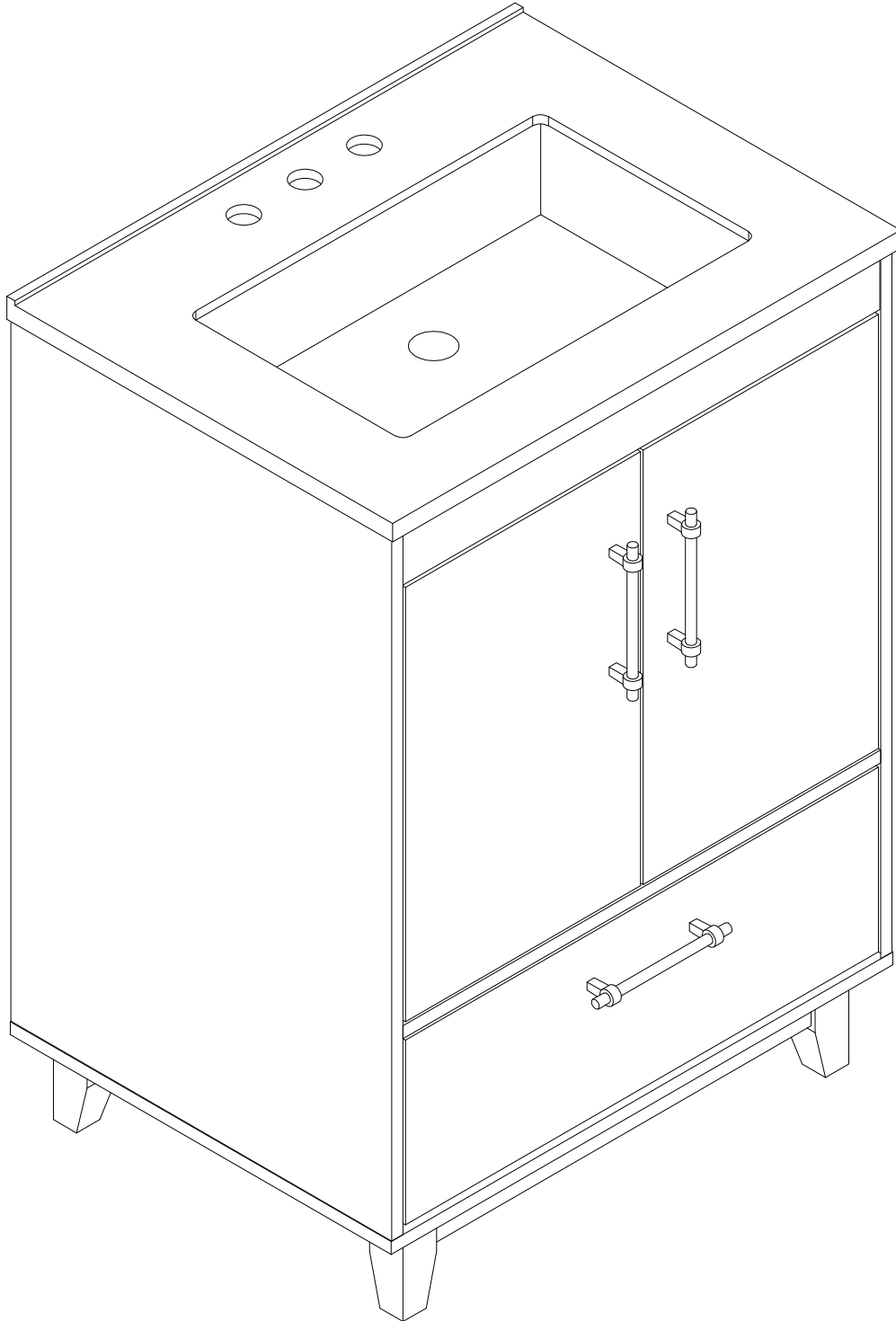

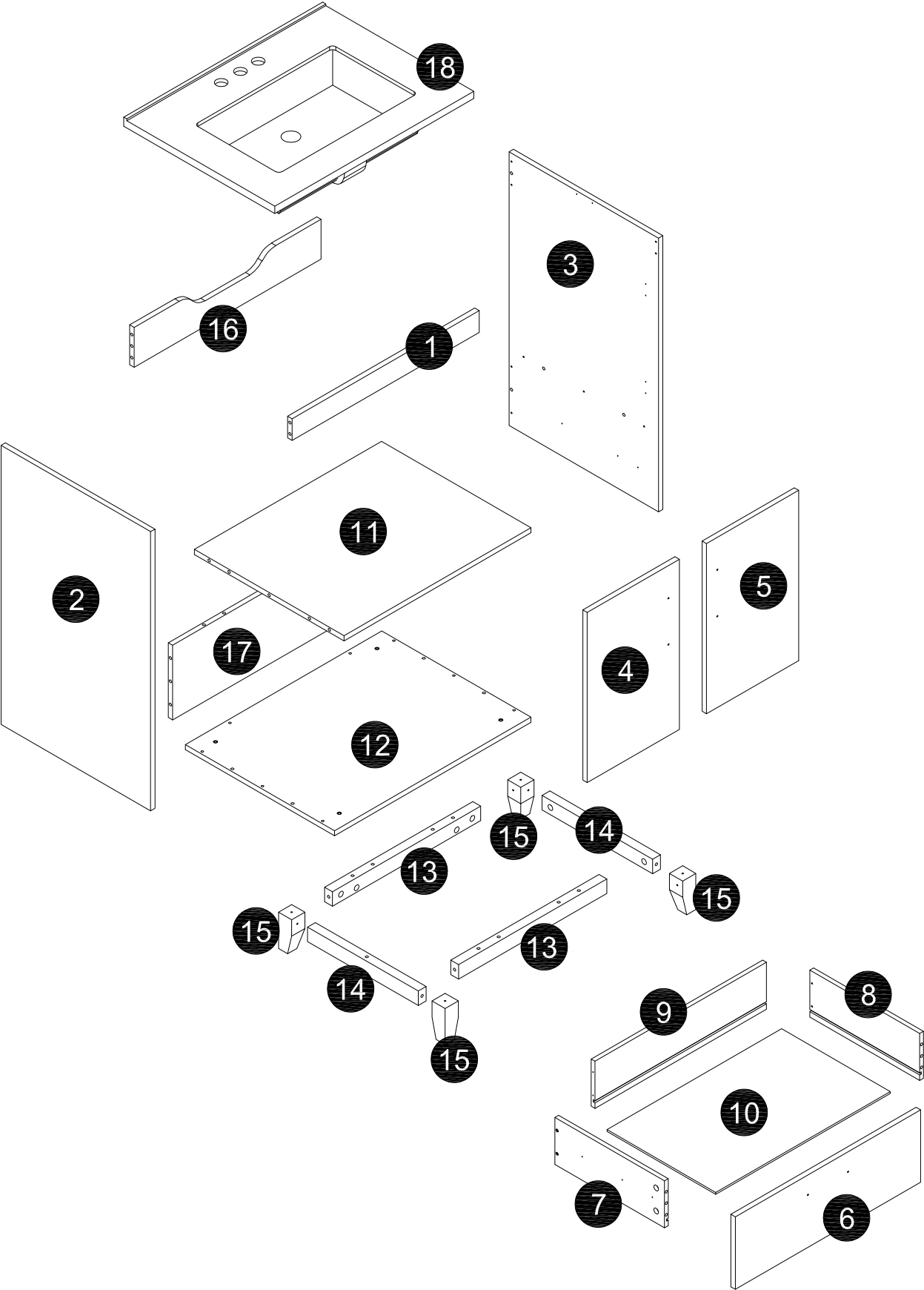

- Always use proper tools. Avoid using a electric drill excessively to prevent damage to cabinet components, especially in wooden furniture.
- Carefully review the parts and hardware list.
- Recommend assembling the storage cabinet on a protected or carpeted surface to prevent scratches.
- Follow assembly steps in order. DO NOT SKIP ANY STEPS.
- Regularly check and tighten all connectors (bolts, screws, etc.). Keep instructions for future reference.
- Exercise caution with sharp edges during assembly and use to avoid scratching or cutting the skin.

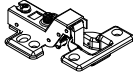
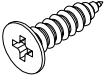
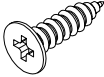
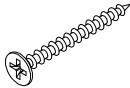
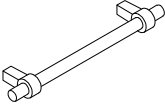
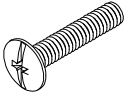
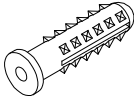
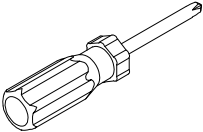
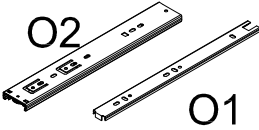
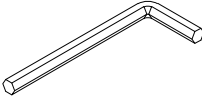
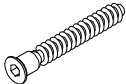
Congratulations on your new purchase! Follow these simple care instructions to keep your product in top condition:

