the seat, the parking brake must be activated.
- Consult your physician to determine the proper adjustment and use of this device.
- Make sure that the handles on both sides are set on the same height and are locked correctly.
- Regularly check all parts to ensure there is no damage to the grips, wheels, or frame and that all screws are securely tightened.
- No modification may be made to this device. Use only original parts supplied by the manufacturer to replace any broken or defective parts.
- Do not use the product if it is damaged!
- Hold firmly to the handles while using this product and move forward with short steps to ensure proper balance.
- In case of falling, let the walker fall to the side to avoid contact with your body.
- While using this product, beware of any indentations, holes, obstacles, or other ground deformities in the path of the walker.
- This product is not intended for use as a step stool, lever, or for moving furniture.
- This item is intended to seat one person at a time.
- DO NOT store outdoors or in a vehicle and protect from extreme temperatures (Over 100°F or Below 32°F).
- Ensure all appendages are clear of the interior foldable areas while folding or unfolding the walker.

INTENDED USE:

Walking aids are used as part of a rehabilitation program when the user is recovering from an injury or surgery or as a long-term aid when the user has a permanent condition that causes difficulty with walking. This device helps maintain balance and aids in the prevention of injuries (particularly falls) allowing individuals to independently attend to their needs. Mobility aids with wheels may be used indoors or outdoors. Mobility aids are used to modify weight distribution so some of the weight carried through the legs while walking is transferred to the arms of the walker frame for support. The product is intended for adult use.
