

- 1.- If mounting Fixture to Standard Outlet Box: Remove "Outlet Box Knockout" from Fixture Plate (1) and pass Fixture Wires (2) out through opening.
 - 2.- Remove Screws from Outlet Box (3)(Not Furnished) and thread Studs (4) into ears of Outlet Box (3) leaving approximately 1/2 inch of Stud protruding downward.
 - 3.- Connect Fixture Wires (2) to Supply Wires (6) as shown in Wiring Diagram.
 - 4.- Carefully tuck Wires up into Outlet Box (3). Raise Fixture Plate (1) up over Studs (4) and secure in place with Hexnuts (8)(Do Not Overtighten).
 - 5.- If mounting Fixture to Wall or Ceiling with Conduit or Cable Power Feed: Remove 7/8 inch diameter Round Knockout (14) from corner of Fixture Plate (1). Select a UL listed Connector (9)(Not Furnished) appropriate to the Power Feed at installation site. Fasten Connector (9) with Supply Wire (7) to Fixture Plate (1).
 - 6.- Mount Fixture Plate (1) to Wall or Ceiling with appropriate Fasteners (Not Furnished) and make Electrical Connections as detailed in Step #3 above.
- Final Installation
- 7.- Fasten Cover (10) to Fixture Plate (1) with Cover Screws (11).
 - 8.- Slip Reflector / Insulator (12) up into Cover (10) with Reflector Surface facing outward, and snap behind Tabs (13) in Cover.(See Detail A).
 - 9.- Install Lamp(s)(Not Furnished).
- Caution - All Glass is Fragile, use care when Handling Lamp(s).
- 10.- Snap Diffuser (14) up over Cover (10).
