About This Variety: Dahlia Pulp Fiction is an excellent choice for a patio planter or window box. It produces bright red single flowers with deep dark purple foliage, an eye -popping combination. The flowers and leaves are also suitable in flower arrangements.

Growing Instructions: Exact care of dahlia flowers may vary dependent upon your zone, but these tips should help you get maximum blooms and healthy bushy plants. Plant in well-drained soil, after danger of frost has passed, where they will get plenty of sunlight. They respond dramatically to feeding increasing the growth of leaves and flowers, and your tuber clump for an even bigger show next season. Water well.

Care Tip: Plant one bulb to a small pot, or three in a 8-10" pot or larger.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 8-10" tall

Spacing: Plant 12-36" apart, 3" deep

Hardy in: USDA zones 9-11
