About This Variety: The leaves of Hosta Whirlwind are variegated of which color changes through the growing season as its lime green white leaves form wide dark green margins which darken later in the summer. Won the Award of Garden Merit and the Best Variegated Hosta in a Garden Award from the American Hosta Society in 1992. Good choice for just about any garden use and garden style.

Growing Instructions: While drought tolerant, they do not like being kept dry for long, and prefer rich, welldrained soil with a consistent supply of moisture.

Care Tip: Virtually maintenance free, clip out dead flower stalks after flowering.

Exposure: partial shade to full shade Height: grows 18" tall Spacing: plant 35" apart, 1.5-2" deep USDA Zones: hardy in USDA zones 3-9
