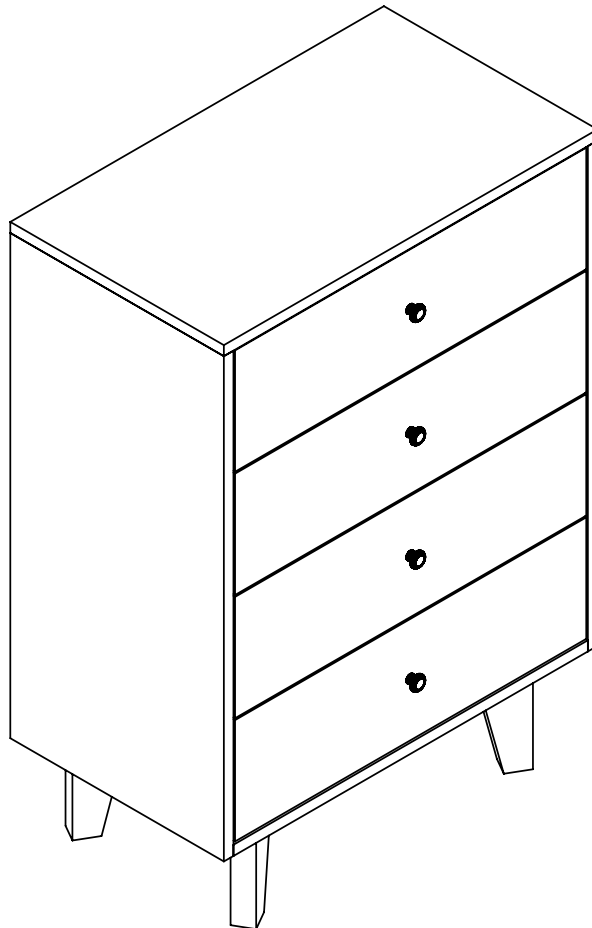


Assembly Instructions

▲ For higher efficiency, we recommend to use a power drill; the power drill should be set on the low speed to avoid screw stripping.

CAUTION

This package contains small parts and hardware; keep it from children to avoid accidental swallowing.



WARNING: Any furniture that is not anchored to a wall has the risk of tipping over in certain circumstances, i.e. when a child attempts to climb up on the furniture or in the event of an earthquake. We supply a free safety wall anchor with all furniture sold and we recommend these are used to prevent your product from tipping over.
