BRUSH OFF DIRT

It's best to brush or rinse off any loose dirt and debris before it has a chance to become embedded in the fabric. *All-Weather Performance Fabric does not promote mildew growth, but mildew may grow on dirt and other foreign substances that are not removed from the fabric.*

WIPE UP AND CLEAN SPILLS RIGHT AWAY

Wipe up spills and wash impacted areas with a homemade mixture of $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of mild soap per gallon of lukewarm water. Rinse the areas thoroughly and allow them to air dry completely. Standing cushions on their sides will allow them to dry faster.

Air dry your cushions and pillows only; do not dry clean. Do not use heat, hot water, harsh detergents, hard-bristle brushes, or allow your cushions to be submerged and/or left to soak in water.

MAKE YOUR CUSHIONS LAST

If possible, flip your cushions periodically to even out the wear on each side. Store your cushions in a dry, covered area when not in use.



Pulling the tags off cushions may damage the fabric. Instead, carefully remove them with scissors.
