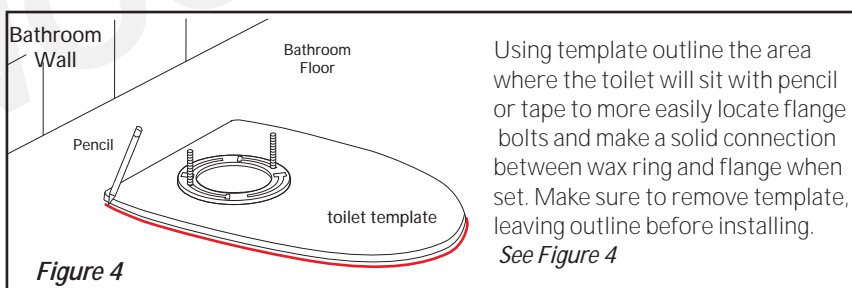
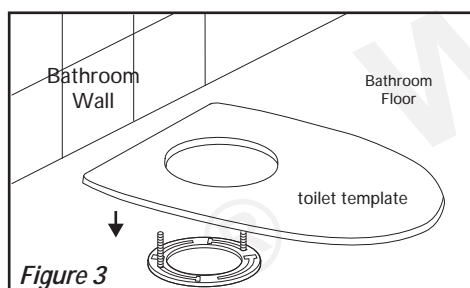
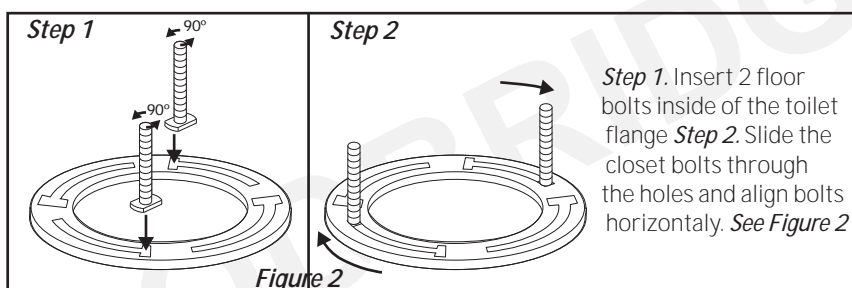
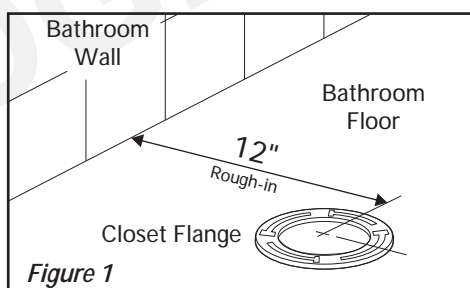
1. Shut off water supply line. If you do not have shut-off valve near the toilet shut off main water supply line.
2. Flush the old toilet and make sure that tank is empty.
3. Disconnect and remove water supply line connected to the toilet's tank.
4. Remove old toilet, bolts, nuts from the closet flange.
5. Clean closet flange area from old wax ring and putty sealant using putty knife from the base area.
6. Clean any remaining debris and wipe any water at the installation area
7. Temporarily plug flange on a floor with a flange plug or towel to prevent gasses from escaping

IMPORTANT! The mounting surface area must be clean, dry, and leveled prior to installation of the new toilet!

NOTE! Inspect the existing closet flange for damages. If damaged, replace it to new flange before proceeding to the installation

PREPARE CLOSET FLANGE

Make sure that rough-in is 12" by measuring the distance from the wall to the center of the closet flange. See Figure 1



Locate and remove template from carton. Place over toilet flange. Measure from back wall to make sure it is square/even with wall. Check your shut-off valve to make sure it clears back of template. See Figure 3

