

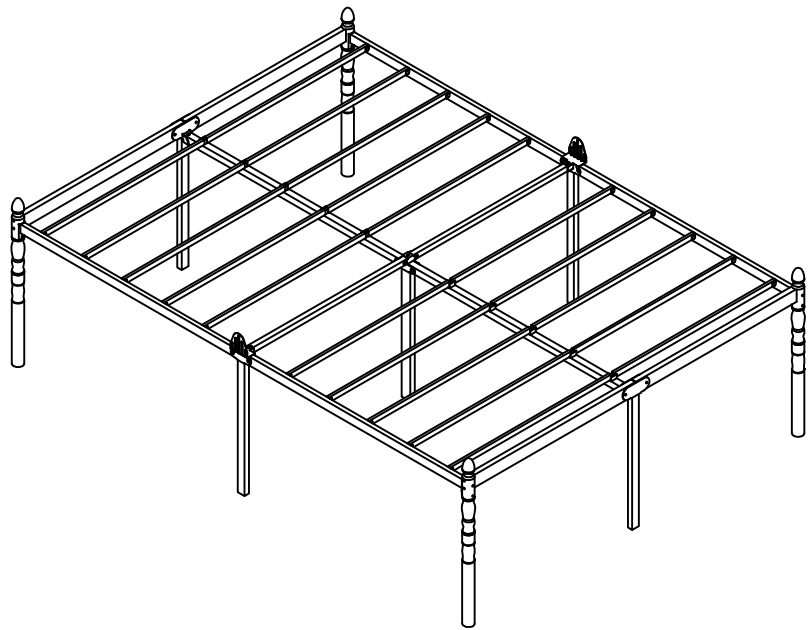

****Read Before Beginning Assembly****

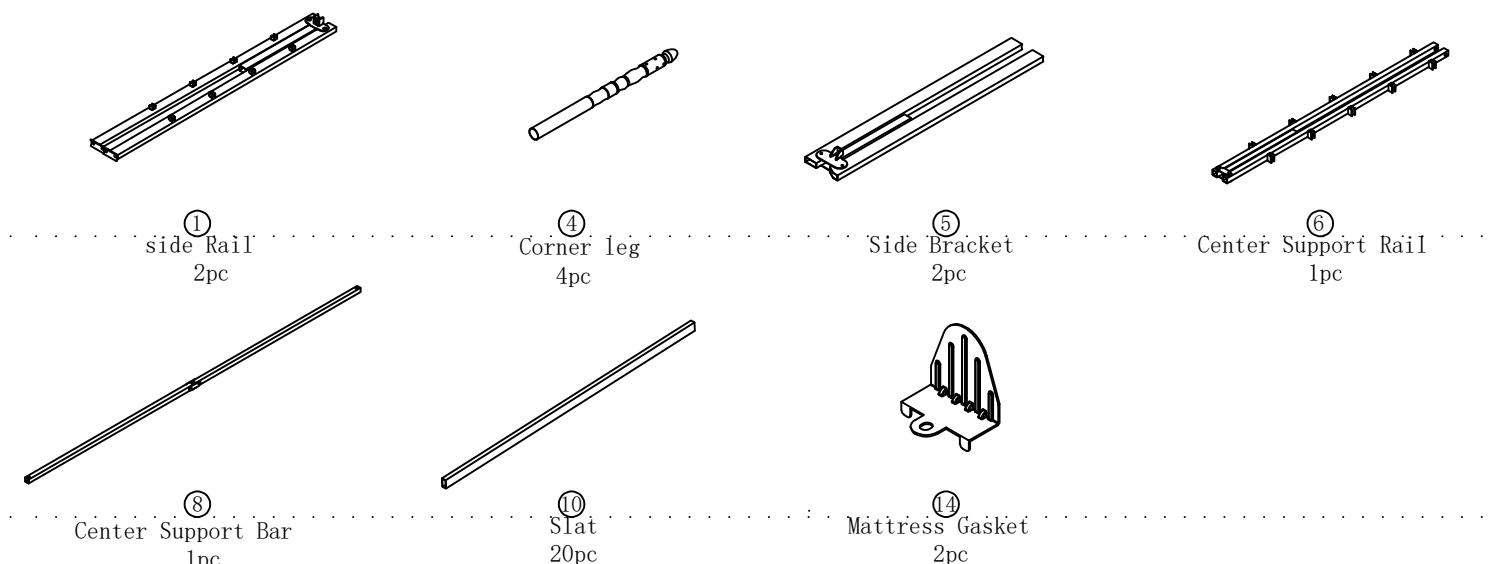
- 1. Clear the area:** Assemble in a spacious area near the product's final location, preferably on a carpet or protected surface (like the product's cardboard packaging) to safeguard both your floor and the product.
- 2.** It is recommended that two people assemble this product. If one person assembles it, you can use the wall, door, table, and other auxiliary support to install it.
- 3. Check for all parts:** Most parts are labeled or stamped on the raw edge. Ensure all parts are included before starting.
- 4. Read each step carefully:** Follow the assembly steps in the correct order. Skipping steps or changing the sequence can lead to difficulties.
- 5. Important:** Do not fully tighten any bolts until the entire unit is assembled. This will allow for proper alignment and adjustment during the assembly process.

