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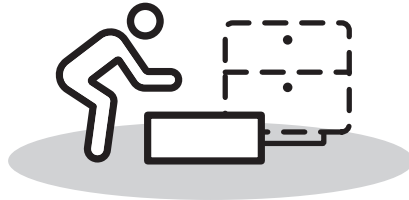
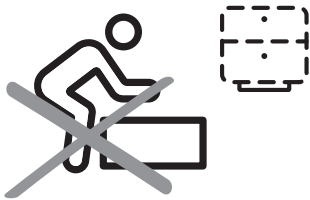
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

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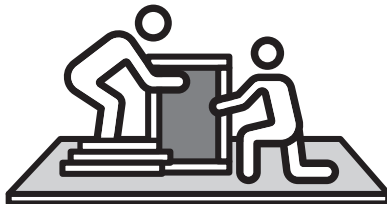
Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



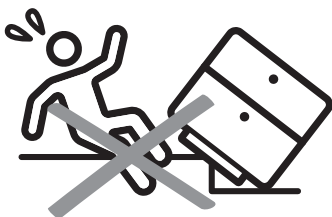
Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent to prevent scratches and damages.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

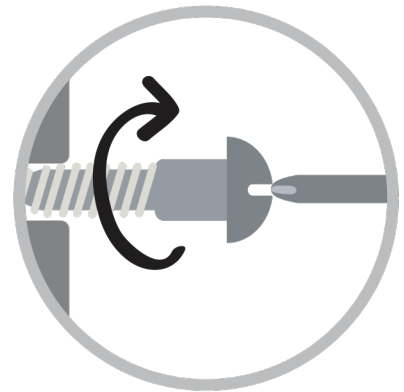

their respective holes.



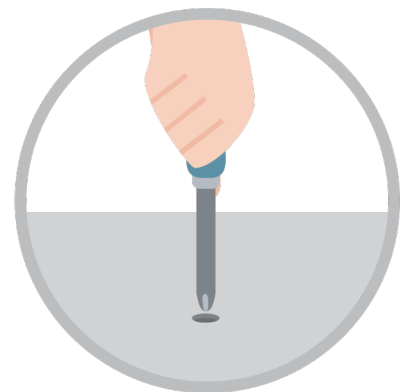
Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
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Use the appropriate hand tools
or power tools for assembly.
Select steps, such as tightening
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Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.



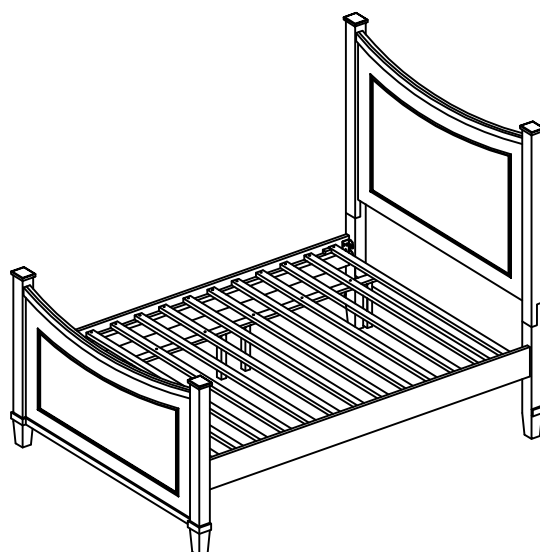
After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

Use the Wood dowels (#G) to align the Under the bed panel (#2) to the Left/Right Head of the bed panels (#1), then secure by using Bolts (#A) with Lock washer (#C) and washer (#D).