INSTALL WAX RING

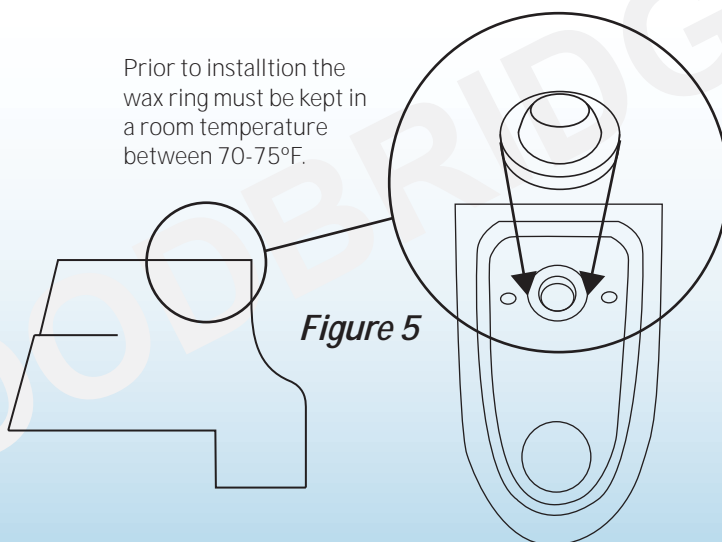
Important: safety glasses must be worn by the installer and all bystanders.

Cover the floor with a soft-close blanket. Carefully turn the toilet on it's side or upside-down on the blanket with assistance of a second person. Install wax ring over the horn discharge located on the bottom of the toilet's bowl.

See Figure 5

Note: Ceramic is a fragile material. You must always cover the floor with a soft-cloth blanket if you want to put the toilet on the floor on any side other than the bottom of the toilet. If you do not cover the floor with a soft-close blanket contact of the toilet with the floor may and will cause minor or moderate scratches on the toilet's surface.

Prior to installation the wax ring must be kept in a room temperature between 70-75°F.



Always Use Soft-Cloth Blanket

INSTALL NEW TOILET

Step 1. Lift and carefully put the toilet over the closet flange inside the outline made by template so the closet bolts can go through the mounting holes in the toilet's base. Once the bowl is in the position press the bowl down with slight twisting motion in level position towards the floor. Apply your body weight to evenly compress the wax ring to create watertight seal. Make sure that the bowl is as leveled as possible to have a nice seal tight.

Do not rock the toilet back and forth and side to side as it may and will break a seal and you will need to replace the wax ring again and start the installation process over.

Step 2. Once the toilet is set and leveled install washers and nuts over the closet bolts. Tighten nuts. Do not overtighten the nuts. It may and will cause damage to the toilet's ceramic base. **Please keep in mind that because this is a skirted trap-way toilet, it may require a little more time, patience and accessibility to complete install.** See Figure 7

CONNECT TOILET'S TANK TO WATER SUPPLY LINE

Connect the water supply line between the tank and water shut-off valve using a toilet hose (not supplied). When connecting toilet hose tighten coupling nut to the tank by 1/4 turn beyond the hand tight.



Do not overtighten nut on the tank connection. It may and will cause water leakage.

Turn on valve on water supply line and allow tank to fill. Check all connections for leakages and tighten as needed.

Once tank is filled with water flush it 4-5 times to perform a test of the flushing system. At the same time check the bottom of the toilet for leaks to make sure that the wax ring is properly installed and sealed.

If there are no leaks you are ready finalize the installation. If any shims are installed at the bottom of the toilet's bowl you may trim them. Apply silicone around base of the toilet's. Allow 24 hours for silicone to dry before start using the toilet. See Figure 8

Important: Leaks may not occur during or right after the installation. Make sure to check for leaks every couple hours first day installed and occasionally check it everyday for the next week to ensure that toilet is properly installed and no leaks occur. If any leaks occur immediately shut off the water supply line valve and contact your local plumber to fix all leaks.

