Blackberries are among the easiest fruit and vegetables to grow for beginners About This Variety: Blackberry Triple Crown, botanically known as Rubus fruticosus 'Triple Crown' is a thornless shrub which is self-fertile, producing a substantial crop of glossy black, full-flavored berries. They produce over a long period, and are easy to pick. While its fruit will come in various sizes some of its berries will be HUGE!

Growing Instructions: Remove plant from packaging. If the roots are dry, soak the roots no more than two hours before planting. Do not submerge the plant. Soak the roots only. Dig a hole slightly larger than the spread of the plant's root system. Place the plant in the center of the hole, spread out the roots and backfill with soil. Firm the soil around the roots as you backfill. Water thoroughly. Trim the plant to about half its original height and remove small side branches. Enjoy for years to come!

Care Tip: Prune canes that bear fruit back after harvesting.

Blooms: Mid Season Exposure: Full Sun Height: Grows 3-5'

Spacing: Plant 5-6' apart, bud union 1" above soil level

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 5-8













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
