Tall phlox, botanically known as *phlox paniculata* or commonly as garden phlox, is native to North America. Phlox is a staple in the perennial garden since it mixes easily with other plants and provides extended blooms throughout the summer. Regardless of the color, garden phlox is fragrant, rich in nectar and attracts pollinators - especially hummingbirds. Vigorous grower with sturdy stems that withstand adverse weather conditions. A perennial if planted USDA zones 4-8 and will return for years to come reaching maturity in year three.

Growing Instructions: Keep plant areas clean and remove faded blooms. Drought tolerant.

Care Tip: Taller stems may need staking. Thrives with regular fertilization.

Blooms: July to September

Exposure: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Height: Grows 24-36" tall

Spacing: Plant 18-24" apart, 1.5-2" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 4-8