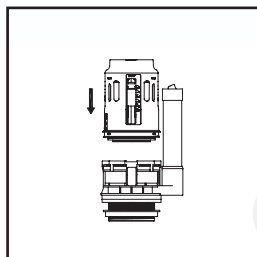
1. BASE INSTALLATION



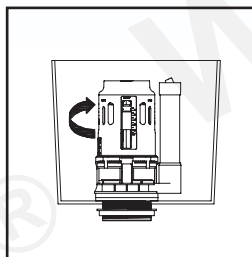
Check the dual flush valve and make sure that it does not have any damaged or missing parts



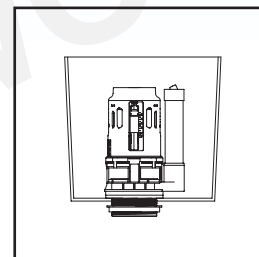
Install the base with the rubber gasket in the tank, turn the screw as illustrated to make sure there is no water leakage and no looseness



Install a body of the flush into the base and make sure they can be rotated clockwise arbitrarily.

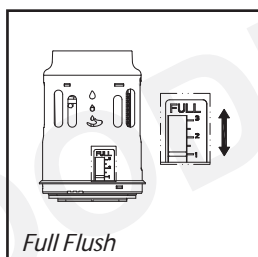


Rotate the valve clockwise to adjust its position inside of the toilet's tank

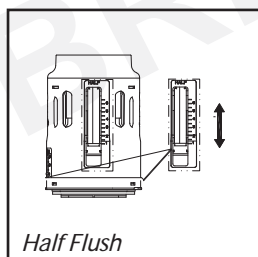

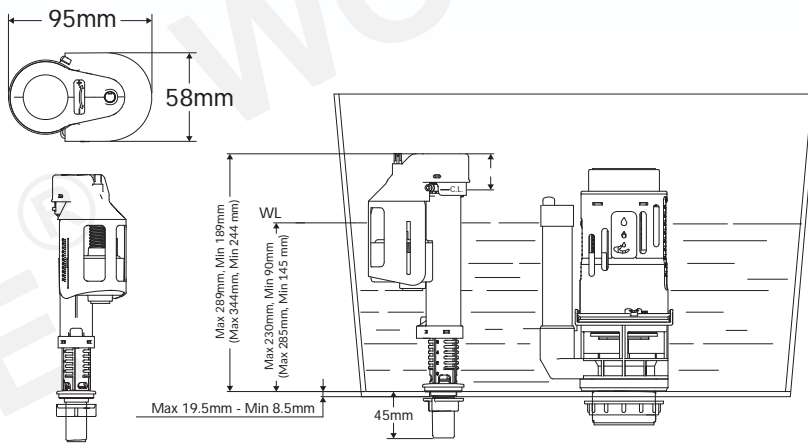


If the rod is too short, please re-adjust it (outward rotation).

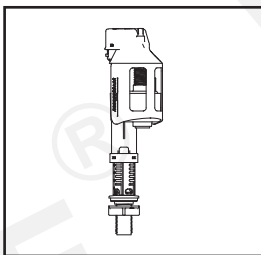

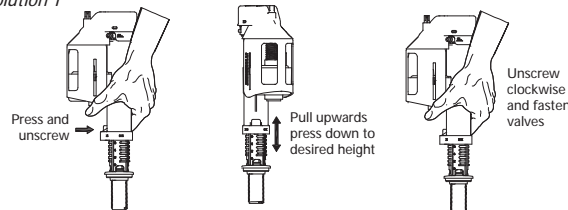
1. PREPARATION

Remove the worn-out fittings and clean your tank prior to the installation of the new ones. There might be a lot of impurities in your tank that may cause damage to the new parts if you do not clean them out. The tank must be absolutely clean prior to installation.

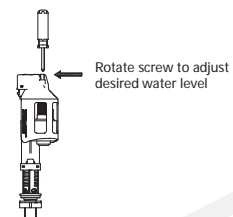

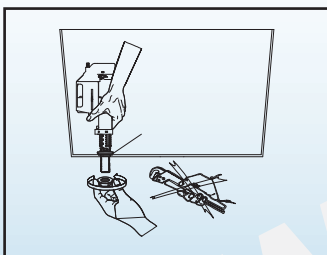

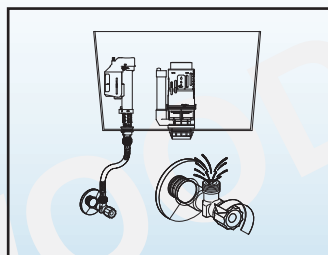
1. Press buckle and unscrew.
2. Pull the valve upwards or press down to desired height.
3. Unscrew the valve body and fasten the buckle

Rotating screw, rise or lower the water level to adjust water level to suitable position (water volume will gradually increase when the adjuster is moved upward from the bottom.)