****Caution****

- 1. Choking Hazard - Small Parts:** This product contains small parts. Keep out of reach of children.
- 2.** Please use electric tools carefully to prevent overload damage to the product.

****Warranty Information****

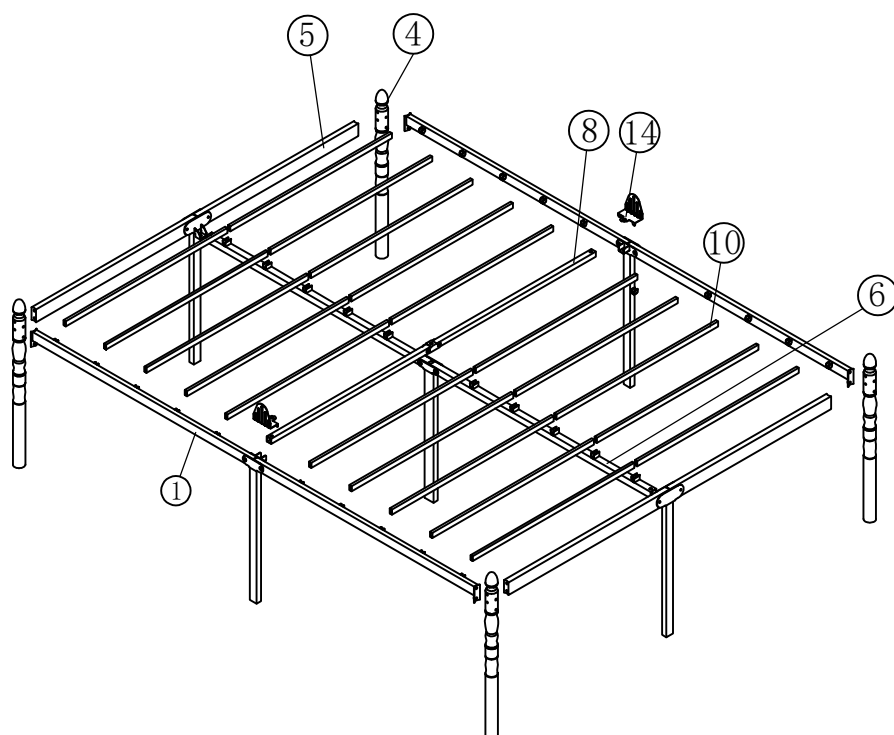

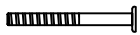
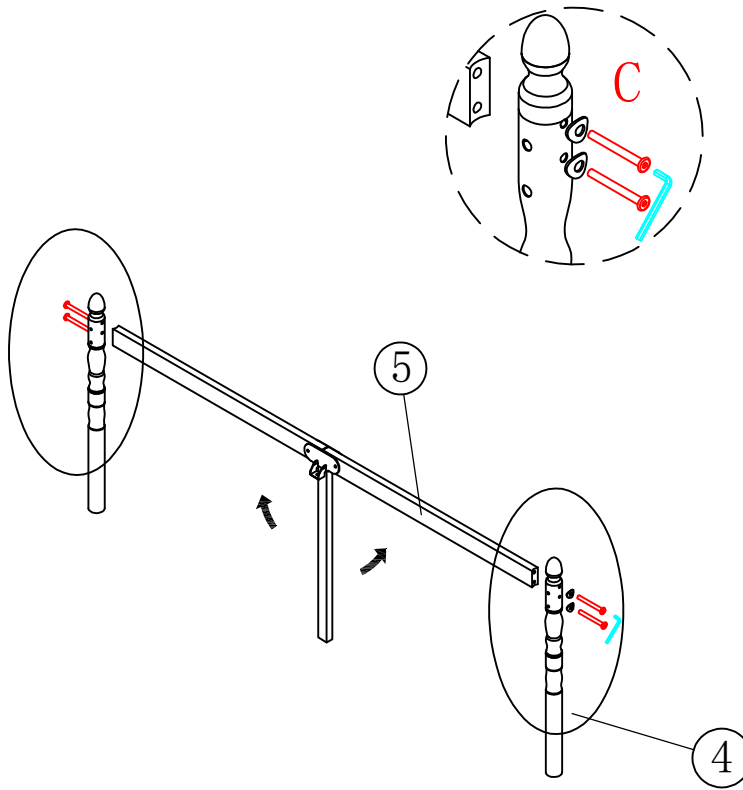
Parts

This page lists all the items included in this package. Please take a moment to identify the hardware and individual components before beginning assembly. When assembling, since there are gaps in the holes, minor adjustments need to be made when tightening the screws .