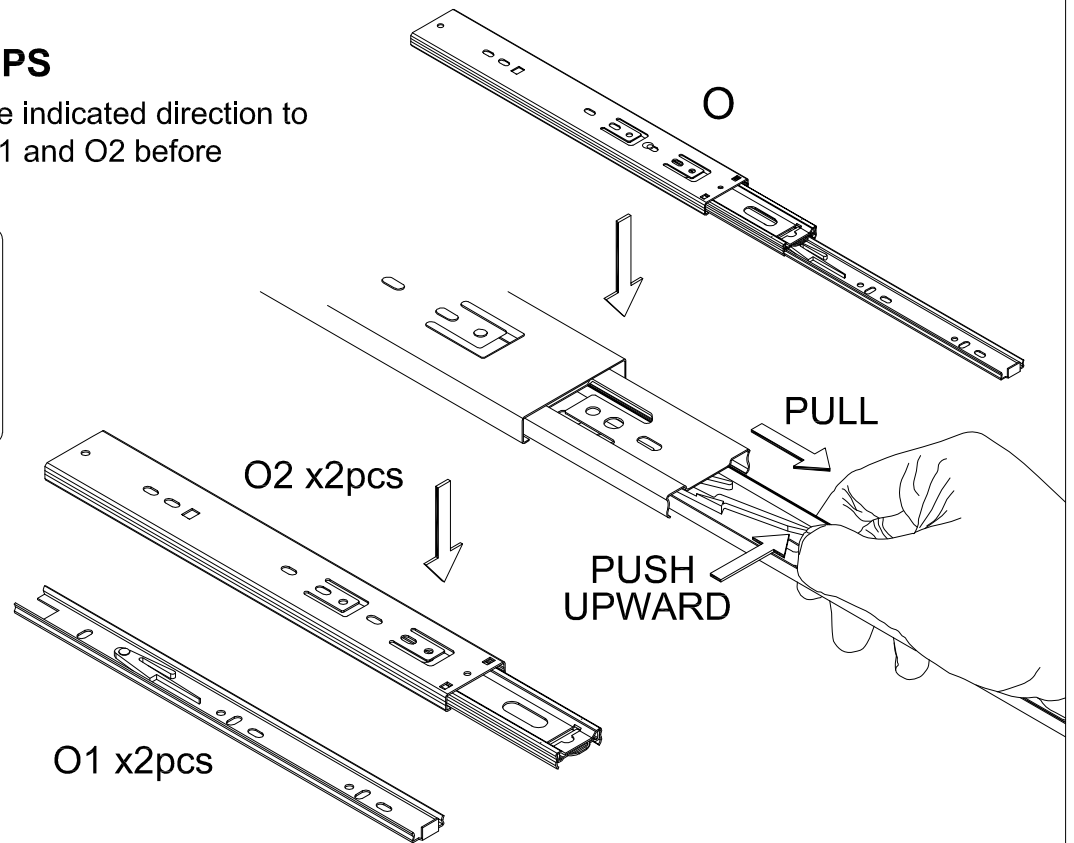

Press the plastic part in the indicated direction to separate drawer runner O1 and O2 before assembling.