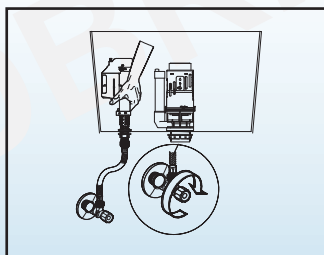

MAINTENANCE & CARE

Use soft sponges or soft-cloths to clean the surface. Always rinse thoroughly any cleaning solutions immediately after cleaning. Do not any chemical remain on the surface for extended periods of time.

Bidet Seat Installation Instructions

When using electrical products, especially when children are present, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

CAUTION—Indicates that failure to follow the instruction may cause body injury or property damage.

1. Do not install or use the product in wet places as steam room etc. This product must be connected to properly grounded power outlet socket.
2. It is recommended to use water-proof electrical outlet which should be installed in the place where is not easily got wet.
3. This product should be used with AC 110V-120V, 50/60Hz electrical current only, load current is at least 15A. Power plug must be equipped with ground fault circuit interrupter or ground fault electrical leakage protector or similar high sensitive, rapid type leakage switch (Rated sensitive current under 6mA).
4. When it thunders, it is strongly recommended to pull out the power plug.
5. Do not stand on ceramic toilet.
6. Ceramic toilet must install floor fixing bolt.
7. Do not stand on product unit, seat and cover.
8. Do not lean against the seat cover when using the product, to avoid damage.
9. This product is equipped with soft-closing seal cover. Heavy pressing or pushing may damage the soft-closing damper.
10. Do not use lacquer thinner, petrol, liquid medicine, detergent, insecticide, toilet cleanser and scrubbing brush to clean the product.
11. Exposure to direct sunlight is prohibited.
12. Only use tap water or potable water; otherwise it may cause chafing.
13. Do not connect water supply to heater outlet. Make sure inlet water temperature at 3~35°C
14. When the room temperature is under zero degree, please dry up the water tank, to avoid freezing.
15. Raise rest room temperature to prevent the toilet from damage due to freezing.
16. When move the product from cold or wet environment into normal room temperature, wait for 2 hours until the condensation water is fully volatilized. Doing so can prevent the product from electrical short-circuit.
17. When not using the product over three(3) days, drain the water out of the container and pull the electrical plug from the wall outlet.
18. Stop using the product and shut off the power when product malfunctions, please contact the service people for professional service.

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This product should be grounded. In the event of an electrical short circuit, grounding reduces the risk of electric shock by providing an escape wire for the electric current. This product is equipped with a cord having a grounding wire with a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an outlet that is properly installed and grounded.




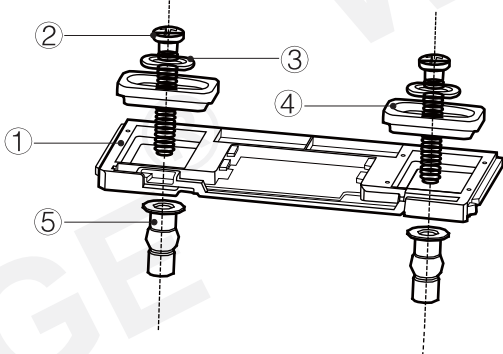
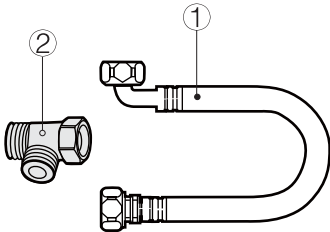
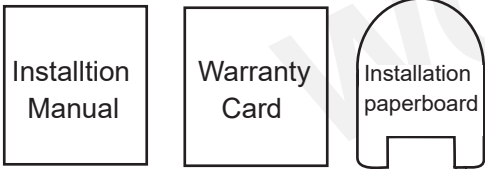
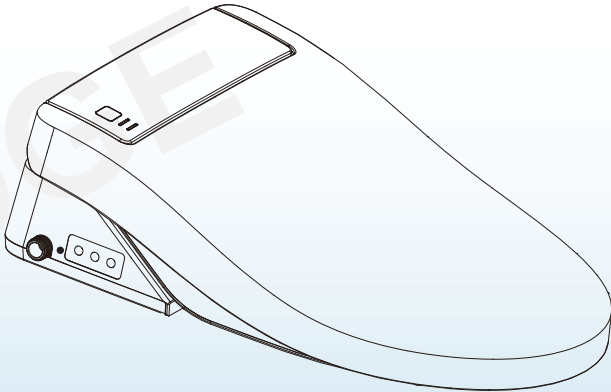

