



Side Storage Bag Set Up Guide

The correct attachment of this product is critical and beyond the control of Rightline Gear. The safe use and long life of this product depends entirely on your good judgment and following these directions.

Pack The Side Storage Bag

- 1-Slide the hard plastic sheet into the top sleeve (Fig 1).
- 2-Place items like towels, blankets, jackets, hats, clothing, first aid kits, lunch/snacks, sun screen, and tool kits in the main compartment A and close its zipper (Fig 2).
- 3-Place smaller items in the zippered pocket B and close its zipper (Fig 2).
- 4-Place items to access quickly in the outer mesh pocket C (Fig 2).



Attach The Side Storage Bag

The Side Storage Bag straps to the front and rear vertical roll bars, over the driver's side rear wheel well, in 2-door Jeep Wranglers. Your Wrangler's top can be up or down. This product fits the Jeep Wrangler JK.

- 1-Position the bag over the driver's side rear wheel well (Fig 3).



- 2-Buckle the D strap around the base of the rear vertical roll bar, without twisting the strap (Fig 3 and Fig 4).
- 3-Buckle the E strap around the rear vertical roll bar, above the seat belt holder, without twisting the strap (Fig 3 and Fig 5).

- 4-Buckle the F strap around the front vertical roll bar, above the seat belt holder, without twisting the strap (Fig 3 and Fig 6)



- 5-Tighten all (3) straps (Fig 7). The top of the bag should follow a straight line parallel to the ground.
