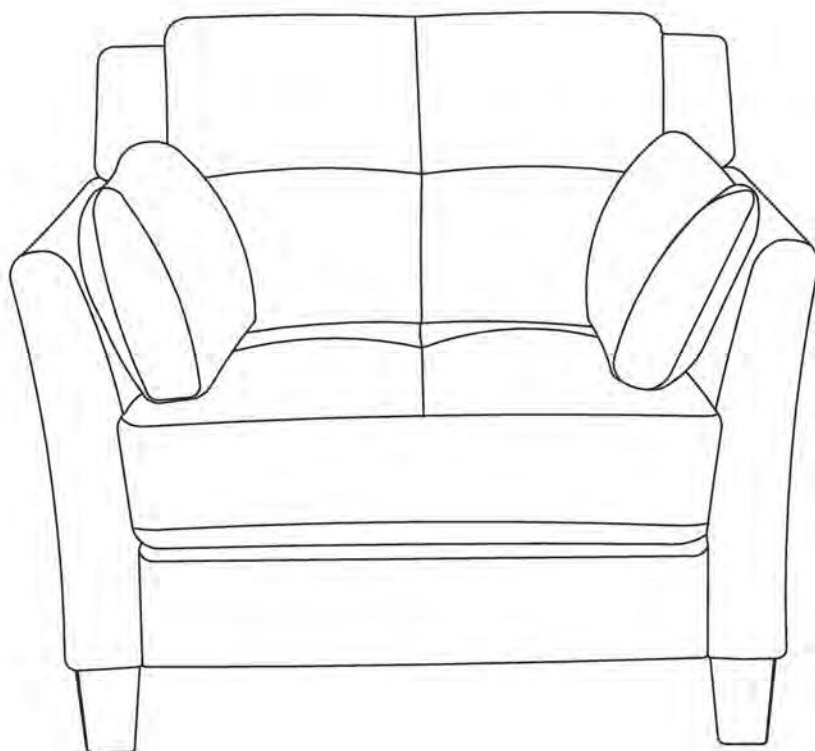
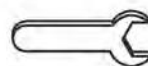

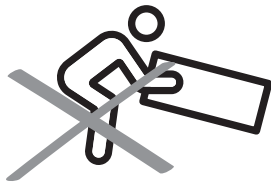

Please review the assembly instructions and all diagrams prior to assembling. Arrange parts as recommended on Page 7 and group identical hardware together to make assembling easier.

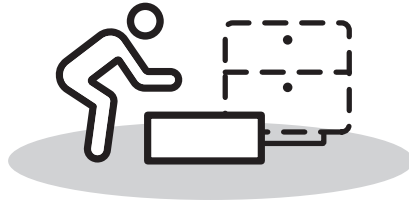
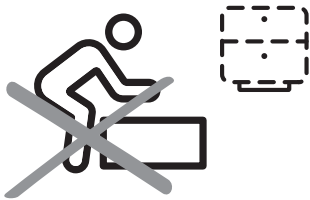
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



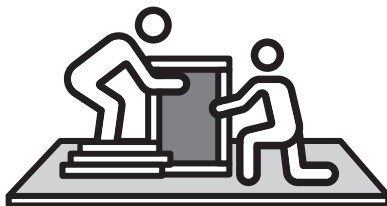
Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



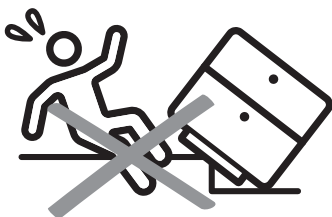
Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE

Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
their respective holes.



Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
to do so.



Use the appropriate hand tools
or power tools for assembly.
Select steps, such as tightening
screws and/or bolts, may require
hand tools to avoid causing
damage during assembly.



Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.

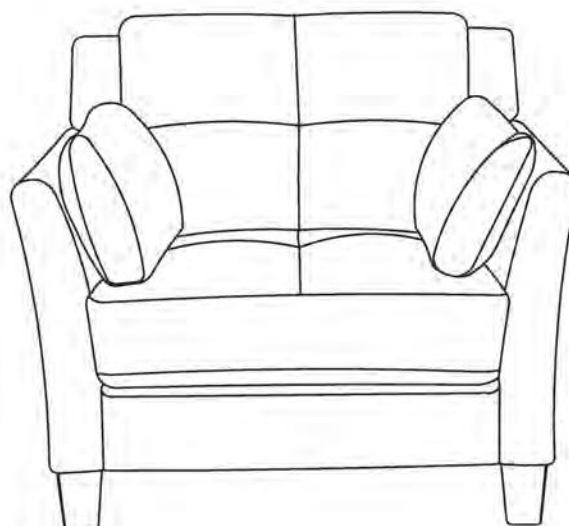
After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

- I. Insert 2 bolts (#A) into each ear (#4), turn right to tighten.
- II. Facing the back, align the ears (#4) to the pre-drilled holes along the sides of the backrest (#2). Insert the ends of the bolts (#A).
- III. Onto each bolt end insert a flat washer (#D) and then a hex nut (#C). Secure each by using the wrench (#B).



