









## **Installation Preparation**




Measure and spacing




- To install EZ Glaze directly on rafters, the inner rafters must be 24" on center.
- If end rafters are less than 24" on center, then the end roof panels must be cut to proper width before installation (see typical finishing details in the last page).
- Make sure the rafters are perfectly perpendicular to the beams/wall.
- Max load for 24" rafter spacing = 80 psf.


#### EZ Glaze - Installation direction recommendation



For 10 panels or less, start on one end of the structure and work across.




- The maximum distance between horizontal purlins for EZ Glaze is 40" on centers.
- Max load for 40" purlin spacing = 60 psf.




For more than 10 panels, start in the center of the structure and work out in both directions.

## Installation




Applying foamed tape on each rafter will reduce friction.

3 Attaching the first EZ Glaze panel




Attach the first EZ Glaze panel's outer corrugation, using specified screws and washers through the pre-drilled holes. Start at the bottom edge and work your way up.



- Install the first EZ Glaze panel on the rafters, leaving 1"-3" overhang.
- Drill 3/8" holes along the outer corrugation, every 16".
- First and last pre-drilled holes should be located  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-2" from the rafter's top and bottom edges.

### 4 Attaching the second EZ Glaze panel




- Attach the second panel, overlapping the first one.
- Drill 3/8" holes through **both** panels on the lateral overlap, every 16".


 Attaching the second EZ Glaze panel


Using specified fasteners, attach the panels to the structure by fastening through the pre-drilled holes. Start at the bottom edge and work your way up.

7 Applying Expanding foam tape




Expanding foam tape must expand to a dimension no less than 1.75".






Repeat steps 4 & 5 with the remaining panels.