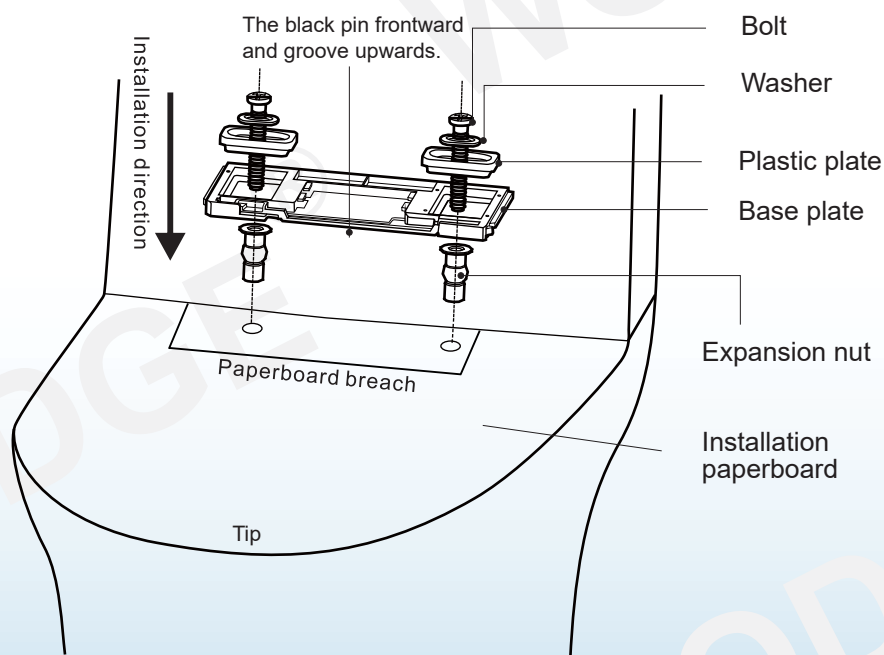
Installation dimension

Installation of mounting plate

Press the expansion nuts into the installation holes in the toilet, then install the base plate, plastic plates, flat washers and bolt as per the drawing and tighten the bolts.



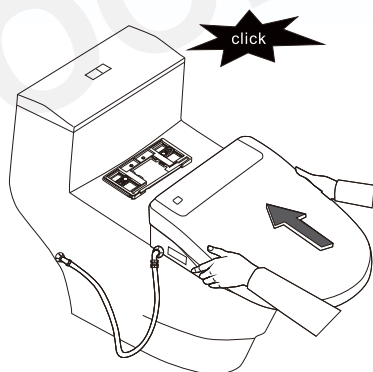
Note:

Unfold the installation paperboard, align the paperboard well fit ceramic bowl from the tip, and then insert base plate to the paperboard breach to make sure base plate align with paperboard breach.

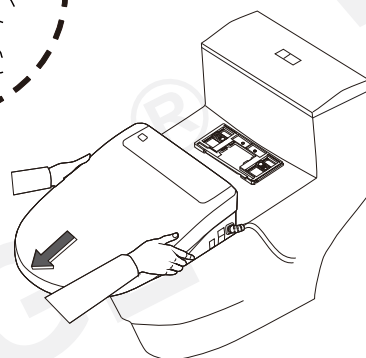
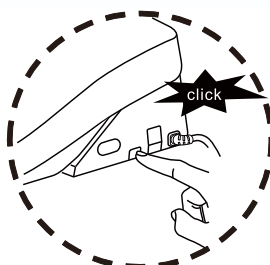
Push the washlet back onto the base plate until a "click" is heard.

