- In order to prolong the life and beauty of your product, we recommend storing it in a dry and protected area during off season periods.



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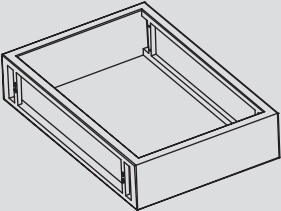
