



Remove debris, then rake the soil to loosen and smooth the top layer.

NEW LAWNS

FOR OVERSEEDING/THIN AREAS:

Start by mowing existing grass as short as possible followed by removing debris. Then rake the soil to loosen and smooth the top layer.

APPLY


Spread the seed evenly using a drop, rotary or hand-held spreader according to the recommended spreader settings listed. Rake gently to work your seed and fertilizer into the soil.

grass height reaches 3" tall



Avoid removing more than 1/3 of the total grass blade length in any single mowing

Hot summers can be stressful on your lawn; increase the mowing height during hot and dry periods to reduce stress on vour lawn

MOST IMPORTANTLY - Don't kill the grass before it starts by using weed control (pros call it preemergent) on your lawn until your grass has reached its full mowing height of 3"
