All Surfaces	Care should be taken to ensure that surface is clean, dry and free of loose material. A simple leaf blower is typically sufficient to remove gravel and dust in most instances. Areas with oil buildup or existing epoxy coatings may require power washing or abrading the surface before application. Alpha Grip should not be applied on surfaces less than 50°F (10°C), when the relative humidity is greater than 80% and/or less than 24 hours before expected precipitation.
Painted Surfaces	When applying over previously coated areas, take special care to remove any loose or peeling paint.
Sealed Surfaces	Use caution when painting over freshly sealed surfaces. Sealers can affect adhesion and cure times.
Concrete & Asphalt	New concrete and asphalt should be aged for a minimum of 30 days prior to painting.

	 Apply using a 3/8" nap roller. For best results, apply in uniform coats with light even pressure. Avoid thick coats. Wait 1-2 hours to apply second coat. The second coat should be applied at a right angle to the first coat.