Step 1

Assemble Side Bracket

- Position the side bracket ⑤ between the two corner leg ④. Insert the bolts (C) and washer (F) through the pre-drilled holes as shown in the diagram and hand-tighten all bolts first to ensure proper alignment.

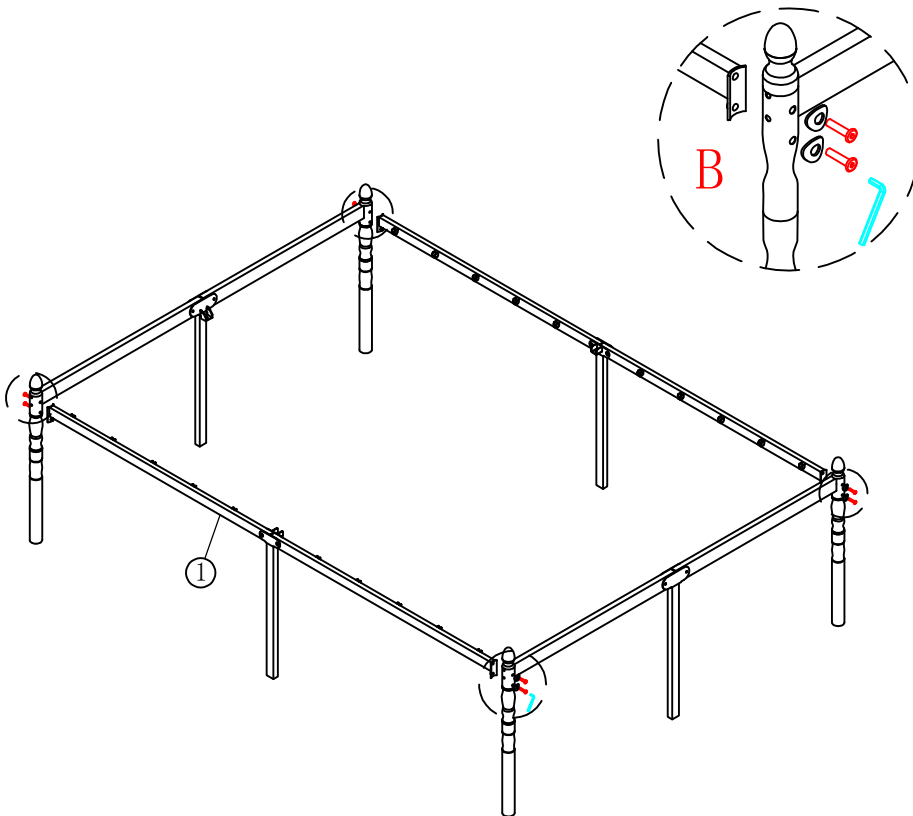

Step 2

Assemble The Bed Frame

- Open the side rail ① and align the mounting bracket with the appropriate holes on the corner legs. After the bolts (B) and washer (F) are in place, use the provided Allen wrench to bolt.