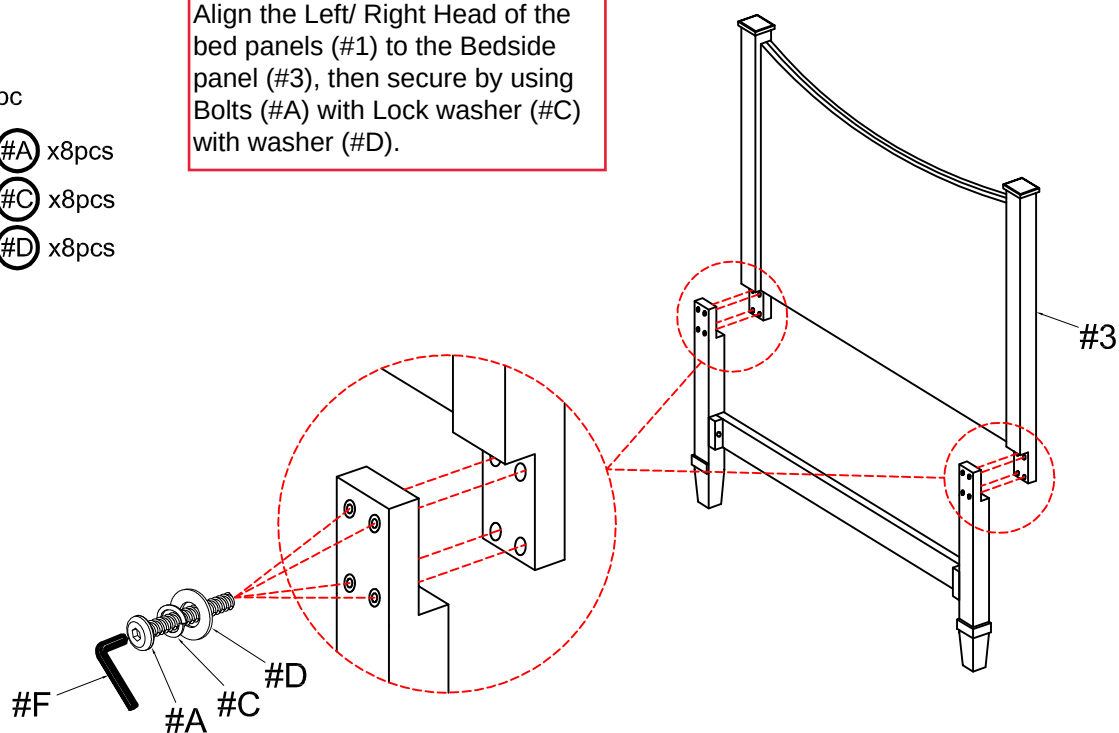

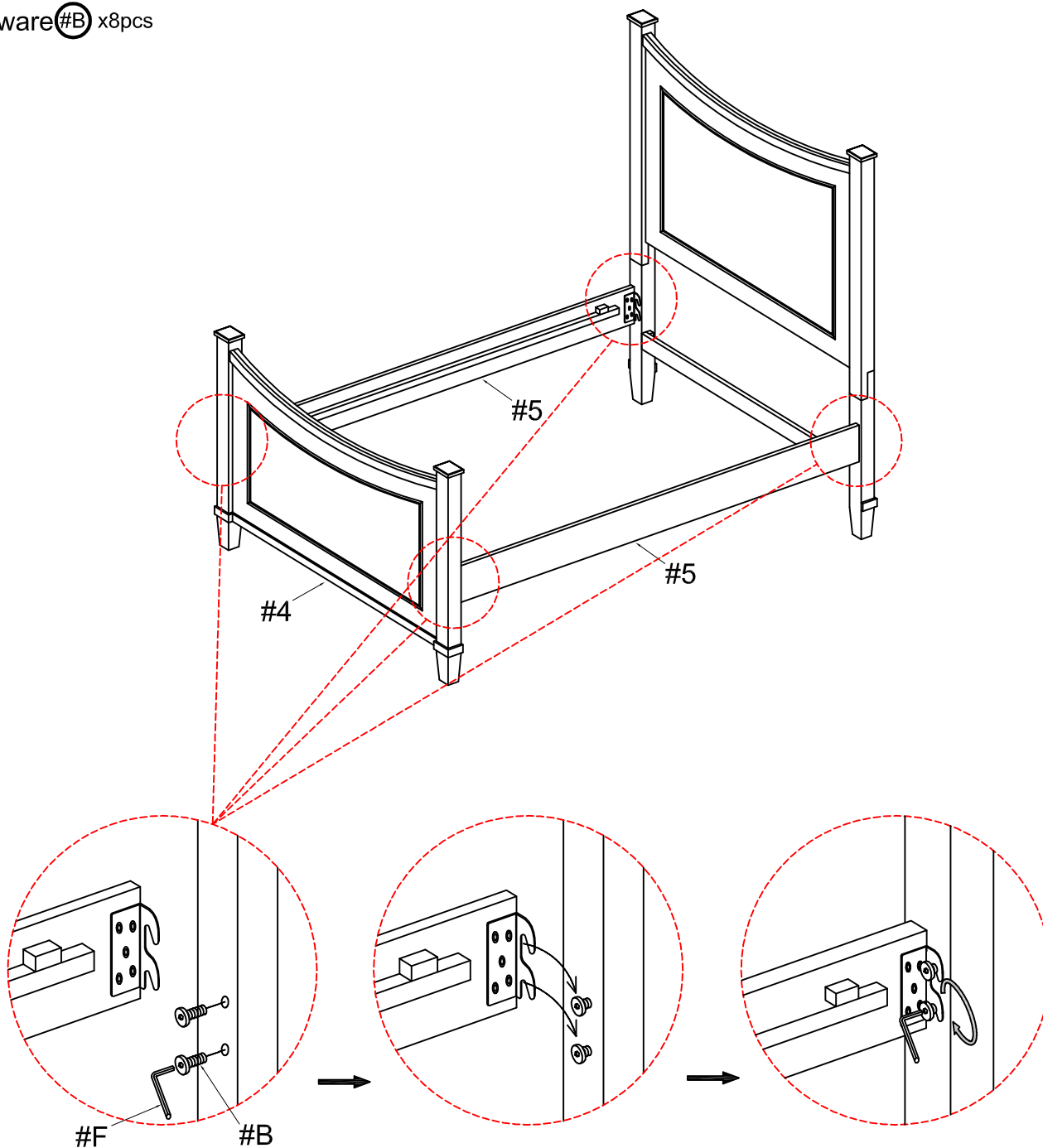

- I. Attach the Bolt (#B) to the Bedside Panel (#3).
- I. Hook the Bed path panels (#5) onto the bolts.
- II. Then tighten the bolt down to secure the rails.
- V. Repeat steps to attach the Bed Path panels (#5) to the Bed end (#4).

I. Twist on the Lower support Leg (#8) to the Lower middle horizontal (#7). Attach the Bed Slats (#6) to the Lower middle horizontal panels (#7).