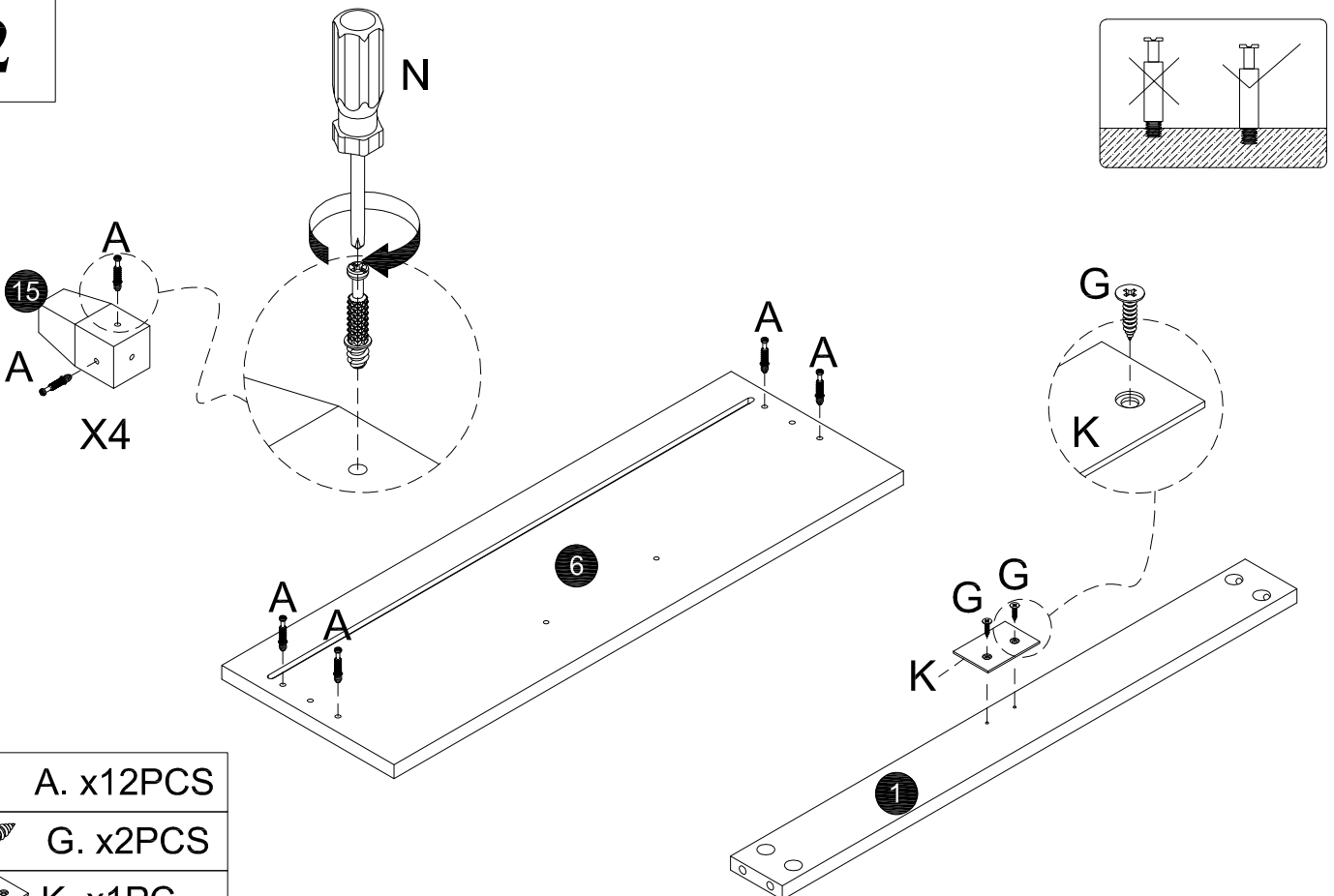

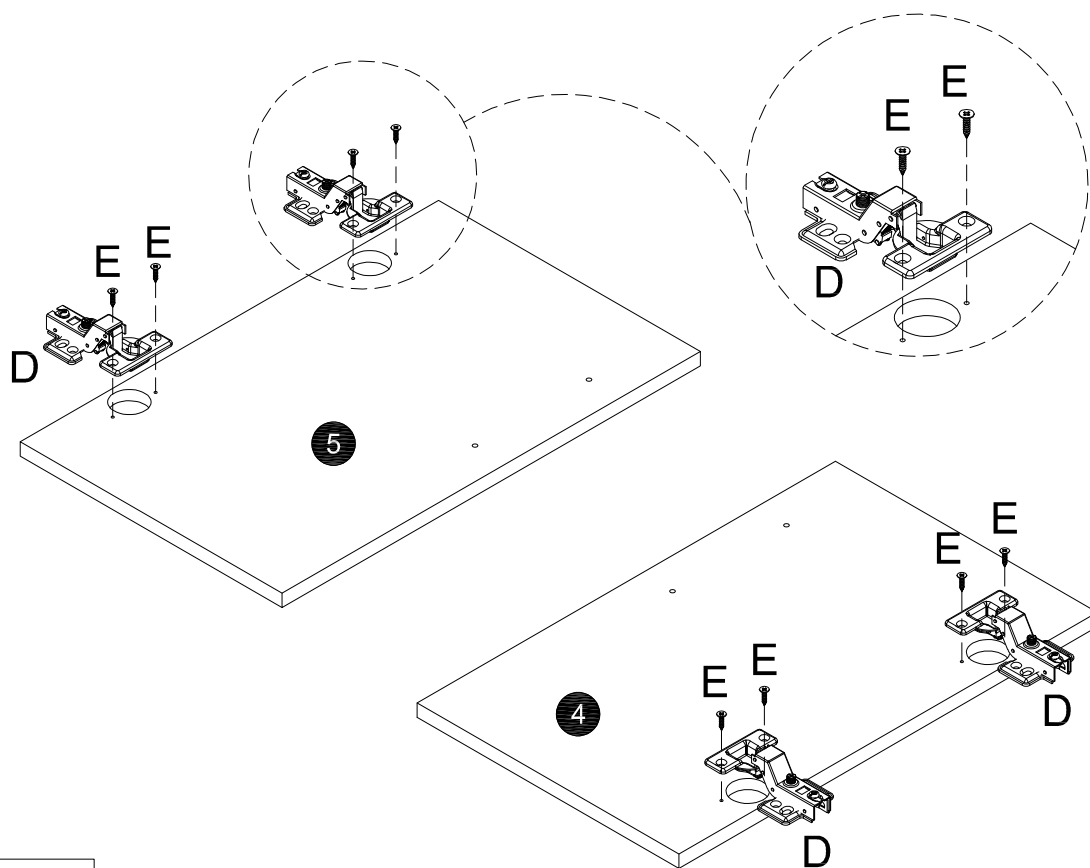
Diagram illustrating the assembly of a drawer front (6) using hardware G, I, J, and O1.
