Tradesman's tips

Hi! Look out for me throughout this manual. Wherever you see my picture I will have a handy tip to help you with the assembly of your product.

My first tip is: Before you start get a cup of tea, sit down and read through these instructions carefully.

⚠ Warnings

This product is intended for a maximum weight of 110 kg for chair, and 50kg for table.

Do not exceed this weight.

During bad weather and winter months the product should be stored in a cool dry place.

We recommend the use of furniture covers to protect your product when not in use.

This product is for domestic use only.

Keep away from children and pets.

KEEP AWAY FROM FIRE!

✓ Do's

Always use on firm even ground.

Sponge clean with warm soapy water and dry thoroughly.

During bad weather and winter months, the product should be stored using a protective cover.

The product must be thoroughly dried to prevent mildew and mould stains from forming.

Before storage, ensure this product is clean and dry.

The frame is manufactured using powder coated steel tubing and when steel is exposed to air and moisture, it will rust.

Any scratches on the paintwork should be touched up immediately with a metal paint, otherwise rust may occur.

✗ Don't's

Do not stand on chair or table.

Do not use this product if parts are missing, damaged or worn.

Never use scourers, abrasives or chemical cleaners on the product. Do not use solvent based cleaners or detergents as they can bleach or damage the product.

Product is fully assembled. Do not disassemble or modify.
