ATTRACTS BEES, BIRDS, AND BUTTERFLIES

BLOOMTIME:



LATE SUMMER- FIRST FROST Soft blue, small flowers will cover fragrant silvery foliage from late summer to frost.

WATERING NEEDS:



MINIMAL
At the time of planting the soil should be kept moist, not drenched. Once established Perovskia prefers to be left on the dryer side.

SOIL TYPE:



ALL SOIL TYPES
Perovskia can be grown in a
wide range of soil. It is incredibly
tolerant. A soil that drains well
is ideal.

FERTILIZER:



TIME RELEASE
At the time of planting add a slow release granular type.
Every spring and mid-summer fertilize again with a granular slow release type.
