Failure to follow these instructions can result in death, fire, or electrical shock.






Before beginning, check that all parts are included in the parts package.








Suitable Windows

The window installation kit allows you to install the air conditioner in most vertical-sliding windows 18" to 50" wide, or horizontal-sliding windows from 18" to 50" high.



Install Window

Cut the adhesive foam seal to the proper length, and attach it to the window sash and frame.



Cut the Non-adhesive foam seal

to the window width. Stuff the

foam seal between the glass and

the window to prevent air and in-

sects from getting into the room.

If your window length requires more than 2 panels, after adjust the length. please secure the panels with rivets.



Install Exhaust Hose and Adapter


> Attach the coupling to the flexible exhaust hose. Turn counter-clockwise until securely locked into place.

Attach the window exhaust adapter to the flexible exhaust hose. Turn counter-clockwise until securely locked into place.



Connect The Hose To The Air Conditioner

Insert the coupling into the slot on the back of the air conditioner. Slide down to lock the hose into place.




Draining the Air Conditioner (Heat Pump models only)

- 1. Uncover the primary drain port.
- 2. Attach the drain hose to the primary drain hose. Make sure the connector does not have a water leak.
- 3. Place the other end of drain hose into a drain. Check to see that the hose lies flat and is in the drain. Make sure the hose end that goes to the drain is on a lower level than the hose end that connects to the unit. The