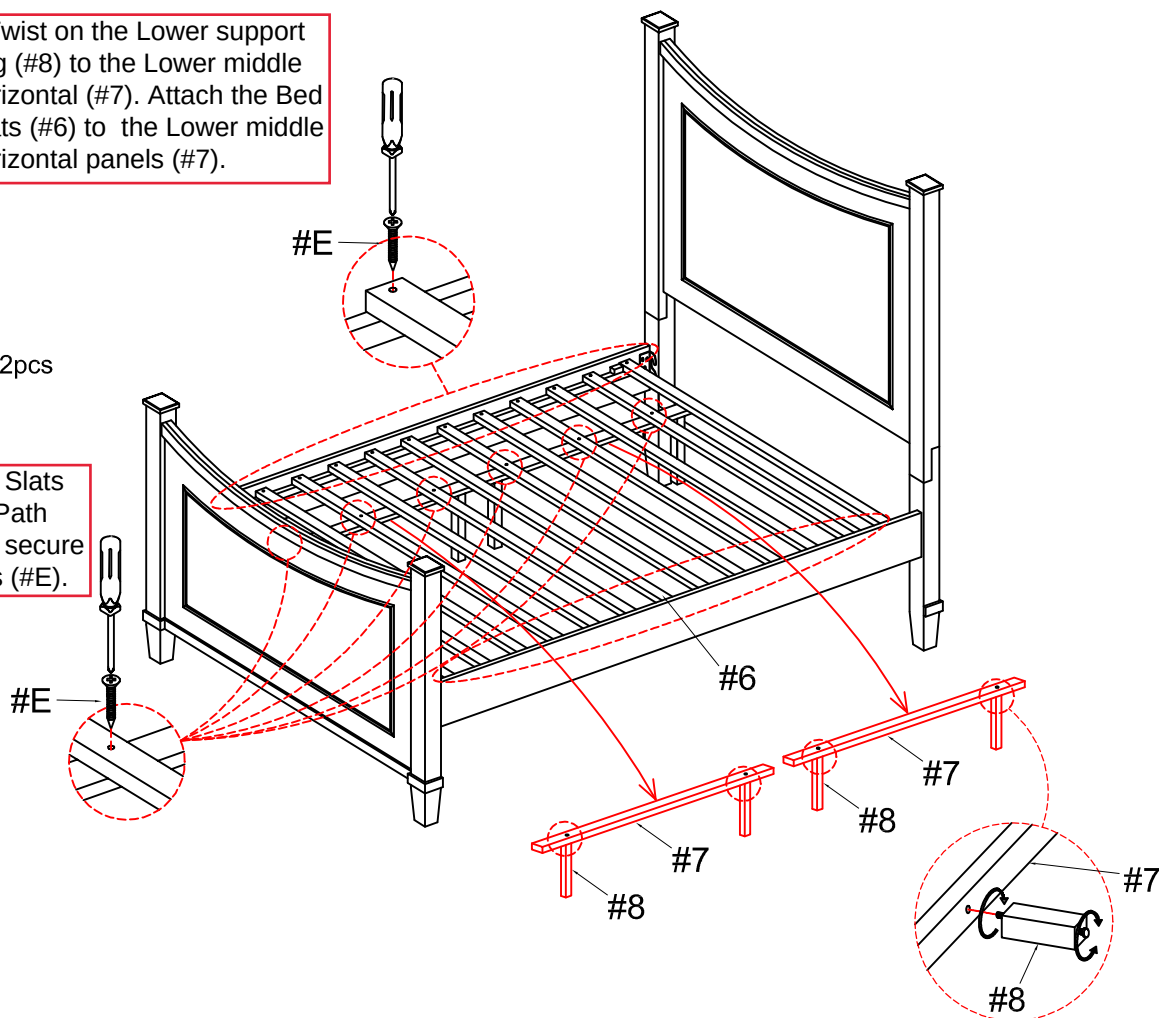

Align the Bed side panels (#2) to the Front Bed panel (#1) and Back Bed panel (#3), then secure by using Bolts (#A.)

