INTRODUCTION

DIPTM Decorative Wall Planks are unique, decorative, wood-like vinyl planks designed for interior walls and ceilings. Strong, lightweight and flexible, DIPTM is easy to install, as each plank comes with pre-attached, self-stick, super-grip tape that's made in China.

Install DIPTM Decorative Wall Planks as accent-walls, wainscoting, interior columns, around island or peninsula cabinets, headboards, ceilings and much more. Let your imagination be your inspiration

SAFETY INFORMATION

Power tools are not required to cut DIPTM planks. However, those who prefer the use of power tools (e.g. electric saws) should wear the proper safety equipment. Such equipment includes: safety glasses, dust mask and gloves.


PRE-INSTALLATION INFORMATION

- Tools required:
 - Utility knife with several new blades
 - Tape measure
 - Square
 - Chalk line
 - Pencil
 - J Roller (hand roller)
- Install in interior, temperature-controlled environments only!
 - Do not install in saunas, showers or tub surrounds, sun-rooms, seasonal porches, and all exterior installations.
- Acclimate product for 24-48 hours at room temperature at 60°F to 85°F (15°C to 30°C). HVAC system should be operational before, during and after installation.
- Store product horizontally in a dry area away from direct sunlight or heating and cooling ducts. Do not remove planks from cartons during storage or acclimation.
- Post installation temperature ranges must be maintained between 50°F to 95°F (10°C to 35°C)
- Pre-attached, self-stick tape requires 24-48 hours to achieve full bond once planks have been installed.

- Ceramic tile
- Concrete (Smooth)
- Plywood smooth, no knots
- Sheetrock unpainted or painted (latex paint or primer)
- Textured surfaces (e.g. orange peel, see note on page 3)
- Wall paper (paper or vinyl)
- Non-approved substrates:
 - Brick
 - OSB (Oriented Strand Board)
 - Cinder-block
 - Popcorn ceilings
 - Rough concrete
 - Wall paper (paper or vinyl), in good condition and fully adhered to wall with no peeling. Remove wall paper in bad condition
- Prepping for installation:
 - Remove any electrical switches, outlet plates and light fixtures that may interfere with the installation
 - Remove ceiling and base board trim (if desired)
 - Fill voids with spackle/joint compound; honor manufacturer's recommended drying times before proceeding with installation
 - Surfaces must be smooth, clean, dry, and free of any dust, excess mortar (on brick or cinder-block), and foreign matter. Remove dirt dust, oils and loose paint. For best results, the substrate should be as smooth as possible. If necessary, clean the surface with a 50/50 mixture of isopropyl alcohol and water. Then dry with a lint-free cloth.




INSTALLATION

The steps below represent a wall installation using the traditional Horizontal design option as seen in the previous section (Design Options). Use the same steps for a ceiling installation.







2 FIND YOUR STARTING POINT




3 INSTALL FIRST PLANK




A CUTTING PLANKS

- □ Do NOT use cleaning products that contain bleach, strong chemical detergents, abrasive cleaners or scouring pads
- ☐ Hanging pictures fasteners must go through the planks into the substrate or wall studs
- ☐ The use of longer screws may be necessary when replacing electrical outlets and switch covers



NOTE: Textured surfaces (e.g. orange peel) may require sanding to ensure proper adhesion of DIP™ Wall Planks b the way of the pre-attached, self-stick tape. If uncertain, test adhesion in an inconspicuous area before proceeding with the remainder of the installation.

PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE

WARRANTY

Limited 20-Year Residential Warranty

DCF, LLC. warrants that DIPTM Decorative Wall Planks will be free from manufacturing defects for 20 years from the date of purchase. This Limited Warranty only applies provided the DIPTM Decorative Wall Planks covered by this warranty are installed and maintained according to the current instructions posted on our website (designispersonal.com). DIPTM Decorative Wall Planks should be used only in interior, temperature-controlled environments.

PRE-INSTALLATION

DCF, LLC. warrants that DIPTM Decorative Wall Planks are free of visual defects. You and/or your installer should carefully inspect each piece before installation. Any planks that appear to have a defect should not be installed. DCF, LLC. will not be responsible for any claim for planks installed with visual defects.

TERMS OF WARRANTY

If a defect covered by this Limited Warranty is found and reported (in writing) within 20 years from the date of purchase to the merchant from whom the product was purchased, DCF, LLC. will supply new material of similar color, pattern and quality to replace the defective planks. This Limited Warranty does not included labor or the cost of labor for installation of the replacement planks.

EXCLUSIONS

The following are not covered by this Limited Warranty:

Dissatisfaction or damage due to improper installation or maintenance, including substrate moisture, alkalinity, unevenness or irregularities
Labor charges for installation or removal of planks with apparent defects at the time of installation
Damage caused by fire or burns, abuse, flooding, leaks, smoke, fumes, construction or installation
Changes in color, shade or sheen appearance when exposed to sunlight, incandescent light or nonstandard conditions
Normal wear and tear

WARRANTY, continued

Exterior applications
Installations in saunas, sun-rooms, boats, campers or RV's
Scratches or damage caused by handling or instruments
Peeking of edges (white line)
Minor shading, color or texture differences between samples, replacement planks, printed materials, photographs or illustrations and delivered product
Products sold as irregulars or trial grade materials or "as is"
Damage caused by misuse of product (including installation of DIP™ Decorative Wall Planks as flooring)
This Limited Warranty is void if the planks are not continuously maintained at temperatures between $50^{\circ}\text{F} - 95^{\circ}\text{F}$ ($10^{\circ}\text{C} - 35^{\circ}\text{C}$)
Damage caused by nonstandard conditions of standing water, moisture, leaks, condensation or excessive humidity. Such conditions may facilitate the growth of mold; mold or damage caused by mold is not covered by this Limited Warranty and is not the responsibility of DC LLC.
Loss due to loss of time, inconvenience, incidental expenses (such as telephone calls, labor and/or materials) incurred in removal or reinstallation of the affected material, and any other incidental or consequential damages

Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages so that the above limitations and exclusions may not apply. Your warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may have other legal rights, which vary from state to state.

This warranty is in lieu of any other warranties, expressed or implied. Please keep your receipt. DCF, LLC. needs the receipt in order to verify date of purchase to help resolve any problems.

WARRANTY OWNER

This warranty applies only to a residential homeowner who is the original purchaser of DIPTM Decorative Wall Planks, not to any subsequent homeowner.