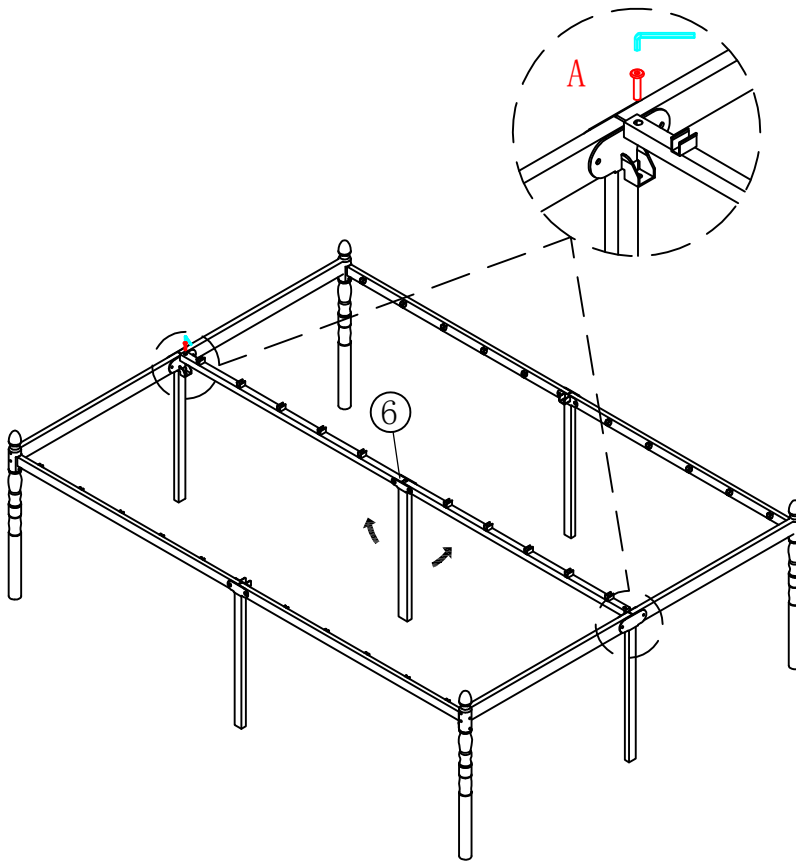
Note: Follow the direction indicated by the red arrow in the detailed view for proper installation.

Step 3

Install The Center Support

Rail

- Place the center support rail ⑥ at the corresponding positions at both ends of the bed frame and firmly connect these pipes with bolts (A).

