

Aquaphalt is the first water-activated, permanent repair material for asphalt and concrete that's designed to last. Aquaphalt is a permanent, eco-friendly patch material for asphalt and concrete manufactured in Orange County, VA. It is commonly used by homeowners, DOTs, municipalities, government agencies, schools and universities, property management firms, asphalt maintenance contractors, and anyone who has roadway and parking areas that need to be repaired or maintained. Aquaphalt begins to set-up immediately and is fully cured within 24 hours so your roadways are returned to service immediately.

# FAQ

### What does the date on the bucket mean?

This is the date of manufacture. Aquaphalt has a 1-year shelf life form the date of manufacture.

### What is the coverage rate?

One 50lb. bucket of Aquaphalt will cover approximately 5 sq. feet at 1" thick

### What is the warranty?

3-year warranty if installed at least 1" thick

### How much water should I use?

We recommend 1/2 gallon of water per bucket of Aquaphalt, but you cannot add too much.

## Can I install Aquaphalt on a failing subgrade?

No, you need to remove failing asphalt and compact your sub-grade before installing Aquaphalt.
