



A DANGER

• For indoor and outdoor use. If using this light in a WET location, connect this product to a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupting (GFCI) outlet to reduce the risk of personal injury, electrical shock or DEATH. If one is not provided, contact a qualified electrician for proper installation.



WARNING

- NEVER use with an extension cord unless the plug can be fully inserted. DO NOT alter the plug.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, DO NOT use the product if power cord is frayed or broken.
- To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock or injury to persons, DO NOT mount or place near gas or electric heaters, fireplaces, candles or other similar sources of heat.
- DO NOT use staples or nails to secure wiring/power supply cord from lights. DO NOT place wiring/power supply cord on sharp hooks or nails.
- This is not a toy! To avoid risk of fire, burns, personal injury and shock it should not be played with or placed where small children can reach it.
- DO NOT hang ornaments or other objects from power supply cord, wire or lights.
- DO NOT close doors and/or windows on the power supply cord as doing so may damage the insulation wire(s).

- The lighting string is rated 8 watts; do not overload. Connect end-to-end a maximum of 16 watts light strings or decorative lighting of the same type. Connect up to 2 sets with included 0.8 watts bulbs.

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PREPARATION

Before beginning installation of product, compare parts with package contents list and make sure all parts are present. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install or operate the product.


Estimated Installation Time: 10 minutes. No tools required for installation.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. **A WARNING**: Do not secure the cord with staples or nails.

Hang lights (A) in the desired location.


WARNING: When replacing bulb(s) (B), please allow bulb(s) (B) to cool down before touching. Replacement bulbs are available on lowes.com.



2. A DANGER: If using this light in a WET or DAMP location, connect this product to a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupting (GFCI) outlet to reduce the risk of personal injury, electrical shock or DEATH. If one is not provided, contact a qualified electrician for proper installation.

WARNING: Risk of electric shock: Install only to a covered Class A GFCI receptacle that has an enclosure that is weatherproof with the attachment plug cap inserted or removed. NOT for use with receptacles that are only weatherproof when the receptacle is covered (attachment plug cap not inserted and receptacle cover closed).

Insert plug-in controller (C) into wall outlet.

Operation buttons on panel of remote control (D):

ON button Turns *lights* ON OFF button Turns *lights* OFF

AUTO button Cycles through all modes

SPEED buttons Press once to change the **speed** of the

light flashes (Speeds 1-4)

R/G/B/W COLOR Select the button of the color you wish to

buttons display

button EACH *light* will change **quickly** from one

color to another.

FADE button Lights will change **slowly** to one color at

same time.

JUMP button Lights will change quickly to one color at

same time.

ASYN FADE button *Lights* will change **slowly** to one color at

same time while one light blinks.

ASYN JUMP button *Lights* will change **quickly** to one of the

color patterns.

TWINKLE button Lights will flash quickly as one of the

color patterns.

STROBE button Lights will quickly change color while

whites lights flash.


IN WAVES button *Lights* will change color *slowly* five bulbs

at a time

TIMER buttons Lights will remain on for a set time before

turning off: 4 hours/ 6 hours/ 8 hours/ OFF


Note: When lights (A) are turned off with remote control (D), the last color command will appear when lights (A) are turned back on.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

 Press button on plug-in controller (C) to change between *fifteen* different light patterns. Press and hold button for 3 seconds to turn string lights (A) off.

Note: When lights (A) are turned off with plug-in controller (C), the last color command will appear when lights (A) are turned back on.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Clean only with a dry, soft cloth. Do NOT use abrasive cleaner.
- Bulb Replacement: Use only E12-base 0.5 watt max. LED bulbs. (sold separately). Replacement bulbs are available on lowes.com.

WARNING: Always unplug this product before replacing bulbs (B). When replacing bulb(s) (B), allow bulb(s) (B) to cool down before touching.

TROUBLESHOOTING

WARRANTY

The distributor warrants all of its landscape lighting against defects in materials and workmanship for five (5) years from the date of purchase. If within this period the product is found to be defective, take a copy of the bill of sale as a proof of purchase and the product in its original carton to the place of purchase. The distributor will, at its option, repair, replace or refund the purchase price to the consumer. All costs of installation and removal of the landscape lighting is the responsibility of the consumer. This warranty does not cover landscape lighting becoming defective due to misuse, accidental damage or improper handling and/or installation and specifically excludes liability for direct, incidental or consequential damages. As some states do not allow exclusions of limitations on an implied warranty, the above exclusion and limitation may not apply. This warranty gives you specific rights and you may also have other rights which may vary from state to state
