Royal Horticultural Society Award of Garden Merit winner Low maintenance and shade loving About This Variety: Hosta sieboldiana Elegans is a big, bold specimen variety from Japan. It grows large, heart-shaped, bluish leaves with off-white flowers in summer. It received the Royal Horticultural Society Award of garden Merit in 1913.

Growing Instructions: While drought tolerant, they do not like being kept dry for long. They prefer rich, well-drained soil with a consistent supply of moisture.

Care Tip: Virtually maintenance free. Clip out dead flower stalks after flowering.

Exposure: Partial Shade to Full Shade

Height: Grows 24-36" tall

Spacing: Plant 3-4' apart, 1.5-2" deep

USDA Zones: hardy in USDA zones 4-9
