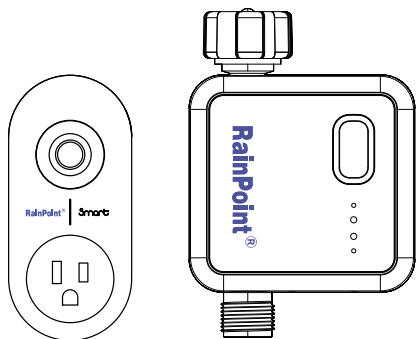


Quick Start Guide

Connection :

1. Download the APP and register your homgar account
Search for "**Homgar**" and download the APP

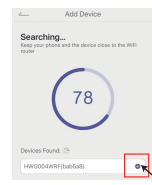
2. Find "+" button on the top right corner of the APP's Home Page. Select "**Socket Hub**", then enter the Wi-Fi information and go next. (Only support 2.4Ghz WiFi)



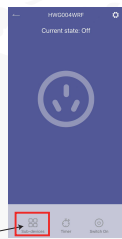
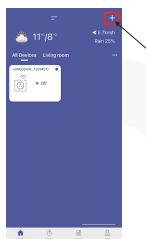
3. Plug on the socket hub near the router, **press and hold the button on the socket hub for about 5 seconds until it quickly blinks**. Select the check box and go "**NEXT**" to start searching devices.



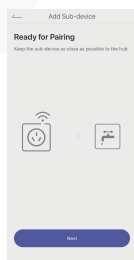
4. When device found, please click "+" to add the device and edit the device name as your like. **Then you successfully add the hub to your APP.**



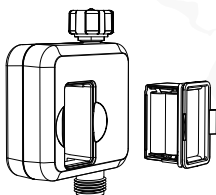
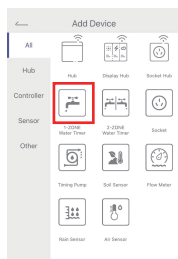
5. **After the hub is successfully connected**. Select the "+" button on the top right corner of the APP home page to add device, or you can go to the hub's home page and use "**Sub-devices**" to add devices.



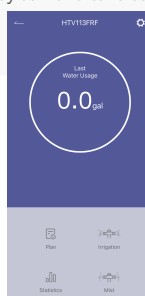
7. Press and hold the button of the timer until the light flashes red quickly. Meanwhile, select "**Next**" on the APP and start searching devices.



6. Find "1-ZONE Water Timer" or the icon  to add HTV113FRF-DLS water timer. And then **insert 4 new AA 1.5V alkaline batteries** (not included) to the timer.



8. After successfully connecting, the last water usage value will display in the middle of the timer's screen. The next watering plan time will display as well after creating plans.

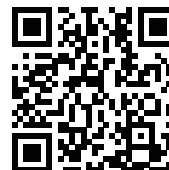


Note:

1. Please make sure you are using 2.4GHz when connecting devices to the APP.
2. Keep the hub always under 2.4GHz Wi-Fi to keep the connection well.
3. If you miss the connection for the first time, please hold the button on the timer to start pairing mode again and reconnect on the APP.

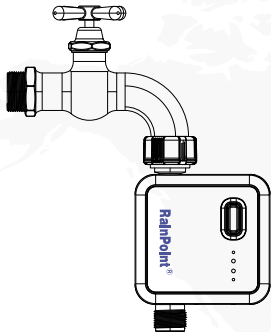

Installation:

Install the timer vertically on the tap.



- NOTE :
- 1) Turn off the garden faucet.
 - 2) Wrap Teflon Tape around the faucet threads.
 - 3) Screw the timer to the garden faucet and make the display as vertical as possible to the ground to prevent rainwater from accumulating and leaking into the interior.
 - 4) Turn on the faucet after programming the timer.
 - 5) Under freezing temperatures, timers should be removed from the faucet and stored indoor to avoid potential freezing damage.
 - 6) Please clean filters regularly and replace them if it is worn in order to prolong the working life of the timer.

Troubleshooting:

Problem	Possible Factors	Solution May Help
Can't turn on /off the valve	• Low battery. • Impurities in water inlet. • Unstable network or delayed response.	• Replace fresh batteries. • Regularly clean the filter port of impurities to avoid disruptions in use. • Wait a while and try again.
Timer can't connect	• Unstable WIFI network. • Long distance from the hub. • Timer not in pairing state.	• Check that the WIFI network environment is working. • Close to hubs and routers when connected to irrigation timers. • Re-pair the timer: Press and hold the timer button until the white light flashes rapidly to indicate pairing. (Or remove the device from the homepage and reconnect)
Hub can't connect	• Not using 2.4GHz WIFI. • Incorrect WIFI password. • Hub not in pairing state.	• Confirm 2.4GHz WIFI connection. • Confirm that the WIFI password has been entered correctly.

Troubleshooting:

Problem	Solution
Hub disconnection or offline	1. Please check if the router works normally. 2. If there is a power shot down and then recovery, and the router is back to work again, please reconnect the socket hub following the connection part of this manual. 3. Please check if the Wi-Fi signal is unstable. 4. If the distance between the hub and the router is too far, please move the hub closer to make the connection more stable.
The button or the socket doesn't work	Please contact our customer service for more support and suggestions.
