# **CHOKING HAZARD -** Small Parts **NOT** for children under 3 years of age.

### Please read these warnings and the information in this manual in its entirety.

Failure to comply with the following instructions may increase the risk of serious injury and/or death:

- This unit must be assembled and disassembled by ADULTS ONLY.
- This See Saw is suitable for use by most children 3 TO 7 YEARS OF AGE.
- Never use this product in any manner other than its intended
  use
- DO NOT exceed the MAXIMUM WEIGHT limit of 150lbs (75 Lbs per seat) regardless of age.
- This unit has a MAXIMUM FALL HEIGHT of 43.5"
- DO NOT install this equipment over concrete, asphalt, or any other hard or rough surface.
   The See Saw should always be installed over an appropriate, stable surface (rubber mat, grass, etc).
- ALWAYS locate this equipment on a stable, level surface AT LEAST 7 feet away from any structure, obstruction, or possible hazard(s) such as walls, pools, power lines, overhangs, other playground equipment, driveways, hard surfaces and/or roadways.
- Children must be supervised at all times when using this equipment. DO NOT leave children unattended at any time.
- DO NOT attach items not specifically designed for this purpose. Especially in the case of jump ropes, chains, clotheslines, pet leashes and cables. These may cause a strangulation or physical hazard.


- DO NOT allow children to stand on the seesaw.
- This See Saw is only designed for family residential use. It is NOT intended for commercial applications and/or use in public areas such as schools, parks, nurseries, day schools, day cares, etc.
- DO NOT allow more than one child on each See Saw seat at a time
- Instruct children to always be sure that the area under and around the seesaw is clear of any persons, pets or obstructions before using.
- DO NOT allow children to wear glasses or helmets when using the See Saw, including bike or other sports helmets.
- DO NOT allow children to wear loose fitting clothing, clothing with straps/loops, backpacks or wear and/or hold accessories with straps or loops, otr any article of clothing or accessory with sharp edges which may present a hazard or become snagged or caught on the See Saw during use. Serious injury and/or accidental strangulation may occur.
- DO NOT place objects on or under the see saw, or allow people and pets to stand or sit on, near or under the See Saw when in use.
- DO NOT allow children to stand on the frame, or hang from the steel tubing – this can cause serious injury.

- Children must ALWAYS remain securely seated, in the forward facing position when using.
- DO NOT use in adverse weather conditions, while the seats are wet, or in poorly lit conditions.
- ALWAYS secure the See Saw against unsupervised use.
- ALWAYS wear the appropriate footwear (i.e. closed toe shoes) when using the See Saw.
- Before each use of this product and twice per month, inspect and replace any worn, loose, defective or missing parts and tighten all hardware. All moving parts should be lubricated with a household lubricant.
- It is important to check the entire See Saw to ensure the Frame Tubing, Protective Coverings, and Seats are steady and all parts and tubing caps are attached in good condition. If any loose, cracked, missing, or otherwise damaged components are found, cease use of this item immediately.
- Check metal parts for rust. If rust is found, sand and repaint using a non-lead based paint. If removed for winter storage, reinstall any plastic parts before allowing use.
- Rake and check depth of loose fill protective surfacing materials to prevent compaction and maintain appropriate depth. Replace as necessary.


- At the end of the play season or when the temperature drops below 40 degrees Fahrenheit, this unit must be disassembled and stored inside.

#### STEP 1

#### Parts:


Part 1 (x2) - Base Rail Part 2 (x2) - Base Bar Part 4 (x2) - Arm A Part 7 (x2) - Arm B

Part 10 (x4) - M6x40mm Bolt Part 11 (x4) - M6 Washer Part 12 (x4) - M6 Nut

Attach both Base Rails and Base Bars to create the bottom frame of the seesaw.

Install both Arm A & Arm B from the outside of the frame using the hardware provided. Repeat this step in both sides of the frame.

NOTE: Make sure to install the bolts from the outside, with washer and nuts on the inside of the frame to avoid injury.



