



Sewage & Effluent Pumps

What size debris can this Sewage Pump handle?

The pump is designed with a vortex impeller and can pump up to a 2" diameter solid which is standard for sewage pump applications.

What size debris can this Effluent Pump move?

The pump is designed with a vortex impeller and can pump up to a 3/4" diameter solid which is standard for effluent pump applications.

Where are Effluent Pumps normally used?

Effluent pumps are used to pump "greywater," which just means "dirty water" with limited solids up to $\frac{3}{4}$ " in diameter. This includes laundry water, limited septic fluids, and other wastewater. Effluent pumps are typically used to pump grey-water from a septic tank to a leach field. They can also be used in sump pump applications when pumping solids up to $\frac{3}{4}$ " in diameter.