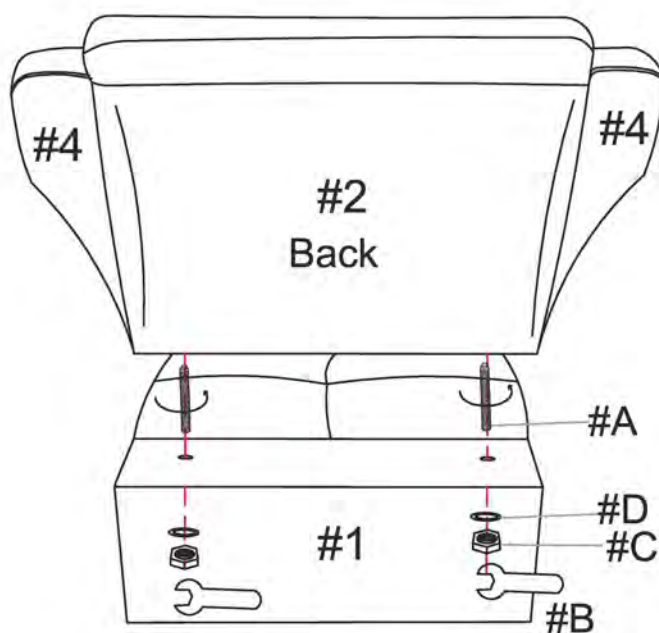

- I. Insert 2 bolts (#A) into the bottom of the backrest (#2), turn right to tighten.
- II. Facing the back, align the backrest (#2) to the pre-drilled holes along the top of the seat (#1). Insert the ends of the bolts (#A).
- III. Onto each bolt end insert a flat washer (#D) and then a hex nut (#C). Secure each from below by using the wrench (#B).

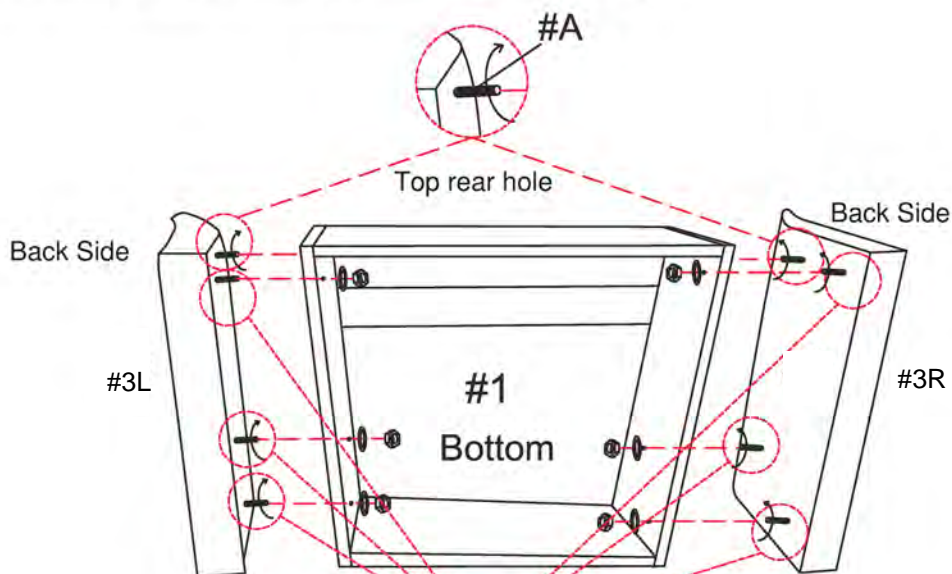

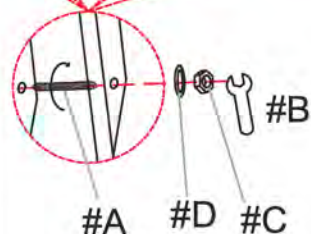

- I. Insert 1 bolt (#A) into the pre-drilled hole on the top back of each arm (#3). Insert 3 bolts (#A) into the remaining holes on each arm (#3), turn right to tighten.
- II. Insert the other ends of the bolts on the arms (#3) into the pre-drilled holes along the sides of the seat (#1).
- III. From within the seat (#1) apply a flat washer (#D) and then a hex nut (#C). Secure each by using the wrench (#B).

