About This Variety: Blue Wonder is a compact hybrid that grows in a vase-shaped clump on upright stems with ovate, green leaves. Creamy white and powder blue lily-like flowers, with heavy blue-purple spotting and purple anthers covering all. It is a favorite due to its deepest blue colors.

Growing Instructions: Best suited in areas where they can be observed up close.

Care Tip: Soil must not be allowed to dry out.

Exposure: Part shade to full shade

Height: Grows 12-24" tall

Spacing: Plant- 12-24" apart, 1" deep

Hardy in: USDA zones 5-8