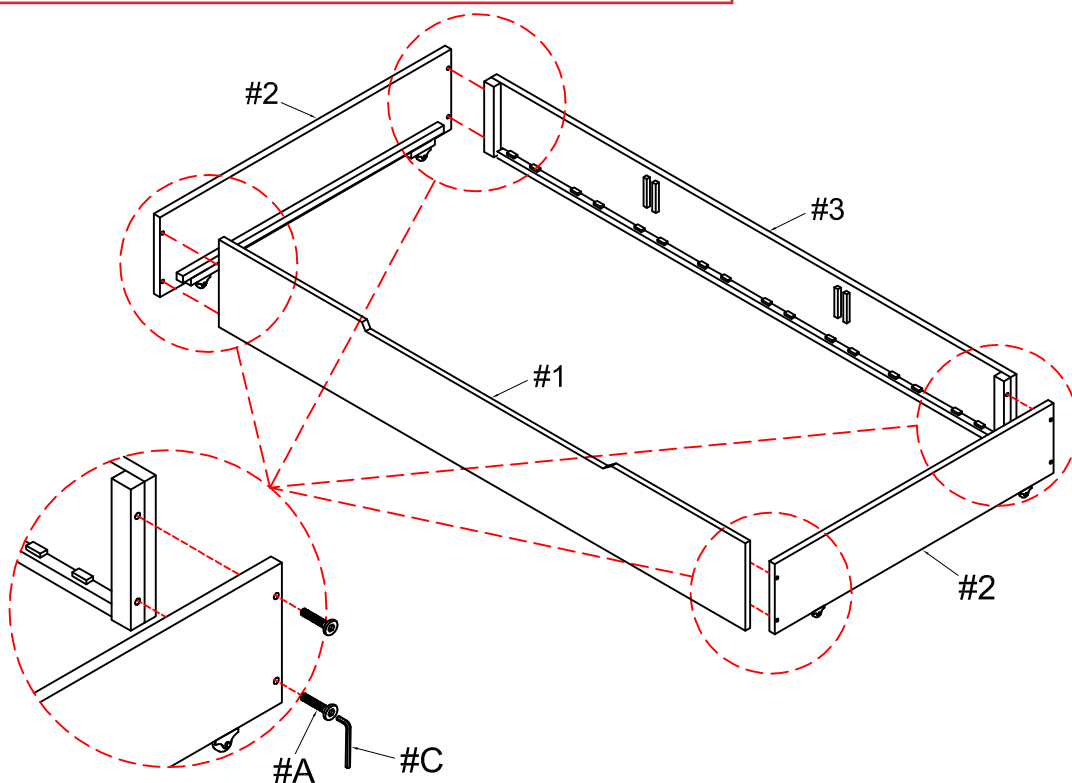

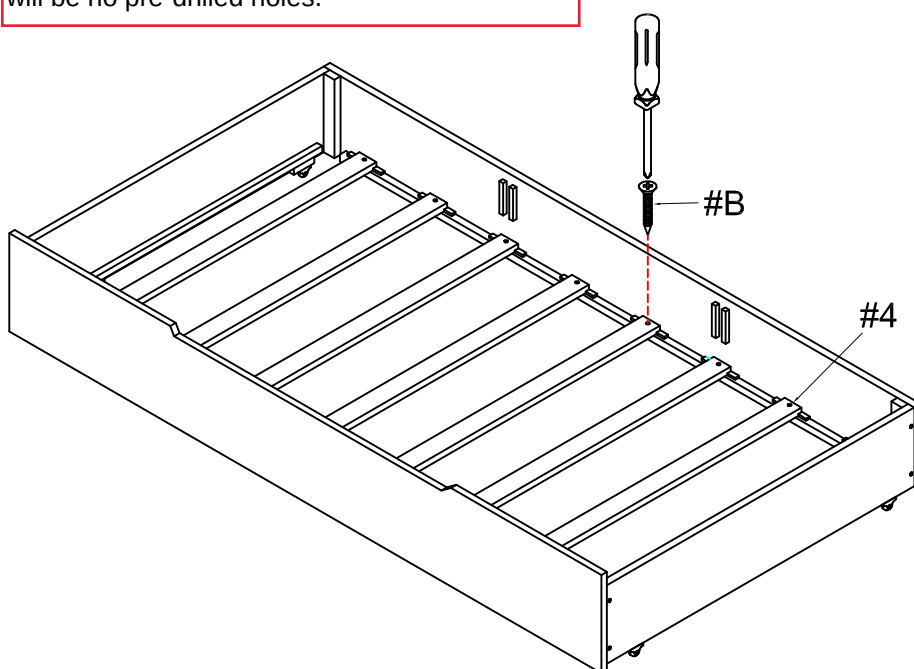

Align slats (#4) to the front and back