Installation instructions

The X9RFDYNAMOUSE is automatically recognized by the computer and does not require a driver. Simply follow the steps below and you are ready to go!

1. Install 2 "AAA" batteries (included) in the battery compartment.

Remove the USB receiver RF dongle from its compartment.

3. Plug the USB RF receiver dongle into the USB port of your computer.

4. Switch to turn on the mouse power, you are ready to use the X9RFDYNAMOUSE mouse.

However, if you wish to configure the mouse settings to your personal preferences you can do this in the settings of the operating system:

Mac OS

To configure the tracking speed, scrolling speed, double click speed and primary mouse button, go to Mouse in System Preferences. To configure the mouse button functions, go to Mission Control in System Preferences.

Windows

To configure the mouse buttons, pointer, pointer options and wheel, go to Mouse in Hardware/Control Panel.
