


Van Zyverden's

They perennialize nicely, providing a splash of color.

Growing Instructions: To ensure optimal results, allow adequate space, sunlight, plant at the appropriate depth, feed with a well balanced fertilizer, allowing the leaves to yellow/brown before removing.

Care Tip: Crocus can be successfully grown in a lawn for a spring meadow effect. Hold off on mowing the lawn in spring until the Crocus foliage begins to die back.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 4-6" tall

Spacing: Plant 2-3" apart, 2-4" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 3-9