panels (#1,3), then secure by using screws (#B). There will be no pre-drilled holes.

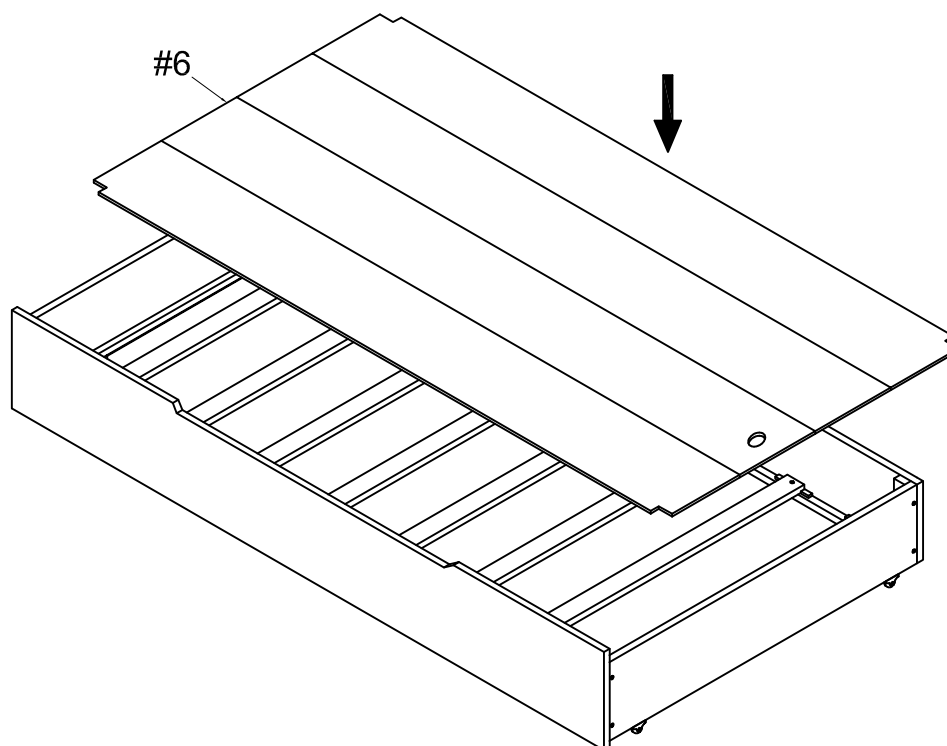
