PROCLEAN DEGREASER™ HOW TO GUIDE

TOOLS FOR THE JOB



STEP 1: CALCULATE SOLUTION AMOUNT

- Determine project size in square feet.
- Remember, 1 gallon covers approximately 200 square feet.

STEP 2: SELECT CONCENTRATE SIZE

- ProClean Degreaser™ is available for making 1 or 5 gallons of solution.

STEP 3: MIX SOLUTION

- For 1 gallon: Mix 4 ounces of concentrate with 1 gallon of water.
- For 5 gallons: Mix 1 quart of concentrate with 5 gallons of water.

STEP 4: PREPARE SPRAYER/CONTAINER

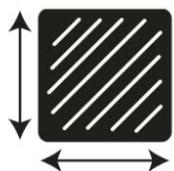
- Remove filters if using a sprayer.
- Pour concentrate into sprayer or mixing container.
- Add corresponding water amount.

STEP 5: APPLY PROCLEAN DEGREASER™ SOLUTION

- Spray the entire surface with ProClean Degreaser™.
- Allow the solution to soak for 30 seconds.

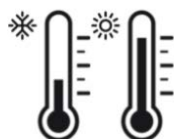
STEP 6: CLEAN AND RINSE THE SURFACE

- Clean with a scrub brush, cotton mop, or low-speed buffer with brush attachment.
- Remove residue with a clean mop or wet-dry vacuum.
- Rinse surface thoroughly with water.

STEP 7: DRY SURFACE

- Allow surface to dry for at least eight hours before applying stain or sealer.