#### STEP 2:


#### Parts:

Part 8 (x2) - Side Rails Part 10 (x4) - M6x40mm Bolt Part 11 (x4) - M6 Washer Part 12 (x4) - M6 Nut

NOTE: The Side Rails will have 12 openings on the side and 4 on the bottom. Make sure that all bottom openings are facing the floor.

Align the openings of the Side Rails hooks to the bottom openings of the Arms A & B.

NOTE: Make sure to install the bolts from the outside, with washer and nuts on the inside of the frame to avoid injury.



#### STEP 3

#### Parts:


Part 3 (x2) - Handle Bars Part 10 (x4) - M6x40mm Bolt Part 11 (x8) - M6 Washer Part 12 (x8) - M6 Nut

Part 13 (x4) - M6x50mm Bolt

Slide the Handle Bars (Part 3) in the middle of the frame and install using the hardware provided.

Align to the bottom of the frame and the middle of the side rails until snug.

NOTE: Make sure to install the bolts from the outside, with washer and nuts on the inside of the frame to avoid injury.



#### STEP 4


#### Parts:

Part 6 (x4) - Seats/Back Rest Part 14 (x16) - M6x35mm Bolt Part 15 (x16) - Square Nuts

Flip over seesaw to install seats.

Install the seats to the rail of the Seesaw with the ridges facing away.

Use the M6x35mm (Part 14) Bolts to align to the openings and secure using the Square Nuts (Part 15) from the inside of the Seat/ Back Rests (Part 6)



#### STEP 5:

#### Parts:


Part 5 (x2) - Foot Rest Part 10 (x4) - M6x40mm Bolt Part 11 (x4) - M6 Washer Part 12 (x4) - M6 Nut

Align the Foot Rest (Part 5) with the hooks facing away from the seats to the openings of the handle bars (Part 3).

Install using the hardware provided.

NOTE: Make sure to install the bolts from the outside, with washer and nuts on the inside of the frame to avoid injury.

Before preceding to step 6, make sure all hardware and bolts are securely tightened.



#### STEP 6

#### Parts:


Part 9 (x4) - Seat Rails Part 16 (x8) - M6x15mm Bolt

Flip the frame of the see saw to install the Seat Rails (Part 9).

Install the Seat Rails to the bottom openings of the side rails using the M6x15mm Bolts (Part 16).

NOTE: Failure to install Seat Rails properly can cause the seat to break.





#### STEP 7:

#### Parts:

Part 17 (x20) - Safety Caps

Install all Safety Caps to all Bolts installed in the product.

NOTE: Failure to install safety caps can result in severe injury. Do not remove. If a safety cap is missing/broken, do not use product until covered completely.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Question: "How should I clean my

seesaw?"

Answer: you should clean the Seesaw with a solution of warm water and Non- Corrosive/Abrasive soap. Dampen a rag with this solution and wipe completely dry before using.

Question: "A seat seems loose, what should I do?"

Answer: Make sure the Bolts/Nuts under the plastic seat are secure.

Question: "Something was missing from the packaging," "I need to purchase a replacement part" or "I discovered a damaged piece. What should I do?"

Answer: Contact customer service. You must have proof of purchase and/or order confirmation available to be considered for warranty replacement. You must report missing pieces within 30 days of purchase.

### **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- Your Seesaw is designed to be very low maintenance.
- If any part of the seesaw requires cleaning, simply wipe with a damp cloth.
- Regularly check to see if the steel tubes, seats, backrests and other parts are tightened and completely secure. Replace worn & damaged parts if found and if necessary, secure from use until replacement parts can be obtained.
- If the paint is chipped, we recommend you lightly rub the damaged area and cover using a non-toxic enamel paint.
- IMPORTANT: While no regular maintenance is required, you must inspect the seesaw before each use and replace any worn, defective, or missing parts. The following conditions could represent potential hazards: Missing, improperly positioned, or insecurely attached frame parts, Missing, improperly secured or damaged seats, and/or a bent or broken rocker, Cease using seesaw immediately and secure it against unauthorized use if any of these conditions are present.
