Assembly

- 1** Put the Ashtray (B) into the Fire Bowl (C).



- 2** Flip the Ring (A).

Operating Instructions

Lighting

- Place a small amount of kindling or fire starter material in the center of the fire pit.
- Arrange fire wood properly. (Recommend using wood log size within Dia. 2 in x L9 in).
- Use a long match or stick lighter to light.
- Add additional logs as needed.
- Please wear heat-resistant gloves during use.



NOTE: When fire lit, there will be some smoke, which will decrease over time as the unit achieves full efficiency.

Make the fire pit less smoke

- Stack fire wood below the interior vent hole (Figure 1).
- Use dry fire wood.
- Create a hot fire.
- Use hardwoods like oak, maple, or hickory etc.
- Avoid burning trash or debris.
- Do not use in gusty weather.
- Build fire wood properly as below teepee and log cabin structure(Figure 2), leaving gaps between the logs for air circulation.

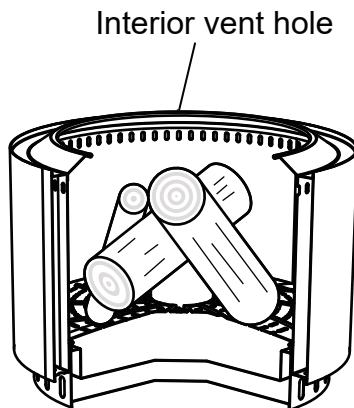
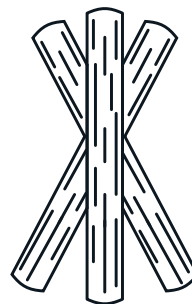
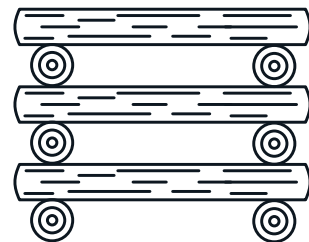

Extinguishing the Fire

- Allow the fire to burn itself out.
- Except in the event of an emergency, do NOT use water to extinguish a fire as this is dangerous and can cause damage to the outdoor fire pit.

Maintenance

- Due to extremely high temperatures, discoloration of the fire pit will occur and is considered normal.
- To extend the life of your fire pit, clean it after each use.
- To protect fire pit finish, use a soft cloth in lieu of bare hands while handling.
- Clean the fire bowl after each use once ashes have cooled.
- Store assembled fire pit in a cool, dry location away from children and pets.

Care

- Do not attempt to clean the fire pit until the fire is completely out and cooled completely.
- Carefully take away the Ring, Take out the Ashtray with the Poker. (Figure 3).
After the cleaning is complete, put it back into the original position and wait for the next use

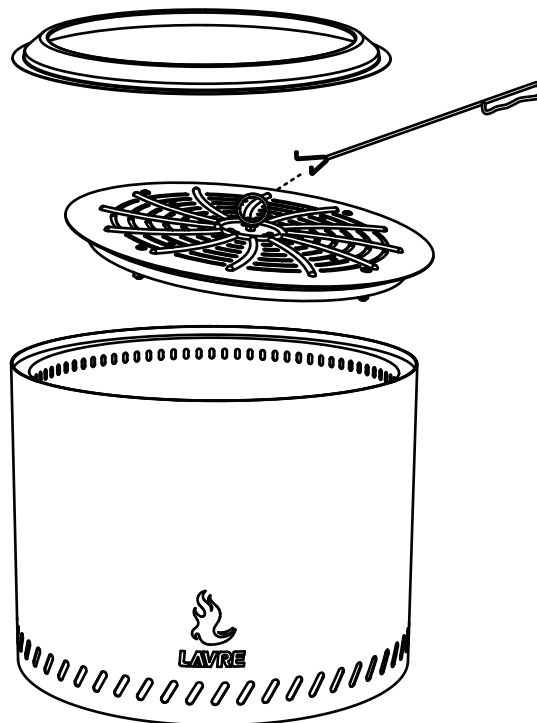