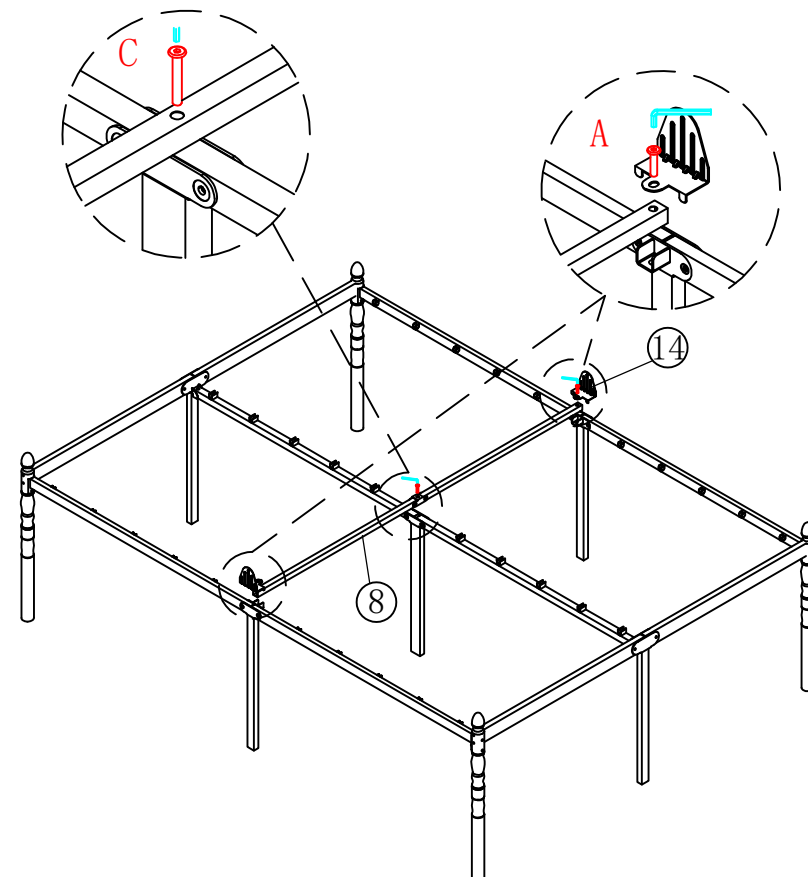
Note: Make sure each beam is fully seated for maximum stability

Step 4

Install The Center Support

Bar

- Use bolts (A) and bolts (C) to lock the center support bar ⑧ onto the center support rail.
- At the center, Mattress gasket ⑭ can be optionally installed.
- After installation is completed, tighten all the bolts.

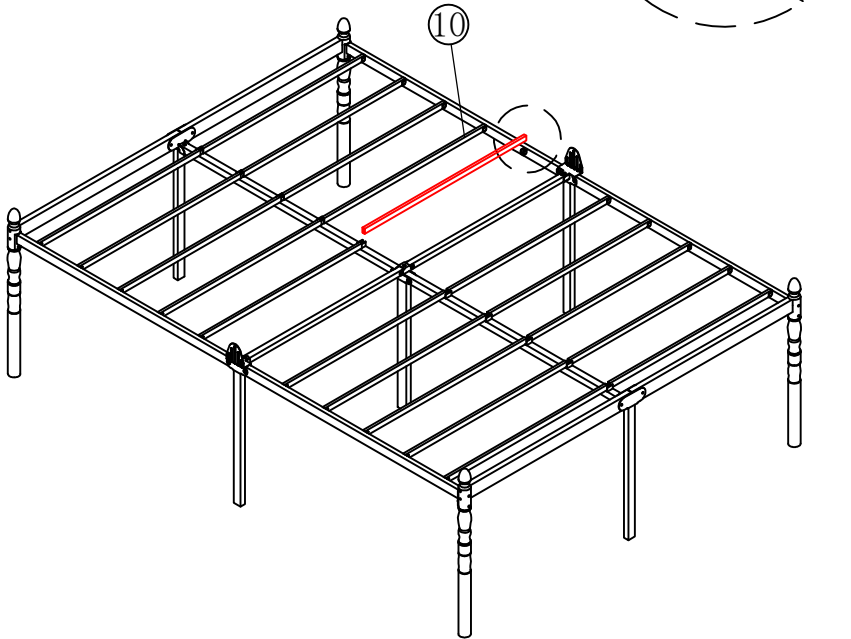

Step 5

Install The Bed Slats

- Place all bed slats ⑩ across the side rails.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

****Warnings****

- 1. Age Restriction:** The bed is not designed for children under 4 years old.
- 2. No Jumping or Horseplay:** This product is not designed to withstand jumping or rough play
- 3. Weight Limit:** The maximum combined weight on the bed should not exceed 1000 lbs. This includes the weight of the bed itself, mattresses, bedding, and people.
- 4. Do not drag or push the bed frame:** Always use two people to lift and reposition the bedframe to avoid damage to the frame or the floor.

****Cleaning & Care****

- 1. Cleaning Method:** Use a dry or slightly damp soft cloth for cleaning. Avoid abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- 2. Hardware Maintenance:** Over time, hardware can loosen. Regularly check and tighten all connections to maintain the bed's stability and prevent damage.
