

INSTRUCCIONES DE SEGURIDAD

Indemnification

By using this Mold and Allergen Testing System you agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Air Care Companies, Inc., its officers, directors, employees, agents, licensors and suppliers from and against all losses, expenses (including medical expenses and personal injury claims), damages and costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees, resulting from (a) any violation of these terms and conditions, (b) any failure to use the Mold and Allergen Testing System or any portion thereof in accordance with the instructions contained herein, (c) any failure to submit the samples to Air Care Companies, Inc.'s recommended laboratory for testing, (d) any misuse or unintended use of the product, and (e) your negligent or willful misconduct.

This Mold and Allergen Air Testing System should be used as the first step in identifying elevated mold conditions in your home or office. Accordingly, by using this Mold and Allergen Air Testing System, you expressly agree to adhere to the Safety Instructions provided below.

WARNING: To guard against fire, injury or death, basic safety precautions must be observed, including the following.

READ AND FOLLOW ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. For safe and effective use of the Mold and Allergy Air Testing System, it is imperative to understand the pump and observe all warnings and these Safety Instructions before using. Failure to do so may result in fire, injury or damage to the pump.
2. **DANGER.** To avoid possible electrical shock, special care must be taken. For each of the following situations, do not attempt to use the pump or conduct repair yourself. In each such case, return the pump to the manufacturer for service or discard the pump.
 - A. DO NOT immerse in water. If the pump falls into the water, DON'T reach for it! First unplug it and then retrieve it. If electrical components of the pump get wet, unplug the pump immediately.
 - B. Do not operate any pump if it has a damaged cord or plug, or if it is malfunctioning or if it is dropped or damaged in any manner.
 - C. (Auto-Shut Off) Unplug the pump if it remains on and runs for longer than five (5) minutes.
3. The pump should not be used by minor children under the age of 18.
4. To avoid injury, do not contact moving parts or hot parts such as the pump, fan, etc.
5. Always unplug a pump from an outlet when not in use. Never yank the cord to pull the plug from the outlet. Grasp the plug and pull it to disconnect.
6. Do not use a pump for other than intended use. The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the pump manufacturer may cause an unsafe condition.
7. Never block the air openings of the pump or place it on a soft surface, such as a bed or couch, where the air openings may be blocked. Keep the air openings free of lint, hair, and the like.
8. Do not install or store the pump where it will be exposed to weather or to temperatures below freezing.
9. Ensure the pump is placed on a level and dry surface before operating.
10. Read and observe all the warning labels and important notices on the pump.
11. Recommended use - 60 Hz 120v power only.
12. DO NOT use with power converters, universal power adapters or any other power variations.
13. If an extension cord is necessary, a cord with a proper rating should be used. A cord rated for less amperes or watts than the pump rating may overheat. Care should be taken to arrange the cord so it will not be tripped over or pulled.
14. In order to maintain a high degree of confidence in the operation of your Air Care Companies, Inc. air sampling pump, we recommends that the pump be returned to our office every 12 months for inspection and re-calibration. 1. Los usuarios de este sistema de detección de moho, usen accesorios apropiados, implementar, definir y eximir de responsabilidad a Air Care Companies, Inc. a sus ejecutivos, directores, empleados, representantes, concesionarios de licencias y proveedores de servicios que contraten con la empresa para el desarrollo de los procedimientos de mantenimiento, reparación y/o sustitución de las instrucciones de Seguridad basadas, incluyendo las que se requieren para el cumplimiento de las normas de Seguridad establecidas en la legislación de la Compañía.

4. La bomba no debe ser usada por niños menores de 18 años.

6. Para evitar lesiones, no intente ni conectarse con las piezas de moho ni con las piezas de moho.
7. No uses una bomba para extraer agua de un lugar donde quede expuesta a la intemperie o donde se acumulen gotas de condensación.
8. Nunca sumerjas las manos en agua de la bomba ni en la bomba de agua de la intemperie.
9. Los sistemas de bomba de agua de la intemperie son más seguros que los sistemas de bomba de agua de la intemperie.
10. Use y respeta las etiquetas de advertencia y los avisos importantes en la bomba.
11. Una bomba es útil para detectar la presencia de agua en el hogar.
12. Si se detecta agua en el hogar, se debe desacoplar la bomba de agua de la intemperie.
13. Si se detecta agua en el hogar, se debe desacoplar la bomba de agua de la intemperie.
14. Para mantener un nivel de confianza en la operación del sistema de detección de moho, se recomienda que el usuario lea las instrucciones de Seguridad y las normas de la legislación de la Compañía.