Connecting the water supply pipe

1. Side inlet: Install the 3-way valve onto angle valve, then attach the water supply hose and the washlet inlet hose into 3-way valve. Connect L-shaped end of water supply hose to the washlet inlet connector. [(a) and (b) parts not included in the water supply assembly.]

2. Bottom inlet: Connect water supply on the inlet connector, then put supply hose and power line through the relevant holes, finally install seat cover.

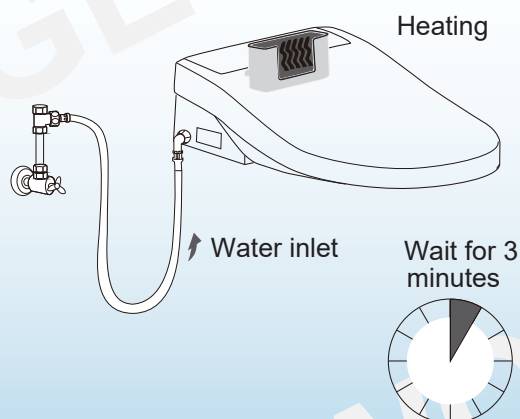
The main unit buzzer rings first "click", the power light and energy saver light will flash. Power light on and energy saver light off means self-inspection.







The buzzer rings second "click" to show that self-inspection is finished.



The water starts to flow into tank and heating will take 3 minutes.

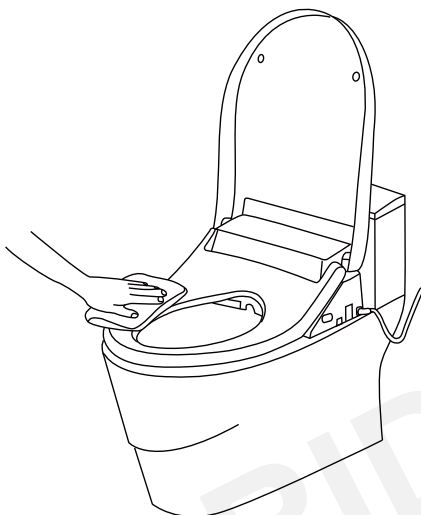
1. When main unit is in functional mode, the light of power goes on and energy saver light is off; When in energy save function, the light of power goes off, and energy saver light is on; When in standby mode, both lights are off.
2. The default setting of all function is on middle level, after using remote-controller, shift to the level showing on remote-controller.
3. If the product is not used for continual 72 hours, the water in the tank will automatically discharge for 90 seconds and replaced by fresh water, to avoid bacteria.

Main unit maintenance

- 1.Shut off power supply at maintenance.
- 2.Turn the seat upward open,press down the button located on the right side of main unit and pull out the seat.Wipe the stain with a soft damp cloth.
- 3.After cleaning,re-install the seat back to main unit.



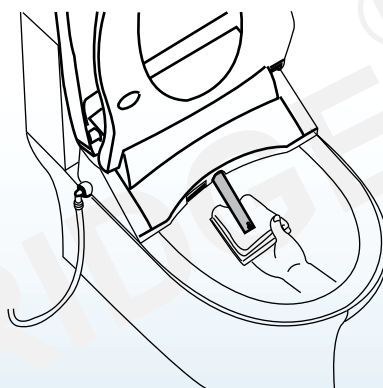
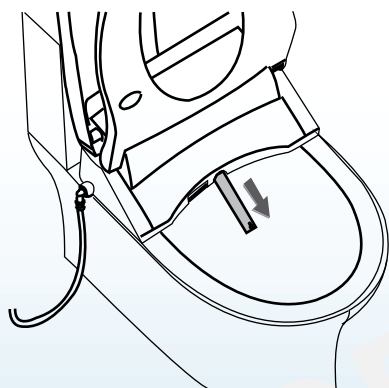
Note:

Do not pour the water on the product at maintenance.