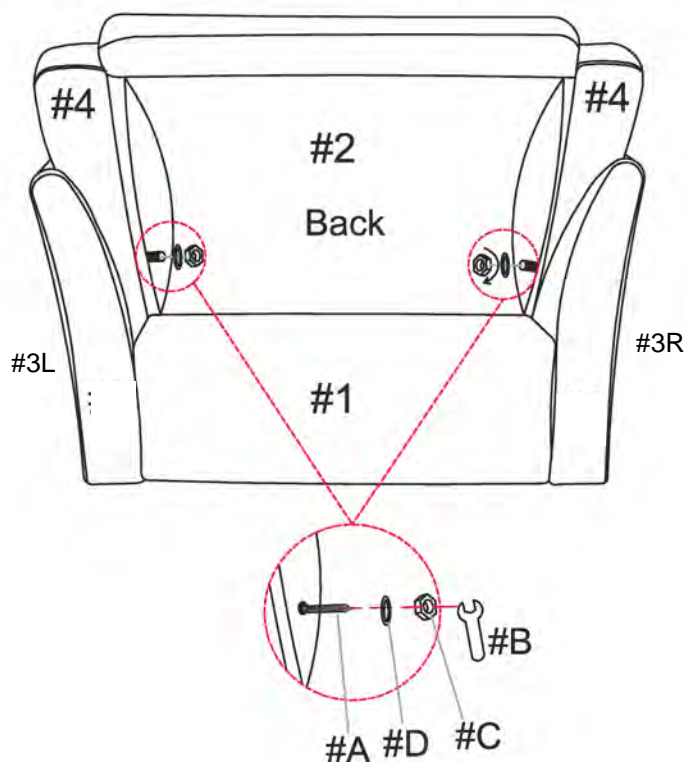

Apply the top assembly onto the seat (#1) and insert onto the bolts (#A) on each side. Once inserted, apply a flat washer (#D) then a hex nut (#C) and secure using the wrench (#B).

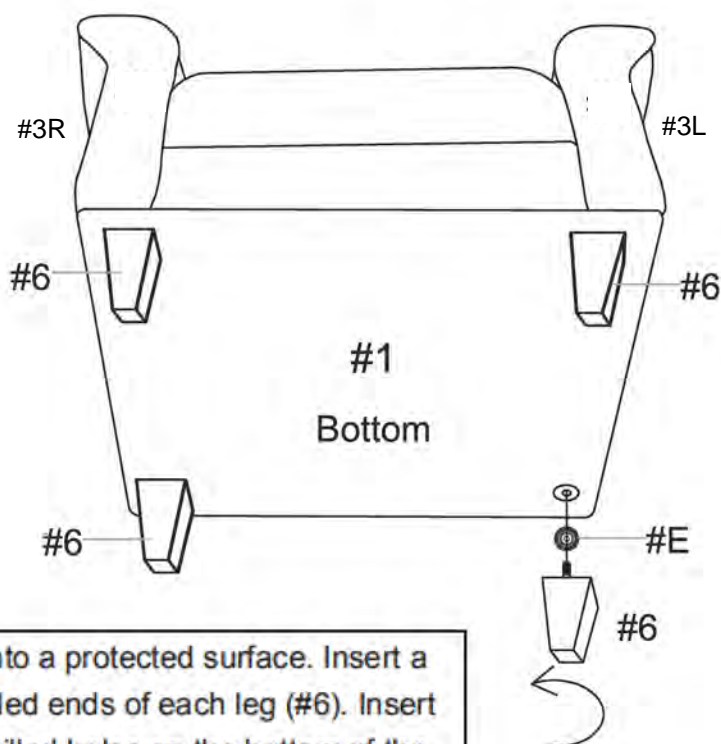

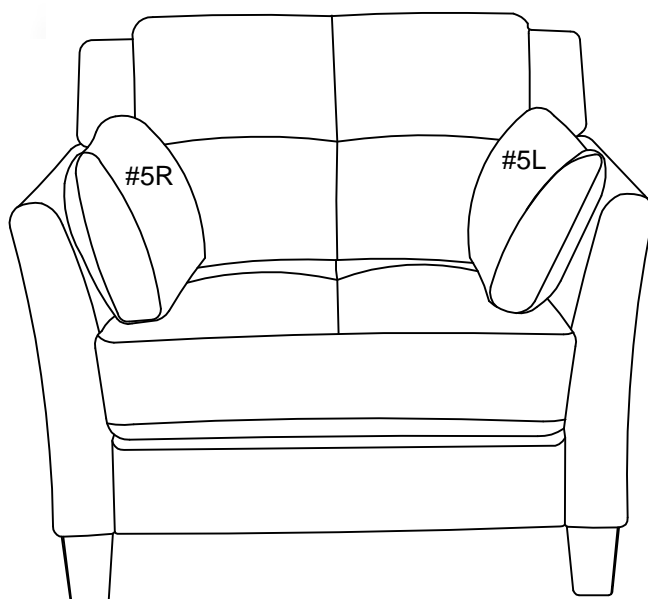


Carefully place the chair onto a protected surface. Insert a gasket (#E) onto the threaded ends of each leg (#6). Insert the legs (#6) into the pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the seat and turn right to tighten.

Place pillows. Make sure all parts are firmly secured.
