
How to better use your microwaves


To have a better using experience, get familiar with your microwaves and maintaining are very useful. Here are a few tips:

How to install your microwaves



Keep cavity clean of your microwaves

Failure to clean food residue may cause innocuous sparking or some smoke in the microwave cavity, discoloration of the cavity may also occur.






What material cannot be put in your microwaves

Avoid to put metal such as metal spoon or aluminum tray in your microwaves. Also, not to put paper bags or something like that in the microwaves. In case of sparking, try the following trouble shooting:

- a. Use microwave-safe cookware only.
- b. Do not operate with oven empty.
- c. Clean cavity with wet towel