Spray nozzle maintenance

Do the following to clean the wand.

- 1.Press “nozzle cleaning” or “rear cleaning” button for a while and wand will come out.Wipe the wand clean with a soft damp cloth.
- 2.Hold “nozzle cleaning” button and the wand doesn’t come out.The nozzle will automatically spray to self-clean.
- 3.Press again “nozzle cleaning” or “stop” or “rear cleaning” button,it will stop the cleaning.

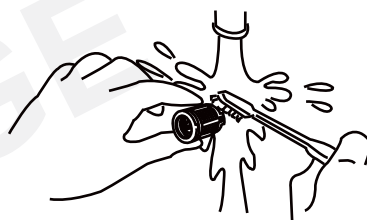
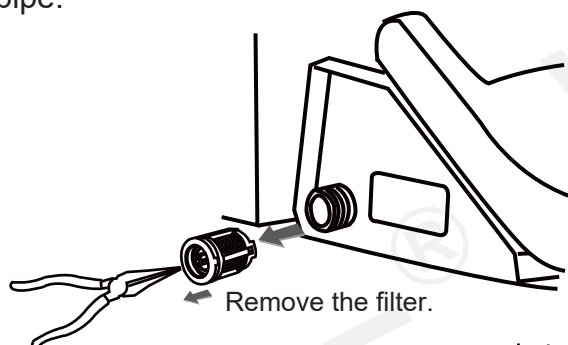

Do not apply force when pushing or pulling the wand,as this may damage the mechanism.

Inlet filter cleaning

1. Pull out electrical plug, then shut off water supply valve and remove water supply hose.
2. Remove the filter. Use the brush to clean the filter.
3. Put the filter back into inlet after cleaning. Then connect the water supply pipe.



Tank anti-freezing and anti-bacterial maintenance

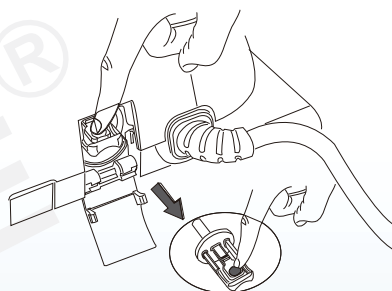
When room temperature is under zero and electricity is disconnected, or user is away for a long time. The water inside the tank should be discharged.

- 1) Open the tank cover, press the discharge button, turn on valve to discharge the water.
- 2) Slightly press the discharge button protruding part to turn off discharging valve and cover.

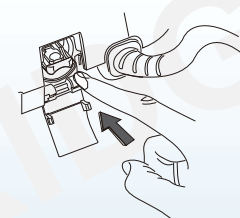

No flushing	Water supply hose buckling causes block	Solve the buckling
	Fill valve is off	Turn on the fill valve
	Water supply is cut off	Connect water supply and wait for the water
Poor flushing	Water supply hose buckling causes partial block	Solve the buckling
	Fill valve is not fully turned on	Turn on the fill valve fully
	Filter is dirty and causes block	Clean the filter
The water is not hot	The water temperature is setted on normal temperature level	Reset the water temperature
	In standby mode or power save mode	Switch to function mode, and then wash after 3 minutes
Seat temperature is not hot	The seat temperature is setted on normal temperature level	Reset the seat temperature
	In standby mode	Shift to function mode for 3 minutes
Wind temperature is not hot	The wind temperature is setted on normal temperature level	Reset the wind temperature
No wind out	In standby mode or power save mode	Shift to function mode to use dry function
Spray wand cannot retracted	Power off	Push back the wand lightly and wait for the power
	Get stuck by impurities	Clear away the impurities
Spray wand cannot stretch out	Power off	Push back the wand lightly and wait for the power
	Do not sit in sensing area	Sit right in the sensing area
Controller cannot display	Reverse the polarity of battery	Reload the battery
 Caution	If the problems cannot be solved as per above methods, please shut-off the power, and contact service providers for maintenance.	
	If the leakage circuit breacker often trips off, it means the products has electricity leakage, so please shut-off the power, and contact service provider for maintenance.
