LIGHT

I grow best in a bright spot. I prefer at least four hours of bright light per day but no direct sun. The more light you can provide, the healthier I will be



FOOD

WATER

Water me when the top inch of my soil is dry to the touch. Allow water to drain: remove any excess water. I prefer above average humidity levels.
