
Assemble components on a soft, clean surface to avoid scratching or damaging the finish.




Inspect packaging to ensure all parts are accounted for before disposing of packing materials.








IMPORTANT: Ensure Back Panel (D) is installed on the same side as the drainage hole.



DO NOT REPEAT THIS STEP! The remaining cover strip will be installed into the remaining side panel during Step 5.



IMPORTANT: Mounting locations are marked in between the slats on the right side of the side panel.


The bottle cap opener and the screw for the bottle cap bin will install on the left side of the unit, as indicated in the images below.



TIP: Leave about 1/4" of the bottom screw exposed for hanging the bottle cap bin.








TIP: Locate the lip just under the cooler rail and press the top of the cooler into the indentation; this is not a firm hold of the liner, it is intended to keep the rim out of the way while the cooler is filled with ice.



IMPORTANT: Install the drain plug over the second notch in the drain tube.



Before Use...

Always unlock the locking casters before attempting to move the unit.

Always lock the locking casters when the unit is not in motion.

Only use on a clean, flat surface. Dirt, debris and uneven surfaces beneath the casters may damage the unit.

Move the unit by pushing on the handle; never lift up on the unit, either by the handle or the serving tray.

Do not exceed weight capacity of the cooler, storage shelf or serving rail.

Ensure the drain plug is closed before filling the cooler with ice.

To avoid puncturing the cooler liner, use caution when filling it with ice.

Care & Maintenance

SAFE USE: Do not stand or sit on any part of the unit. Unless the unit is being moved, ensure the locking casters are engaged at all times. Only use on clean, flat, level surfaces.

CLEAN: Periodically washing the unit will maintain a fresh appearance and prevent damage that may result from the build-up of dust and debris. Do not leave items in the cooler when the unit is not in use.

INSPECT: Occasionally check the unit to ensure all components are firmly secured and resin is intact.

STORAGE & WINTER CARE: To obtain the longest lifespan of this item, avoid extended exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunlight. Always store indoors during freezing conditions. Covering with a breathable cover while in storage will help prevent dust and debris build-up.

Cleaning

Regular cleaning keeps your resin furniture looking stunning for many Sunnydaze to come!

Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials to clean the furniture.

 **DO NOT USE A PRESSURE WASHER**

After each use, ensure the cooler insert is drained and dried out to prevent mold and mildew growth.

- Brush, vacuum, or use a garden hose to remove loose dirt and debris.
- Mix 1/4 cup of soap or a mild detergent with 1 gallon of warm water. Use a soft-bristle brush to scrub dirt and grime from the surfaces.
- Thoroughly rinse the unit; spray with a garden hose or use a bucket of water to rinse all traces of soap residue from the unit.
- Dry the unit with a soft, lint-free cloth.
