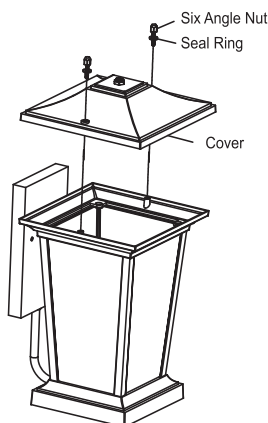
- Risk of electric shock - Disconnect power at the source before installation.

⚠ CAUTIONS

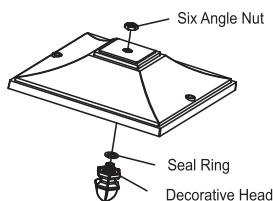
- To insure personal safety, proper grounding of the electrical fixture is required.

WIRING AND FIXTURE MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

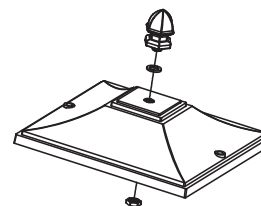
- Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture, in order to prevent possible shock.
- If you are replacing an existing fixture, remove and disconnect the old fixture first.



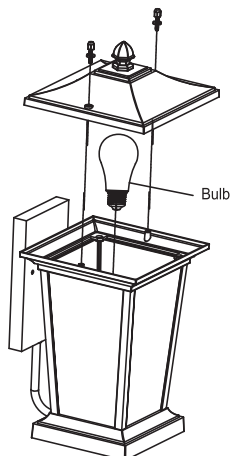
1. Loosen the hexagon nuts on the cover and remove the cover.



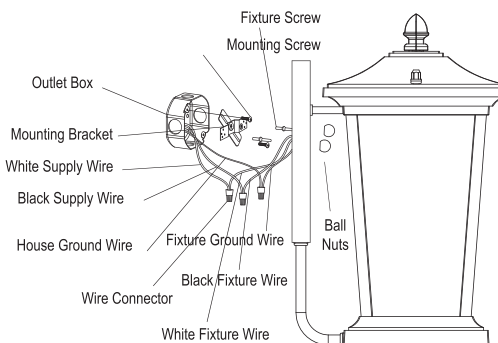
2. Rotate the decorative head down from the back of the cover.



3. Put the decorative head on the upside of the cover.



4. Align bulb with holder and rotate the bulb clockwise to ensure that the bulb is locked to the holder. Then put the cover back and lock it with the two hexagon nuts.



5. Expose the wires from the outlet box.
6. Remove mounting bracket from fixture and install to electric box using mounting screws.
7. Wire fixture to wires in outlet box: Black wire to Black wire (Line/Load), White wire to White wire (Neutral), tie ground wire from Outlet Box and from fixture (bare wire) to the Ground Screw on the Mounting Bracket.
8. Taking care, tuck the wires back into the outlet box.
9. Attach fixture back plate to mounting bracket and tighten ball nuts until fixture sits flush with wall. Fixture screws should protrude from back plate 1/4".
10. The installation is now complete. Restore the electricity and check the operation of your lighting fixture.
